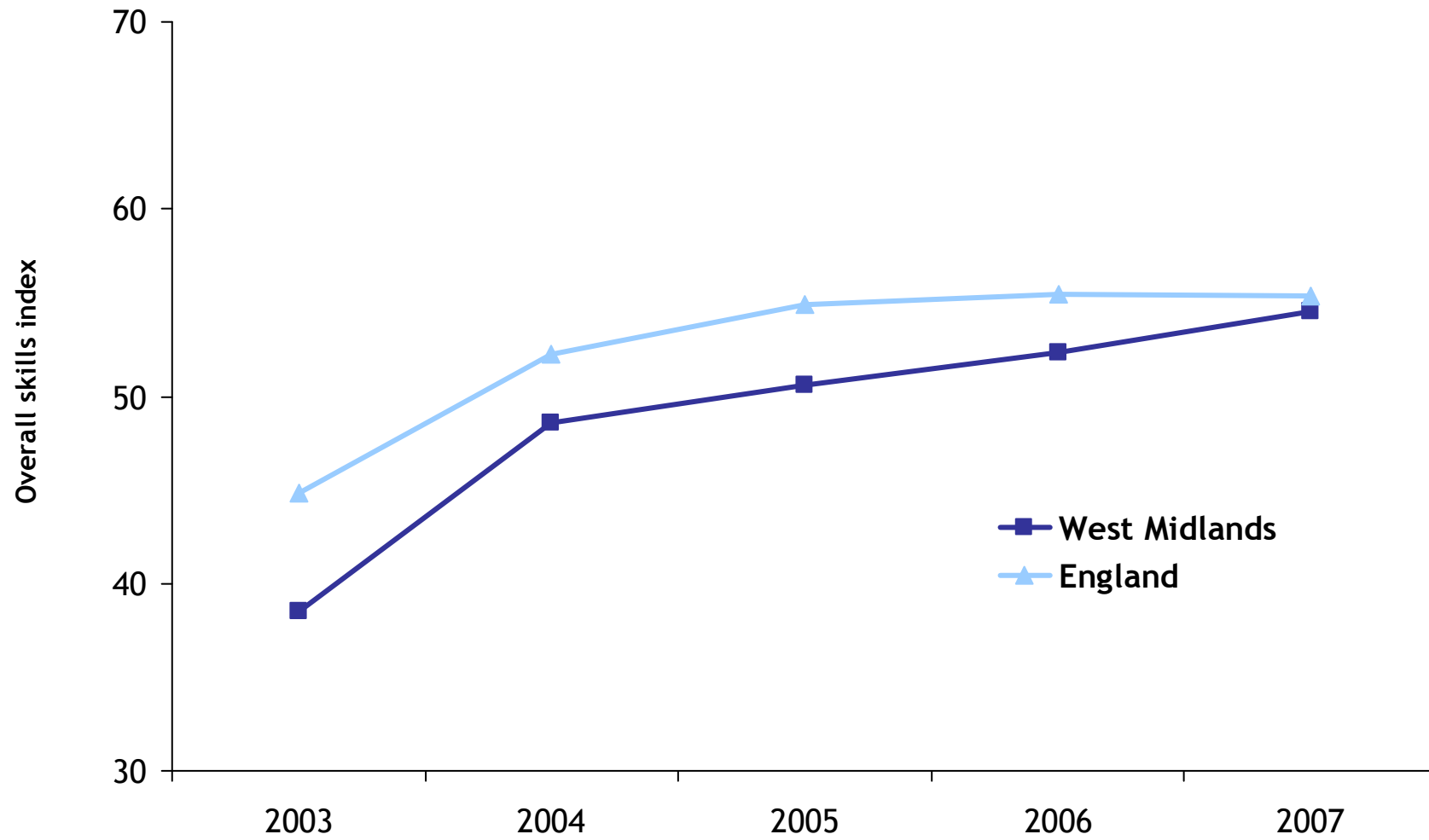


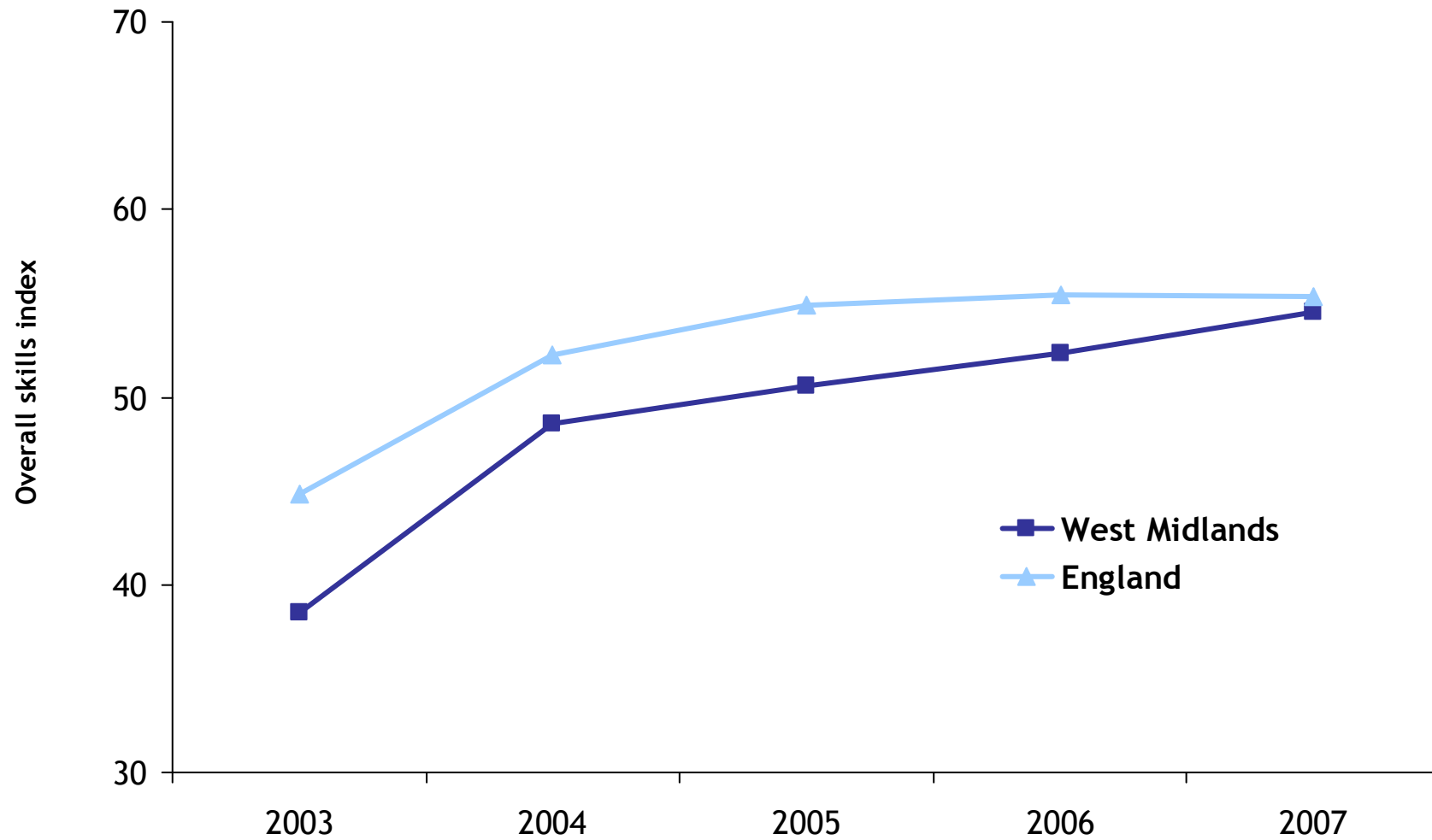

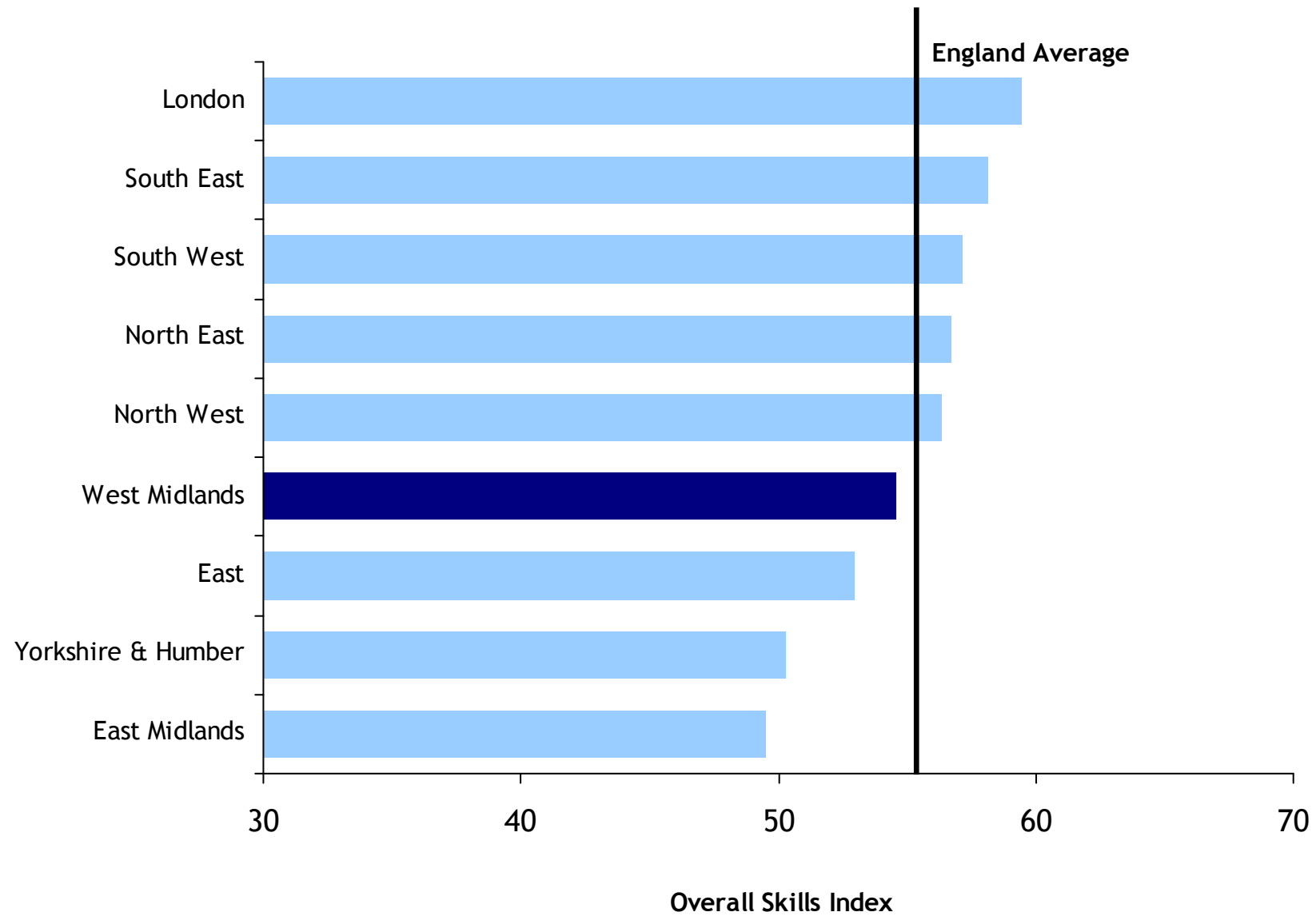
1 Skills Performance Index



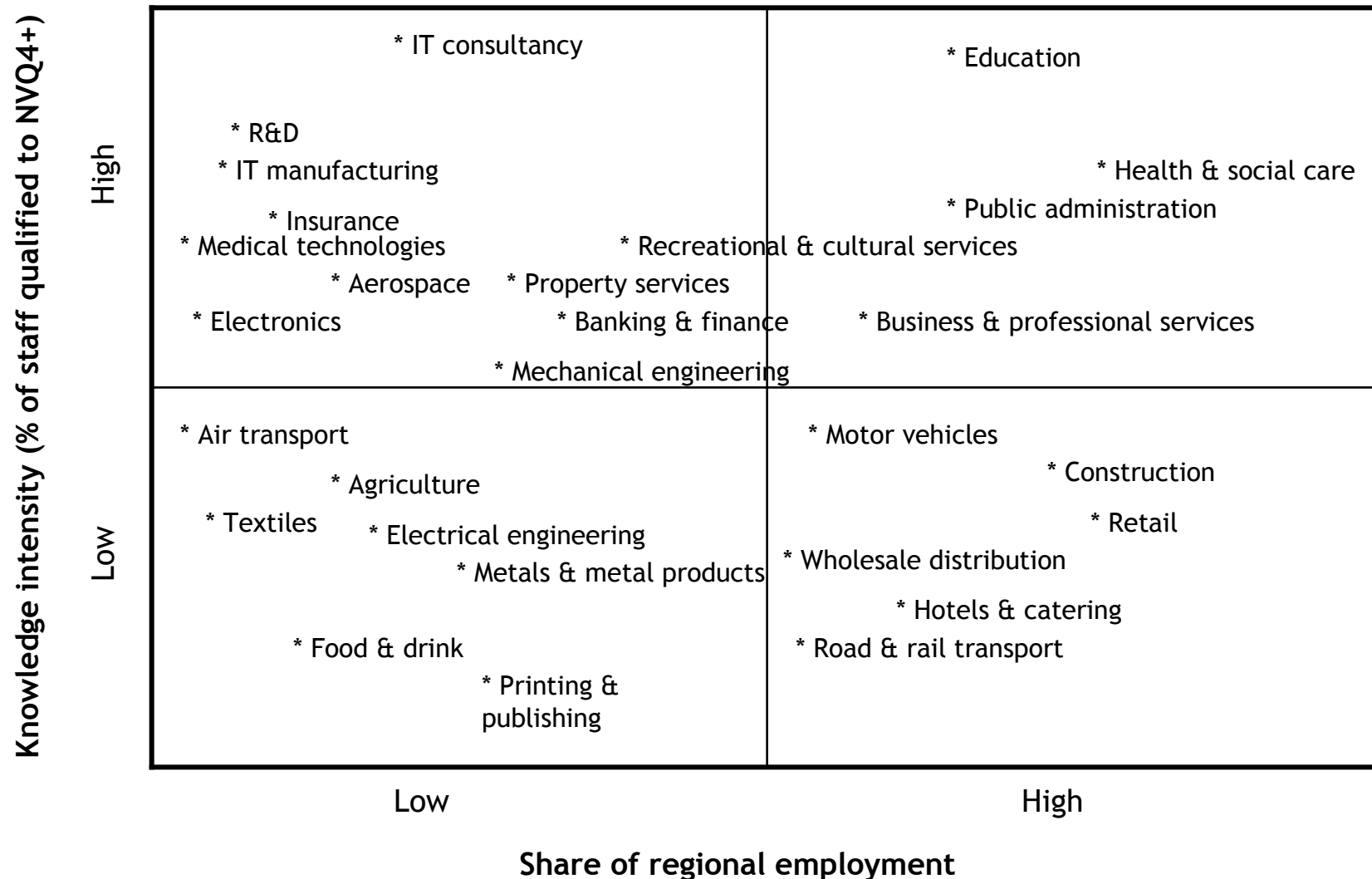
2 Skills Performance Index



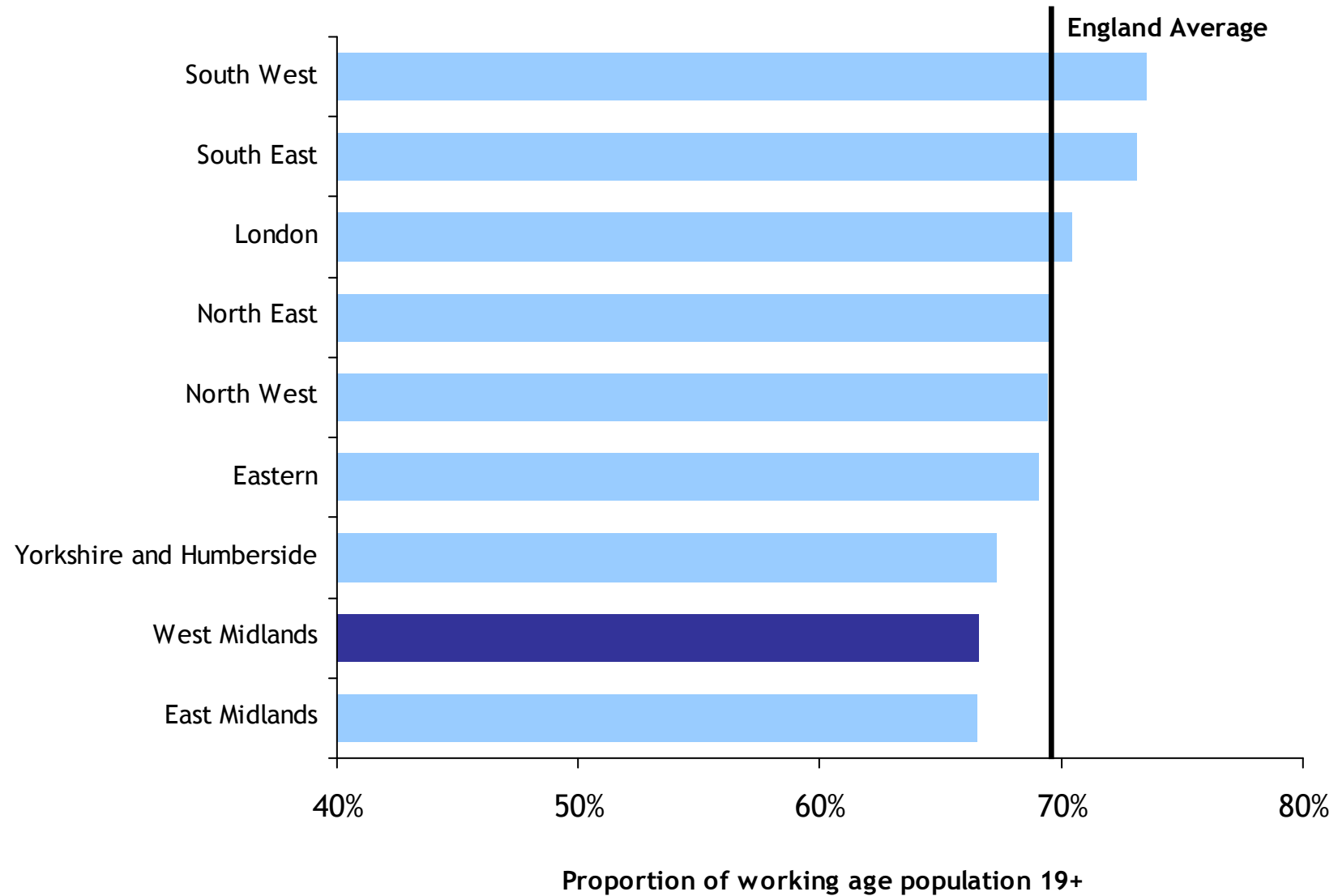
3 Overall Skills Performance Index: Regional Comparison 2007



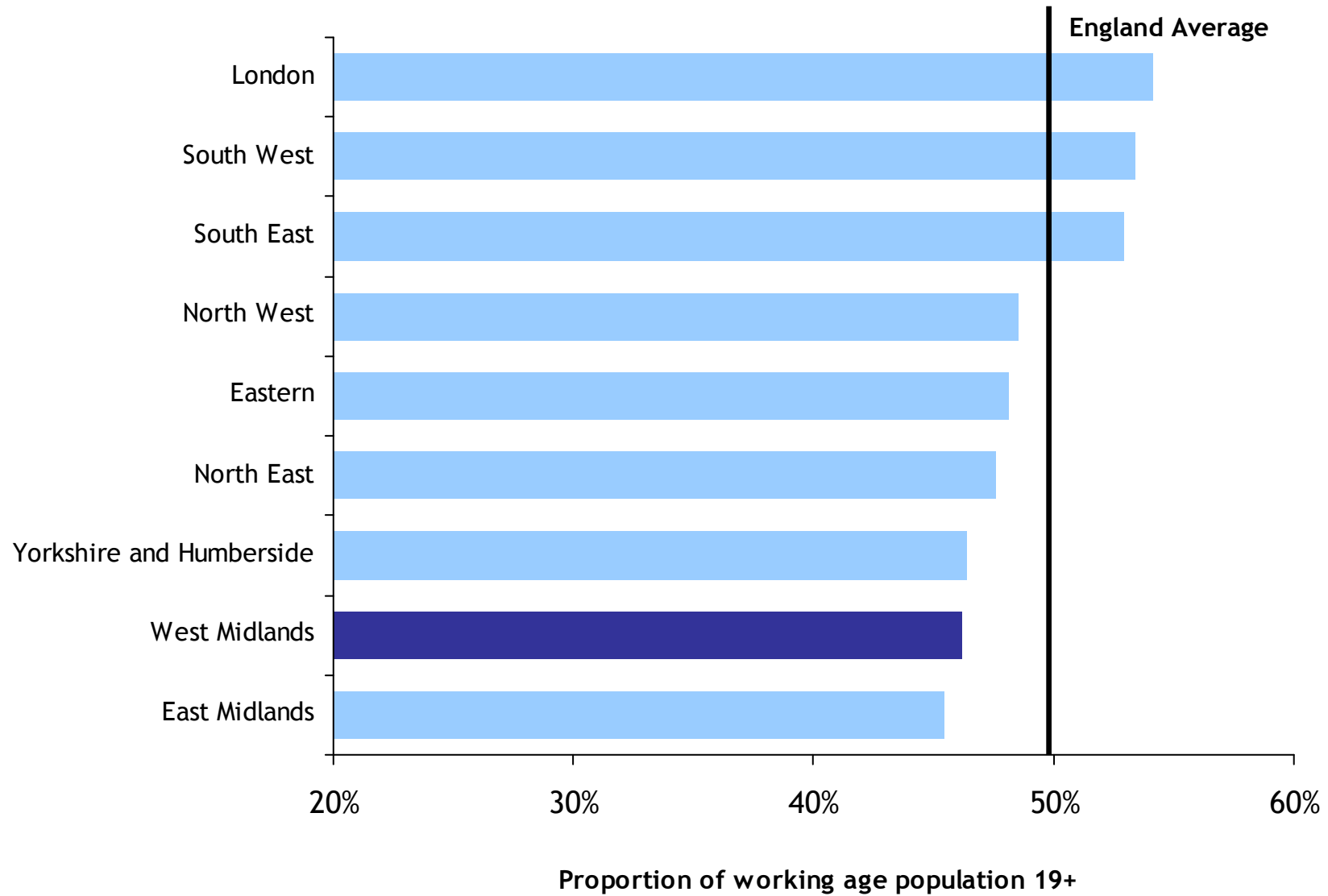
4 The region's key 'knowledge industries'



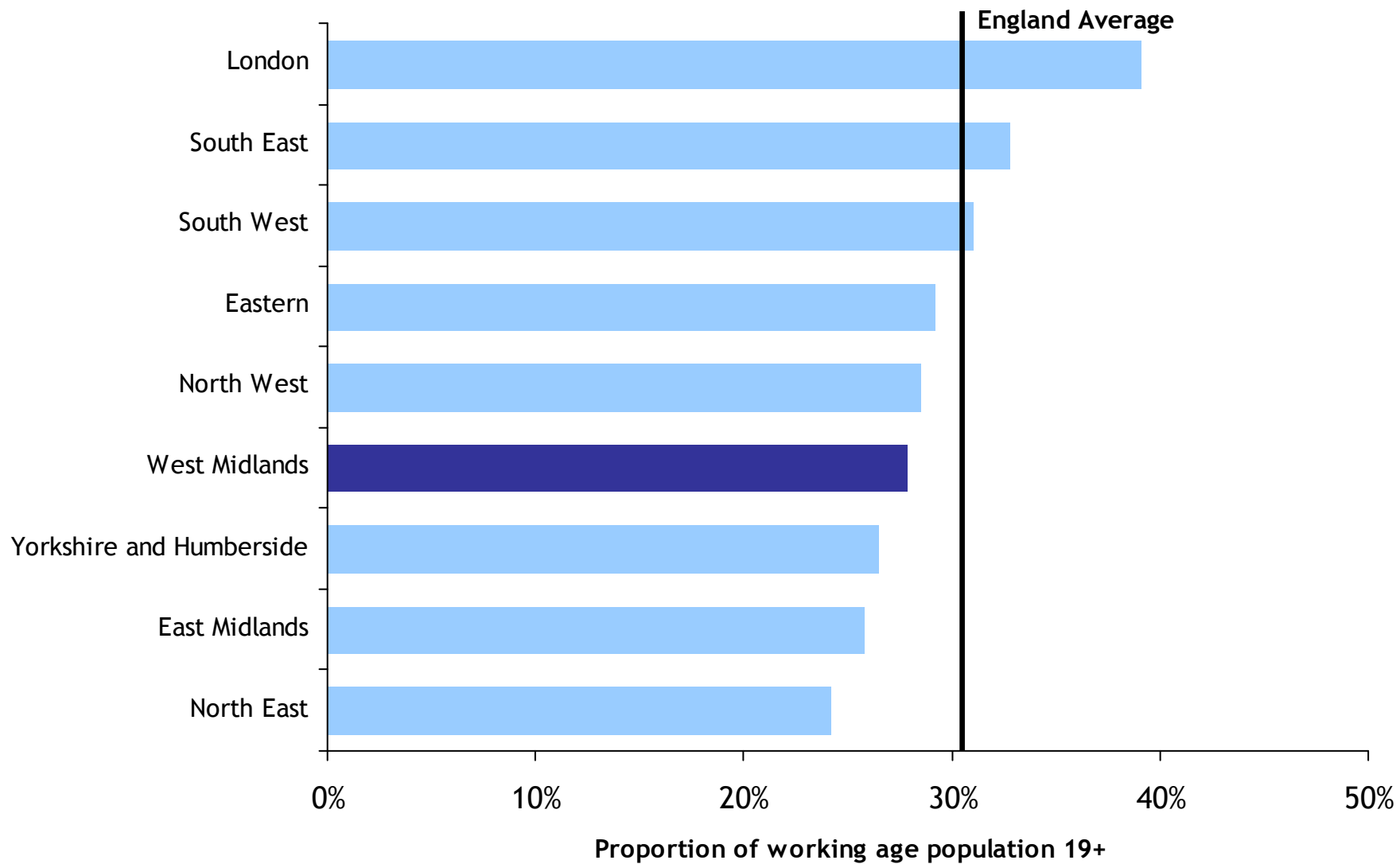
5 Proportion of the working age population 19+ with qualifications level 2+, 2007



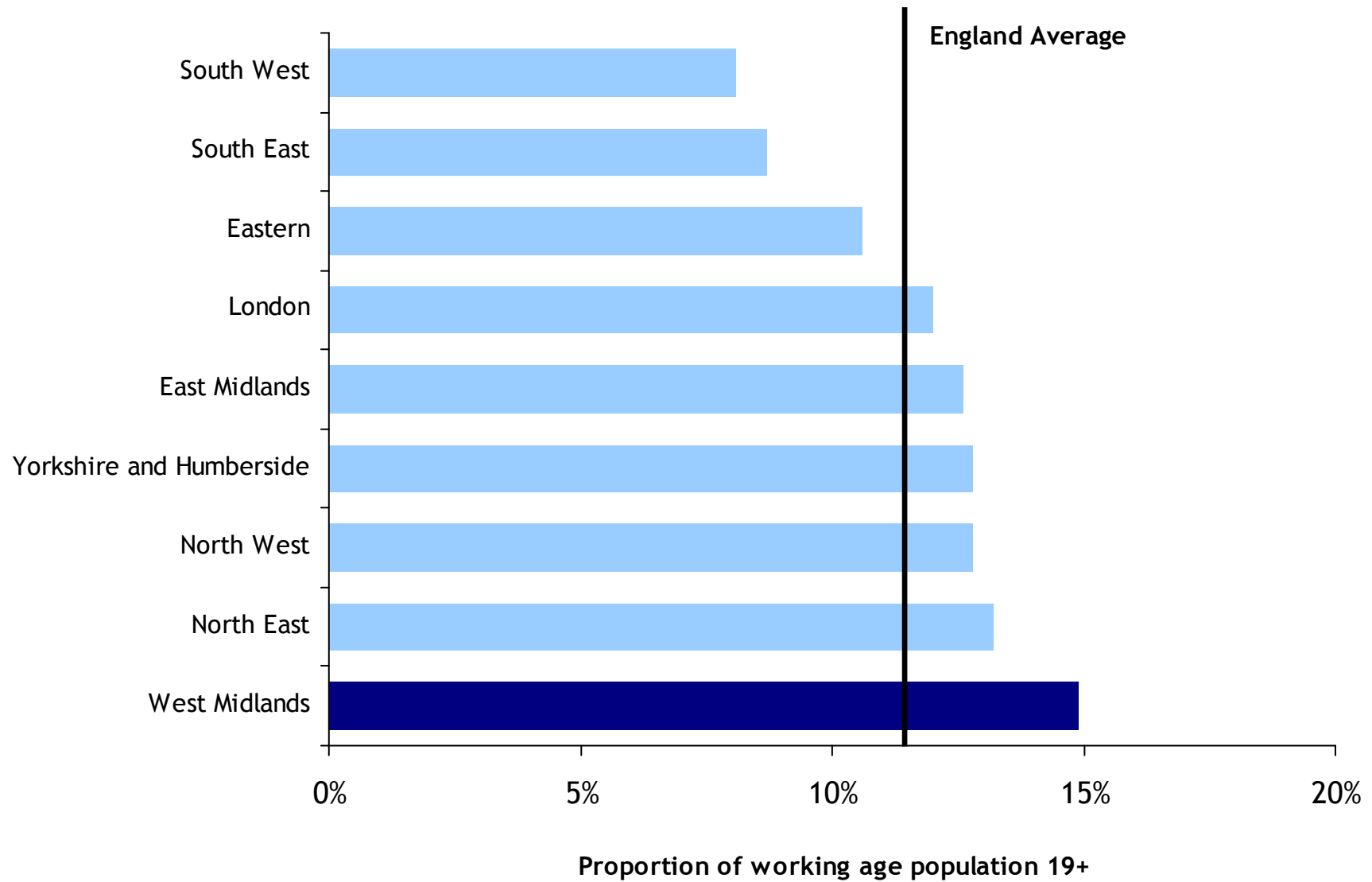
6 Proportion of the working age population 19+ with qualifications level 3+, 2007



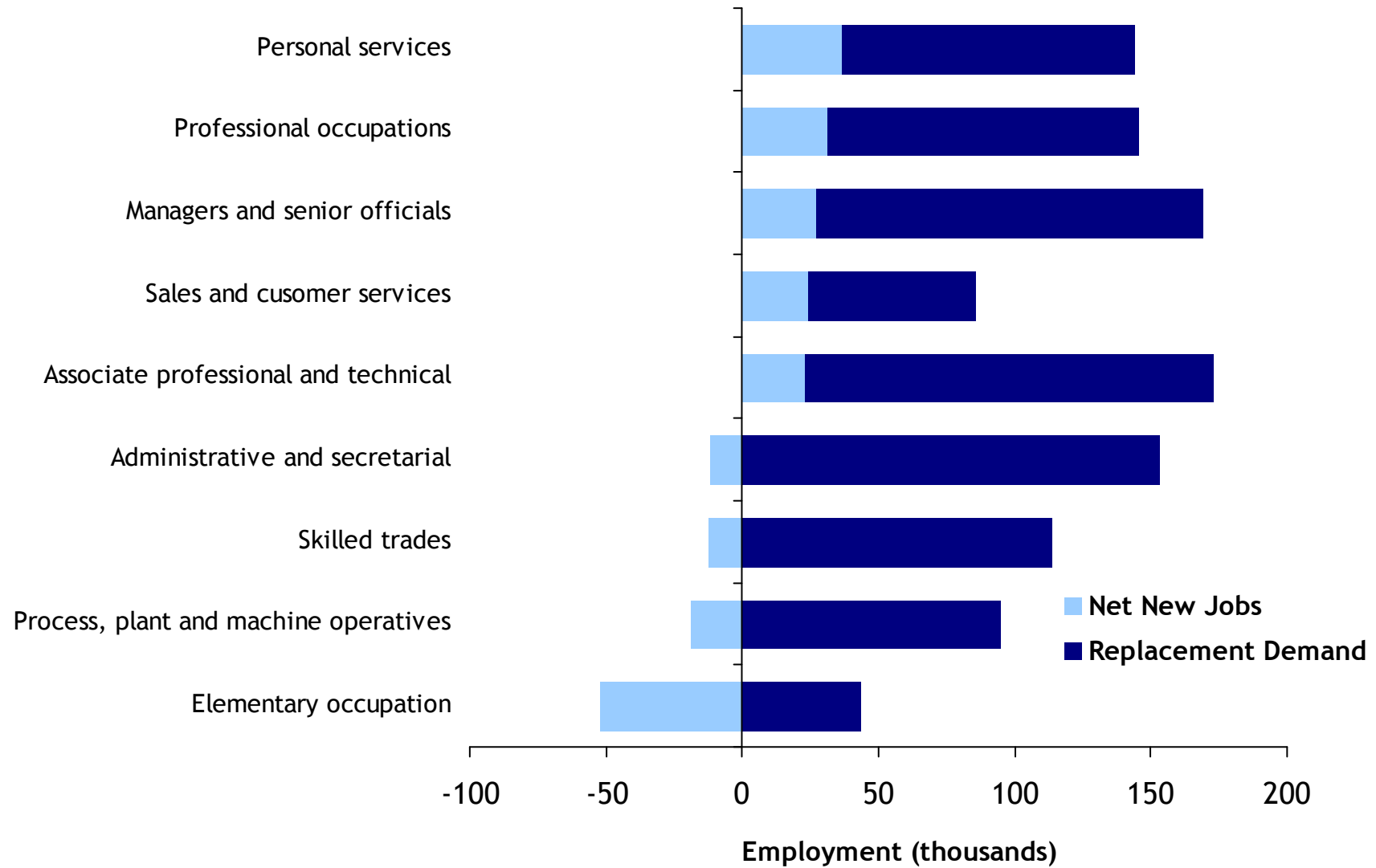
7 Proportion of the working age population 19+ with qualifications level 4+, 2007



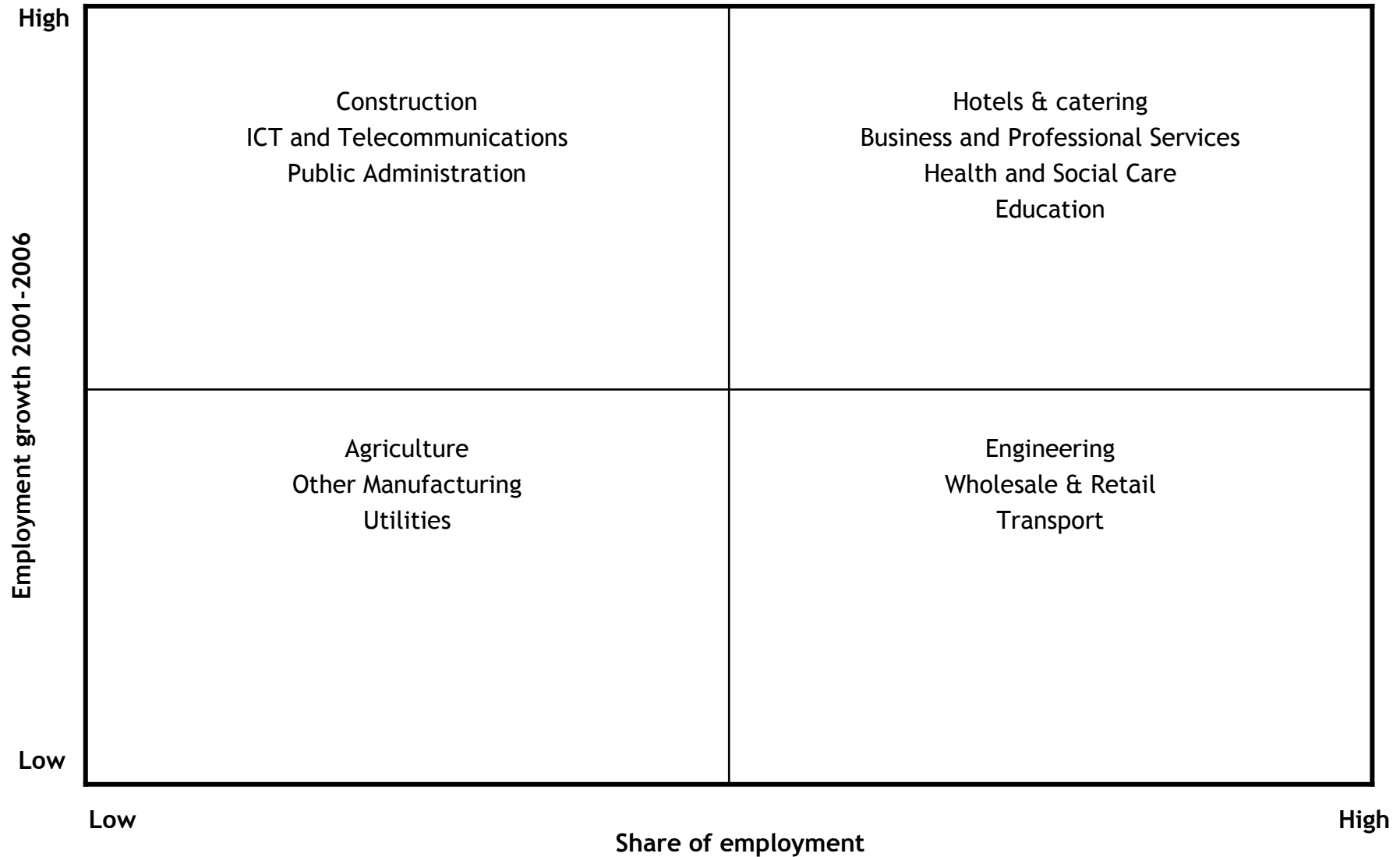
8 Proportion of the working age population 19+ with no qualifications, 2007



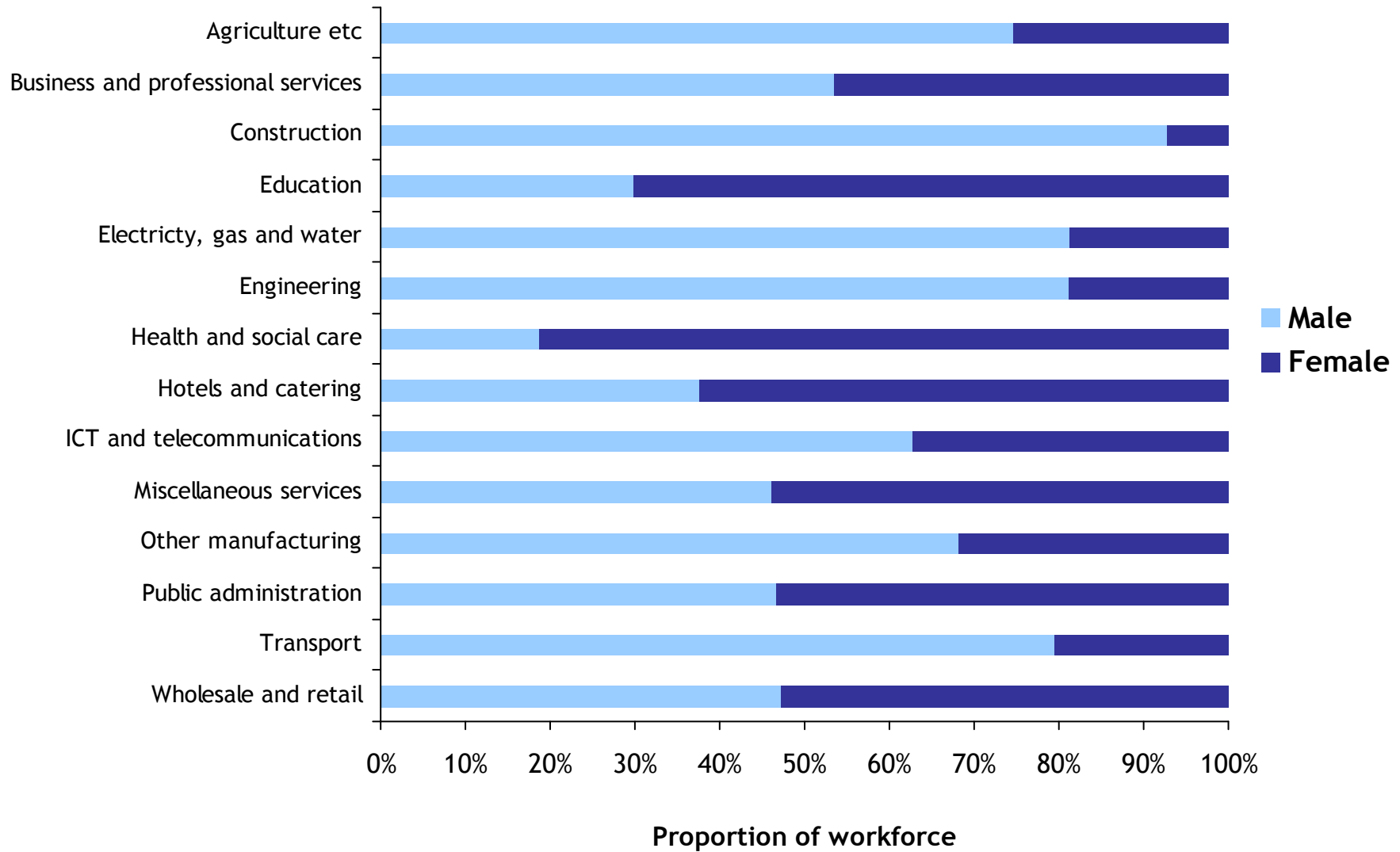
9 Projections of regional employment change 2006-2016



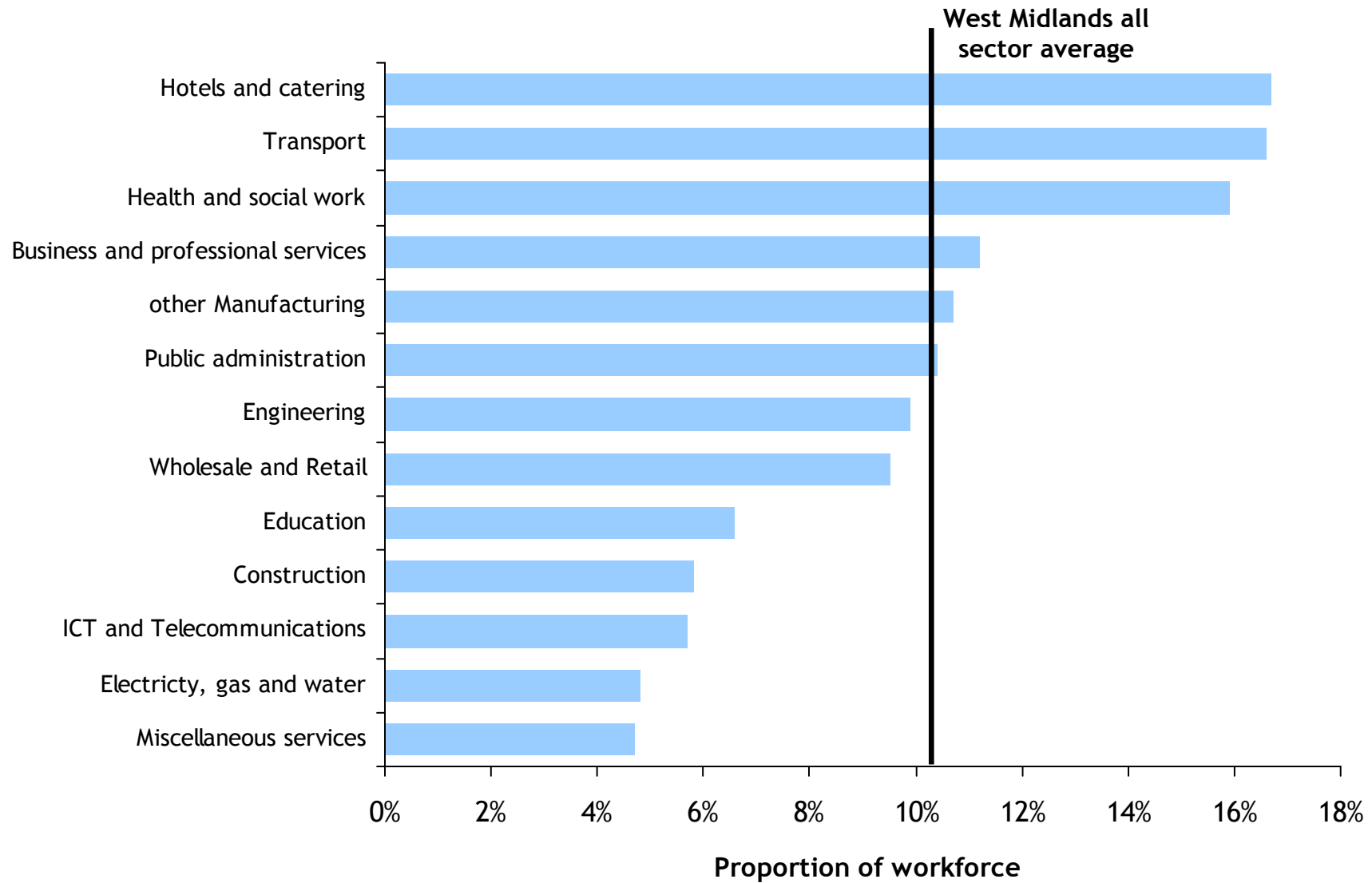
10 Comparison of employment share and growth by sector



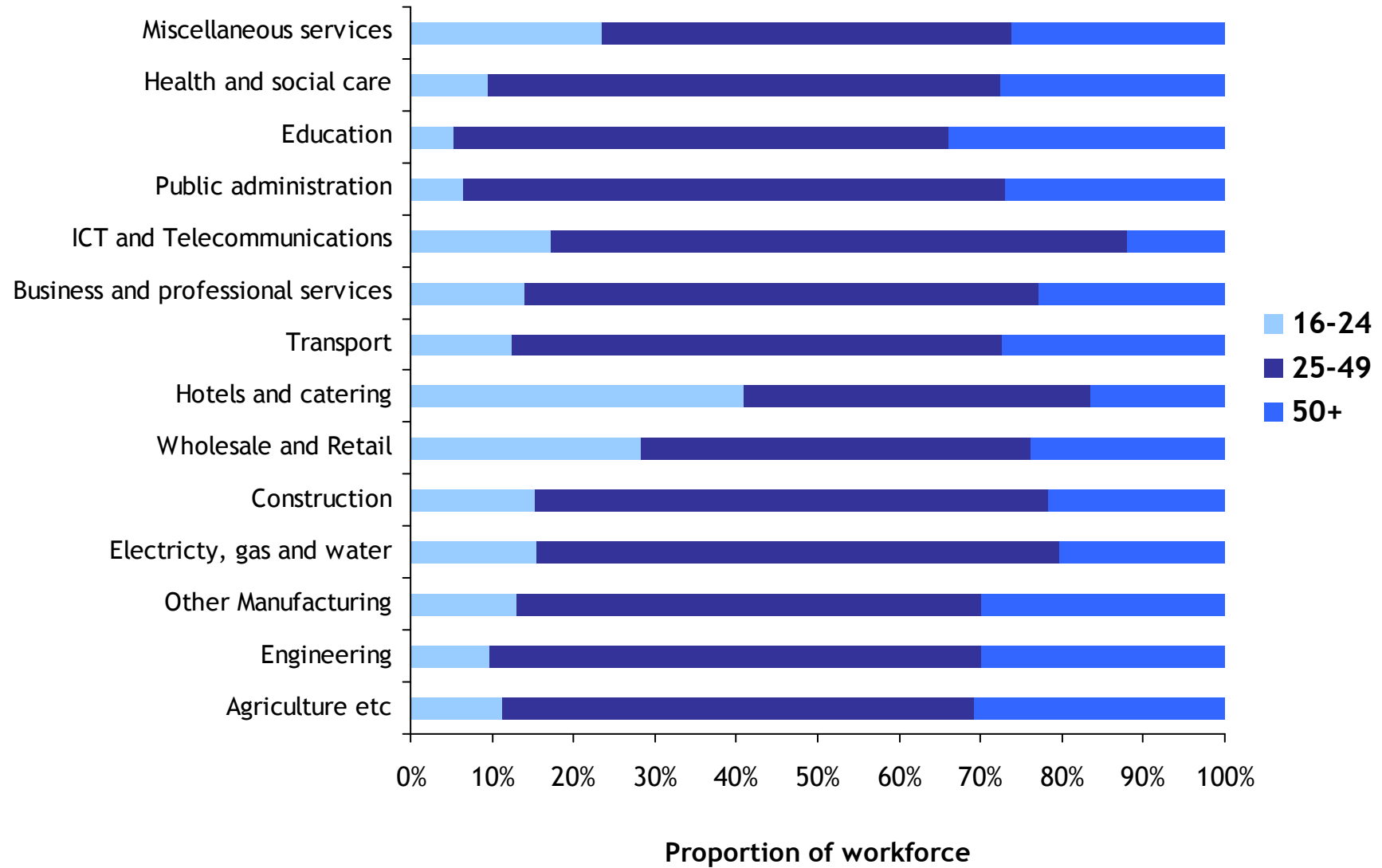
11 Gender breakdown by sector in 2007



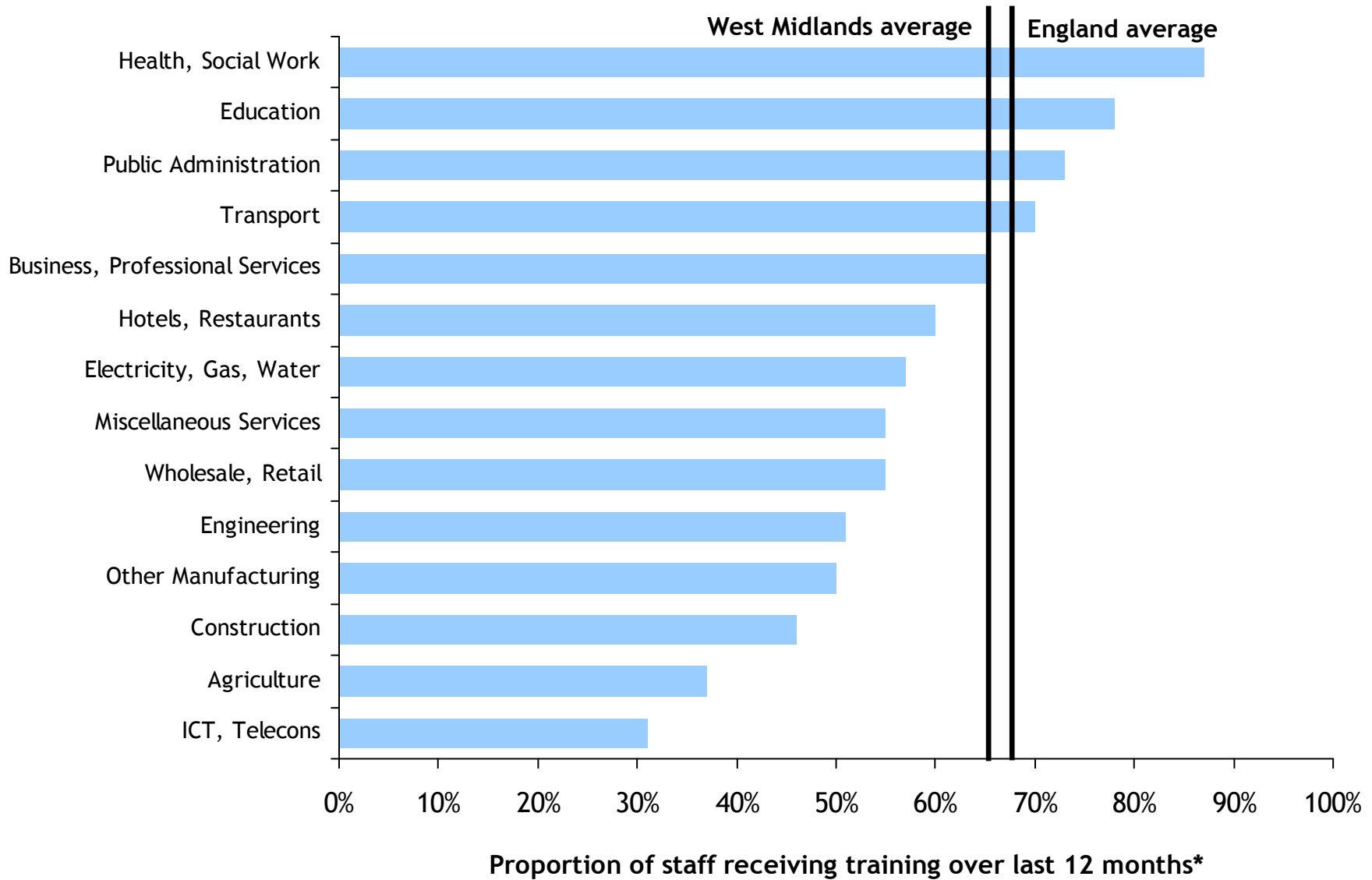
12 Proportion of sector workforce that is non-white in 2007



13 Regional workforce by age and sector in 2007

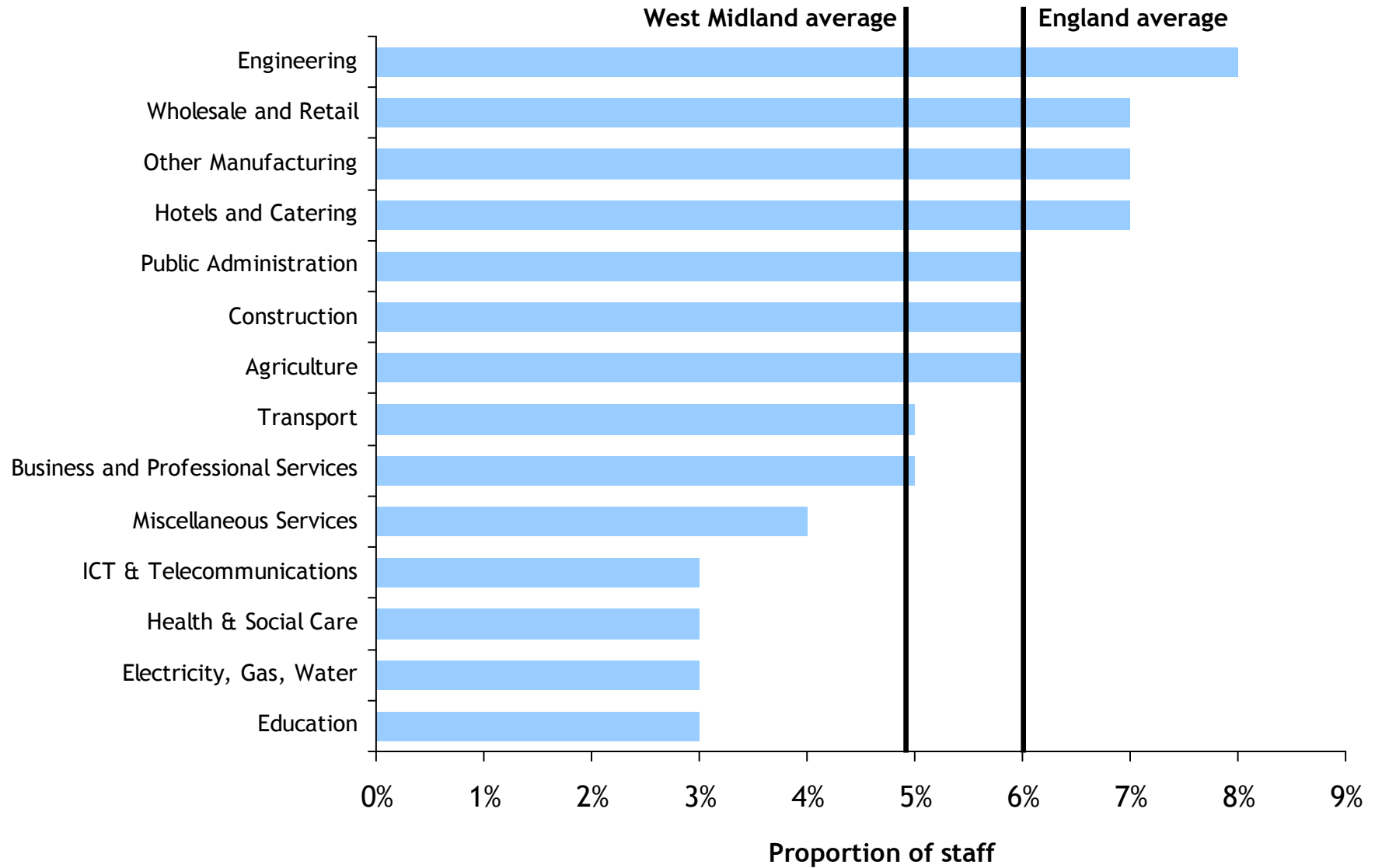

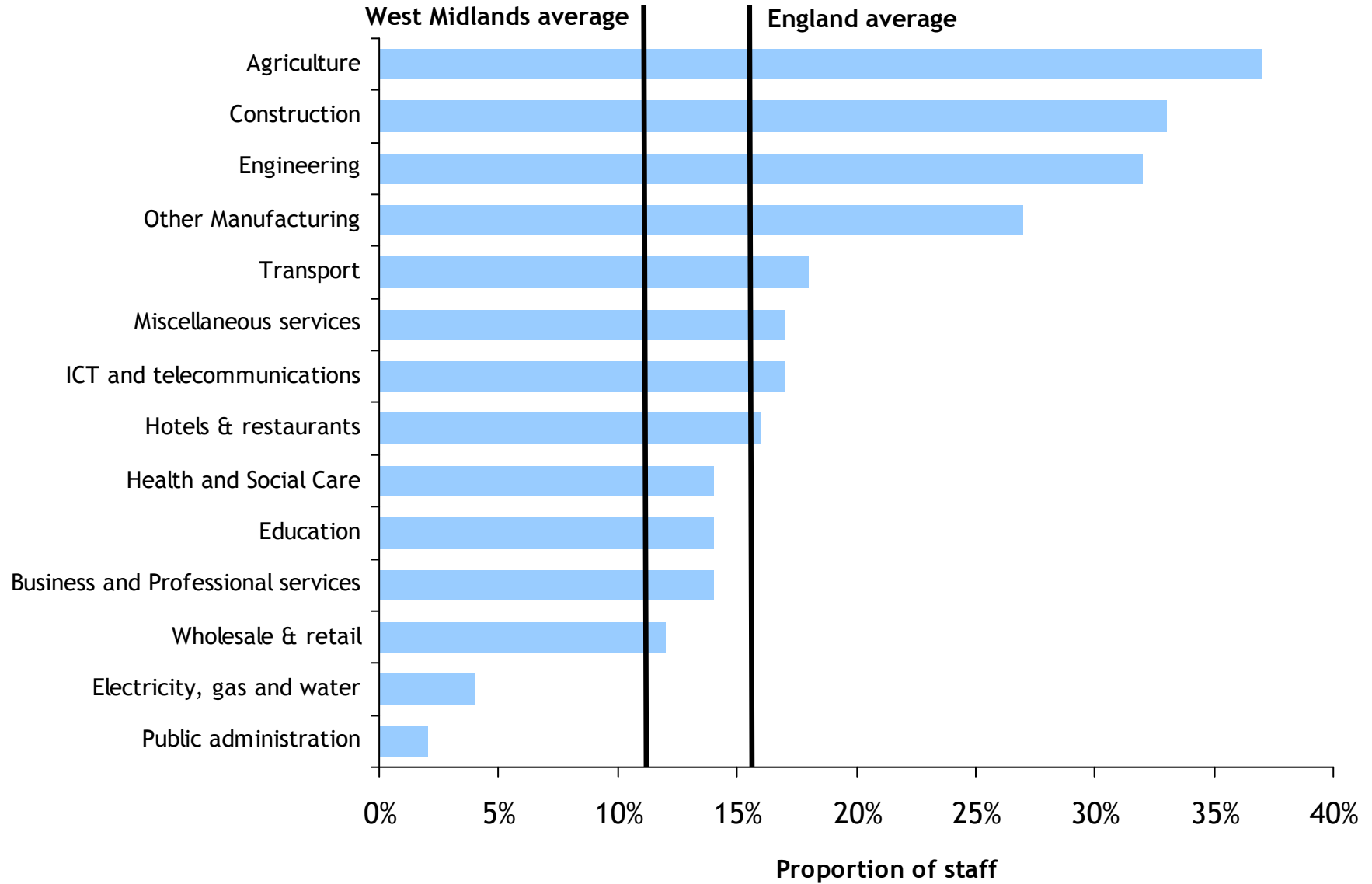

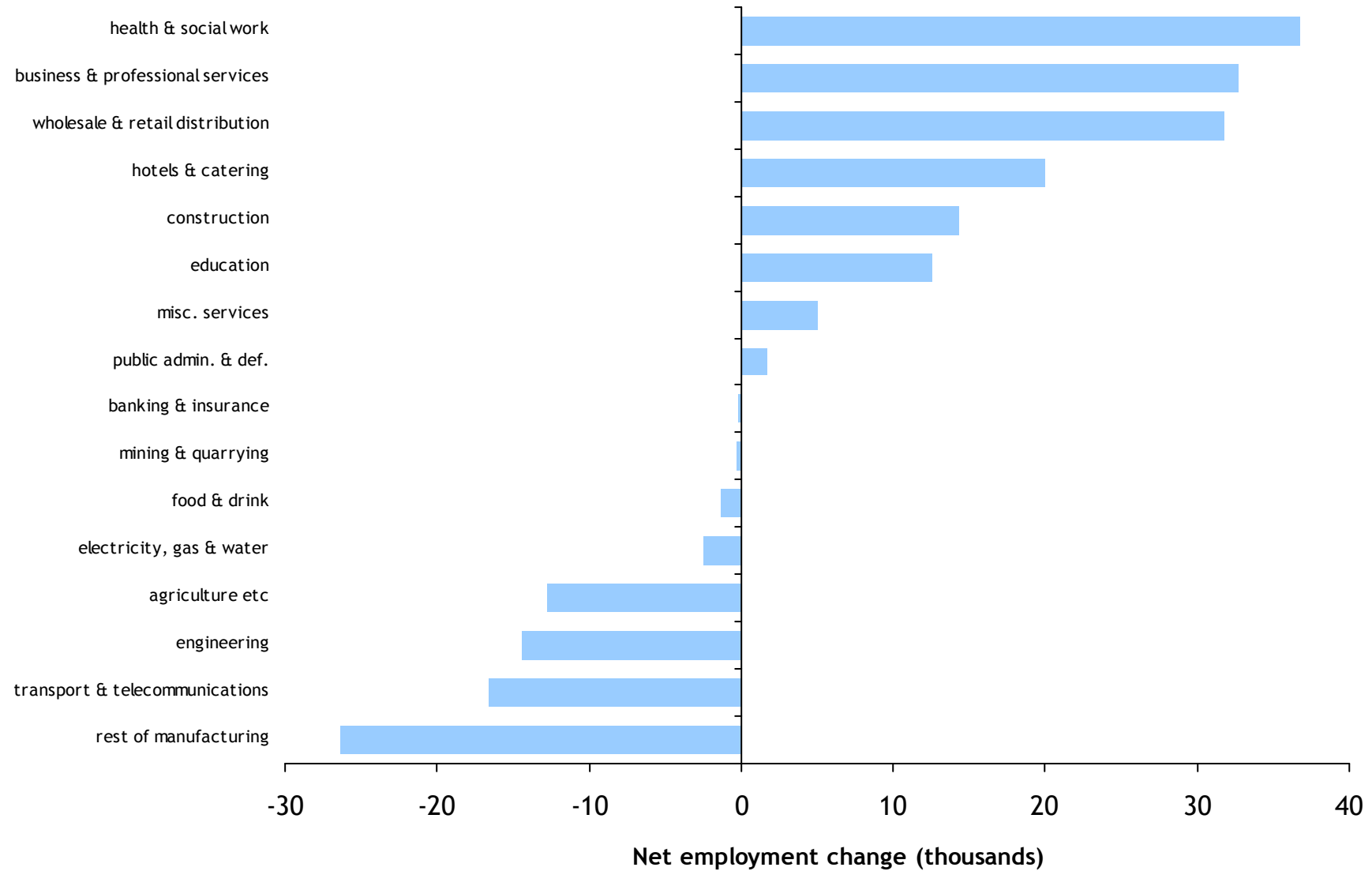

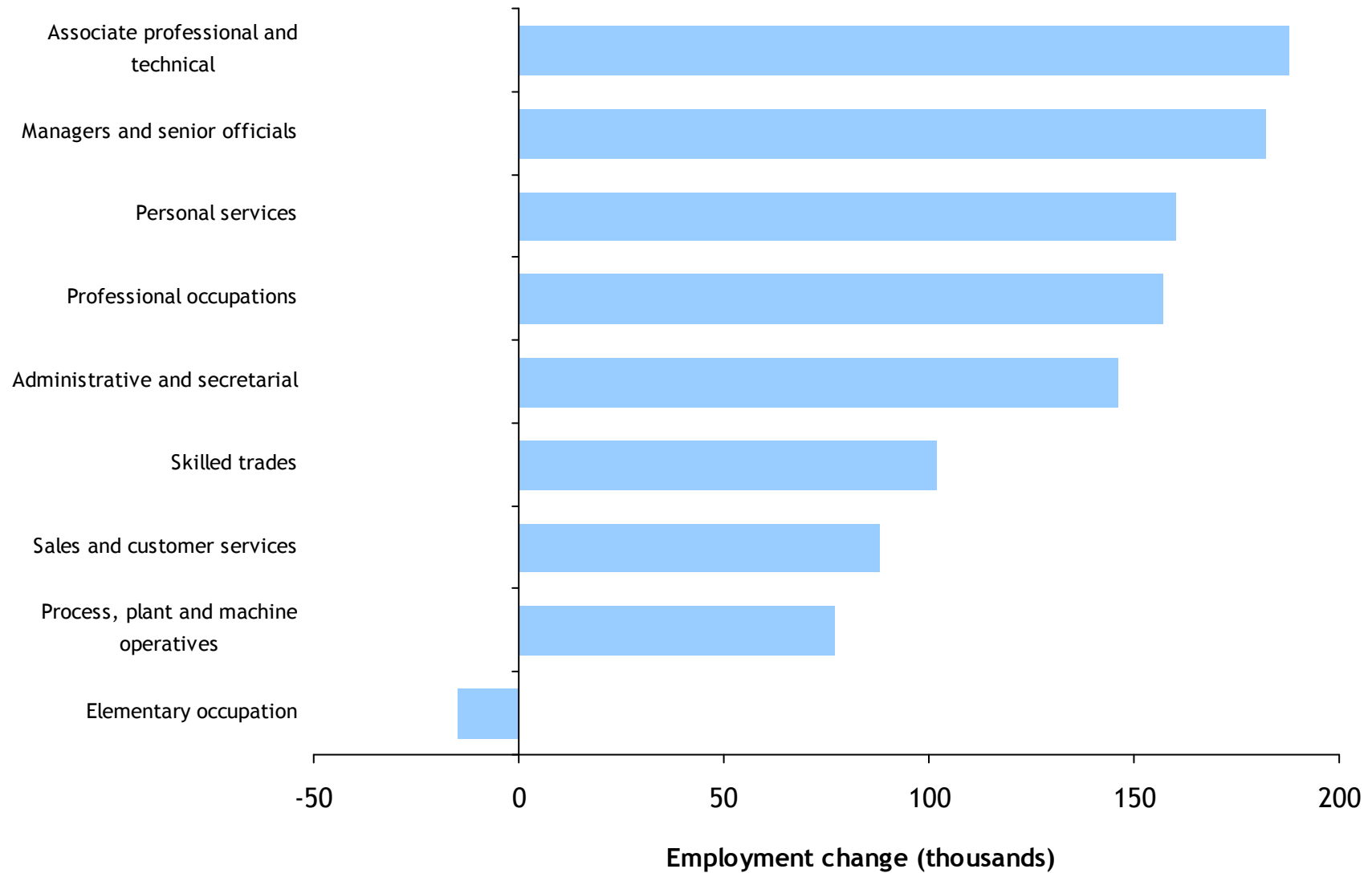
16 Skills-shortages vacancies by sector



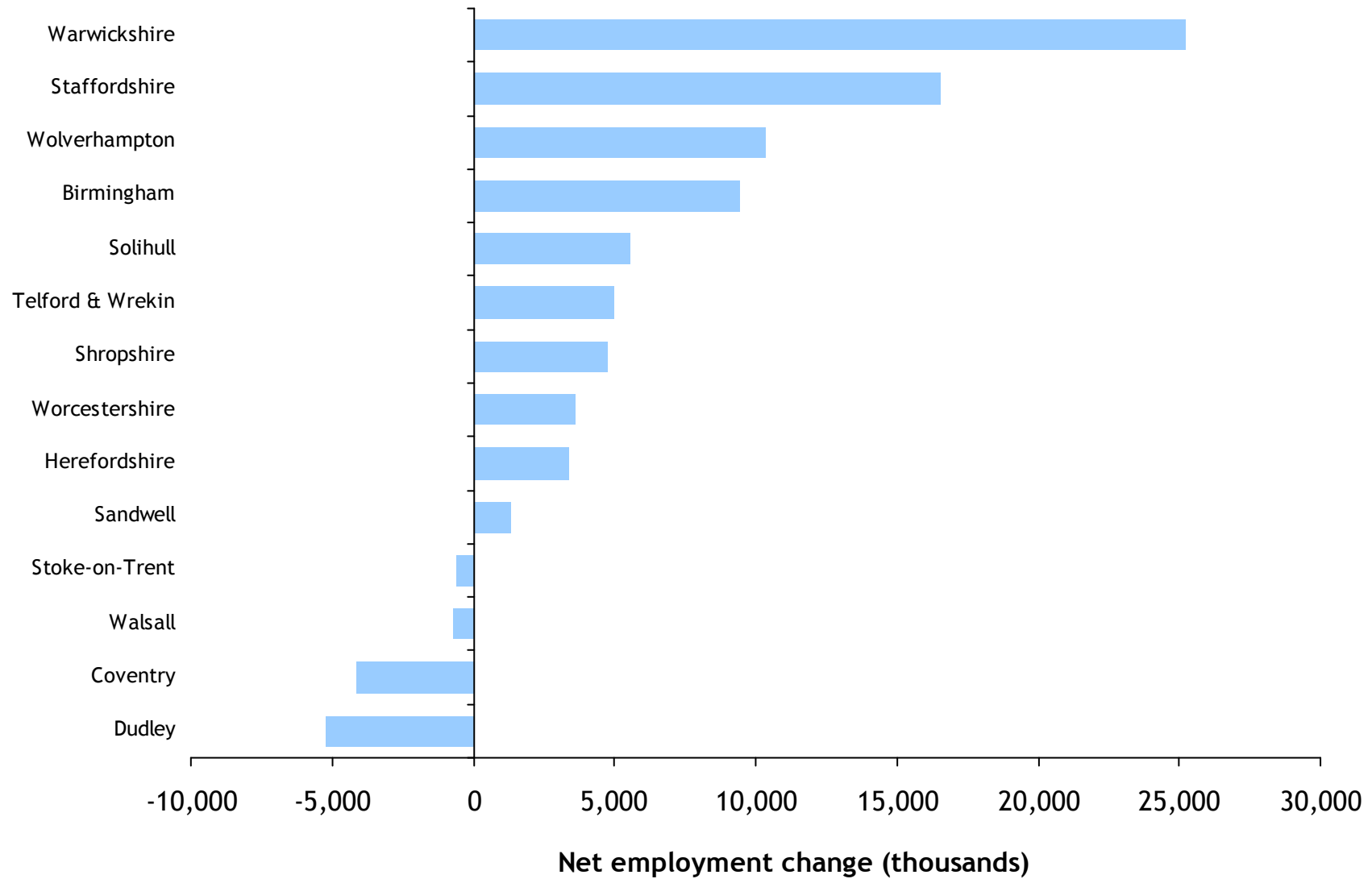
17 Projections of regional employment change 2007-2017: by sector



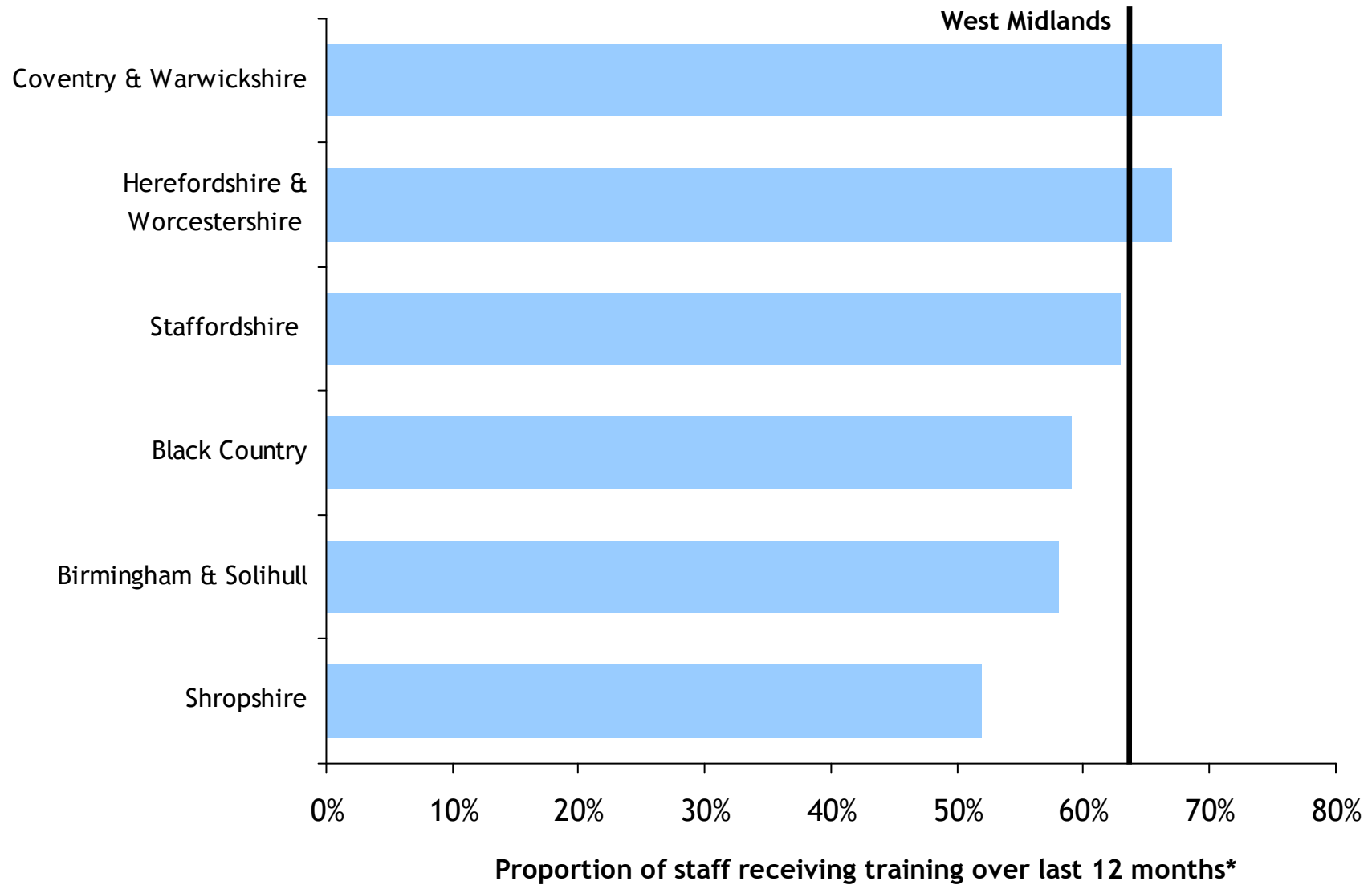
18 Projections of regional employment change 2007-2017: net new jobs

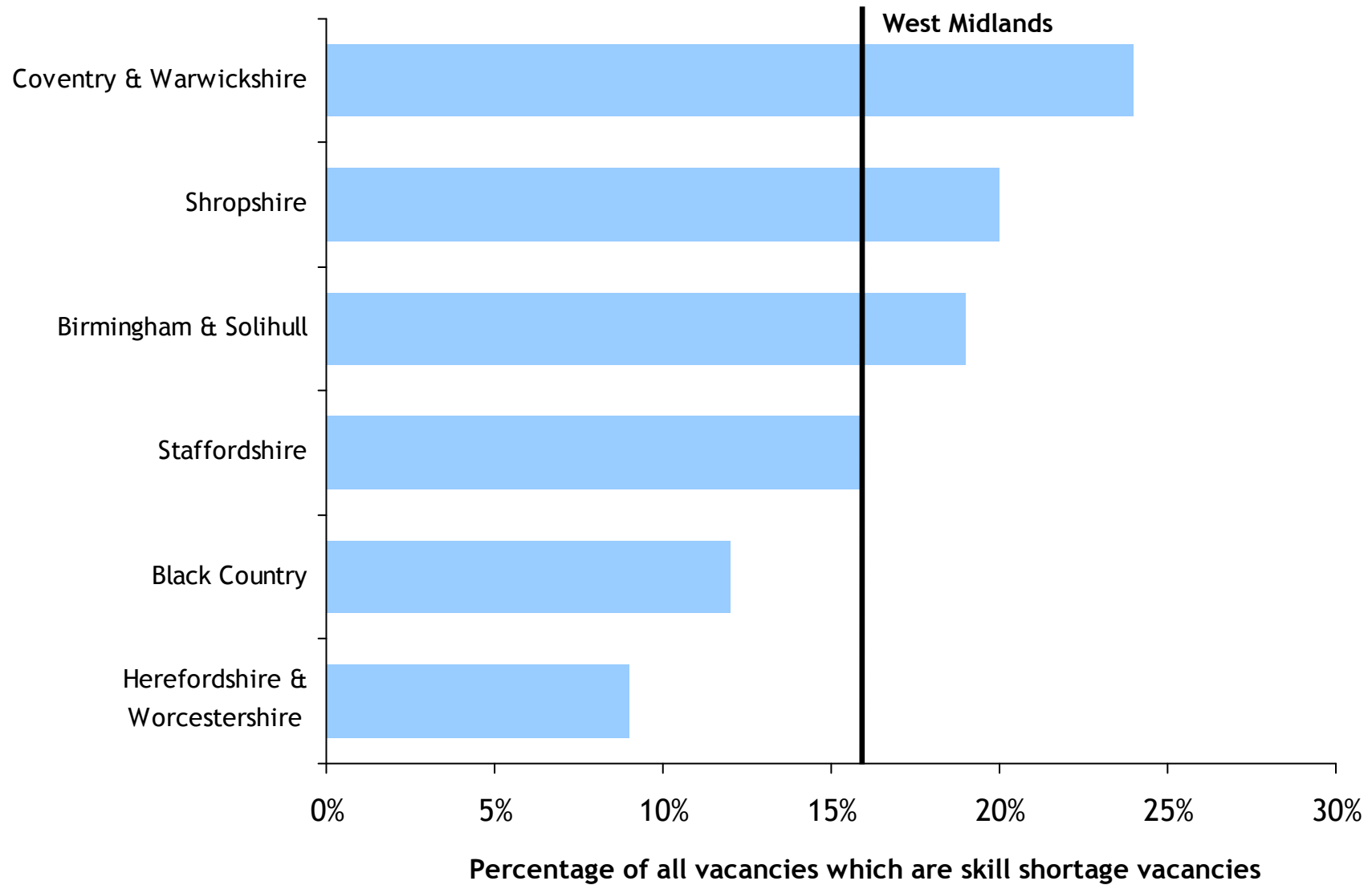

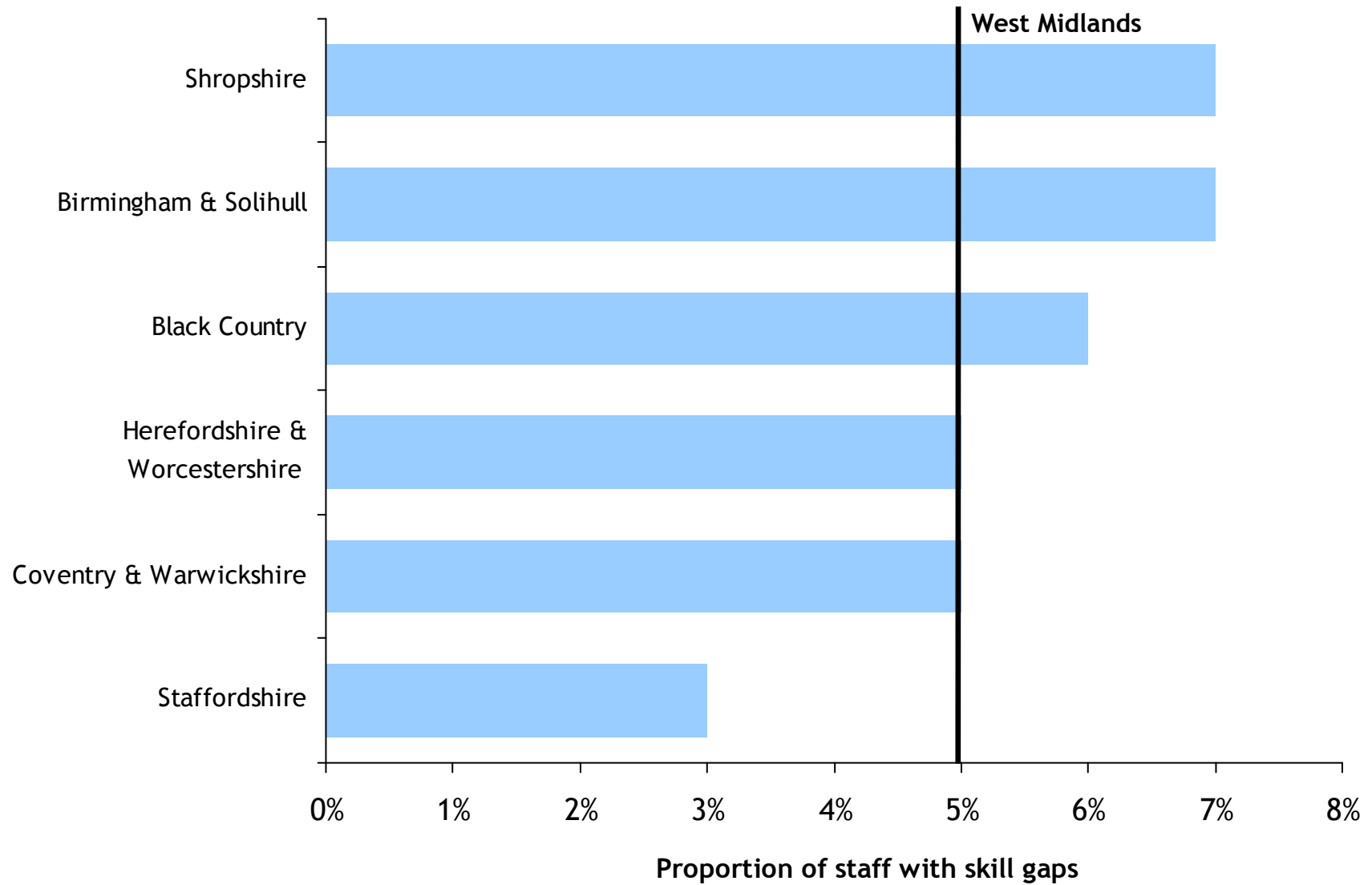

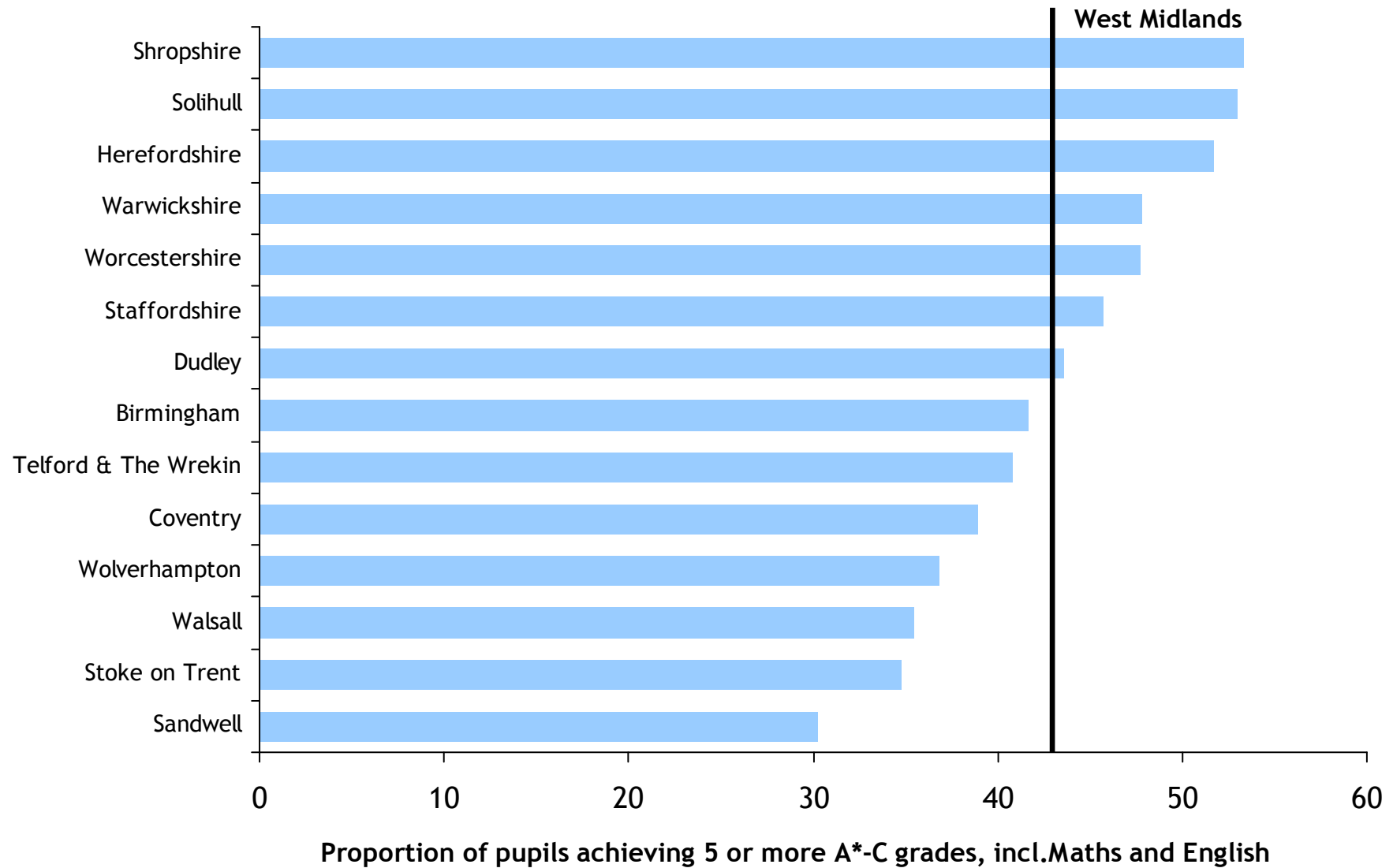
21 Density of skill shortage vacancies



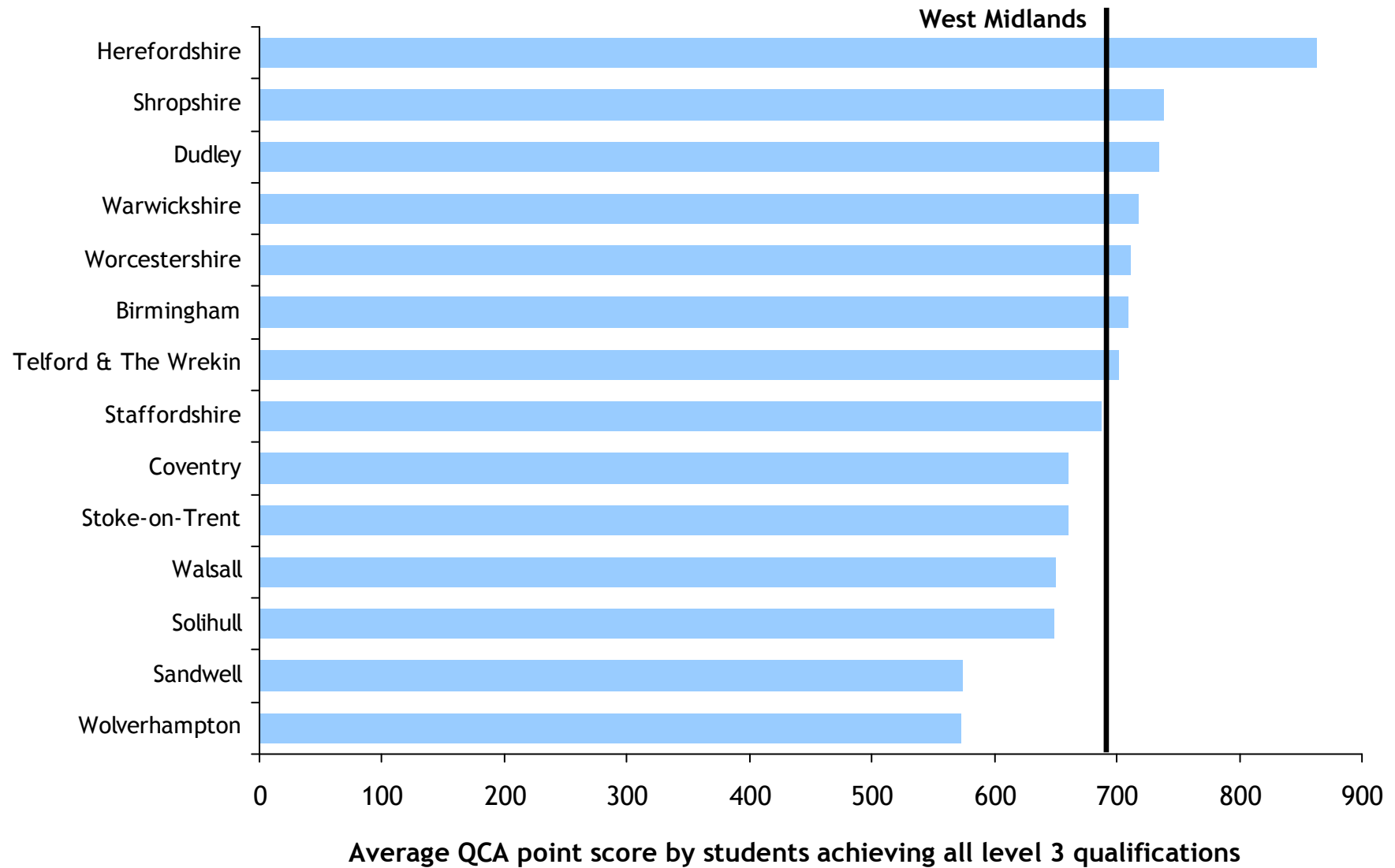
22 Proportion of staff with skill gaps



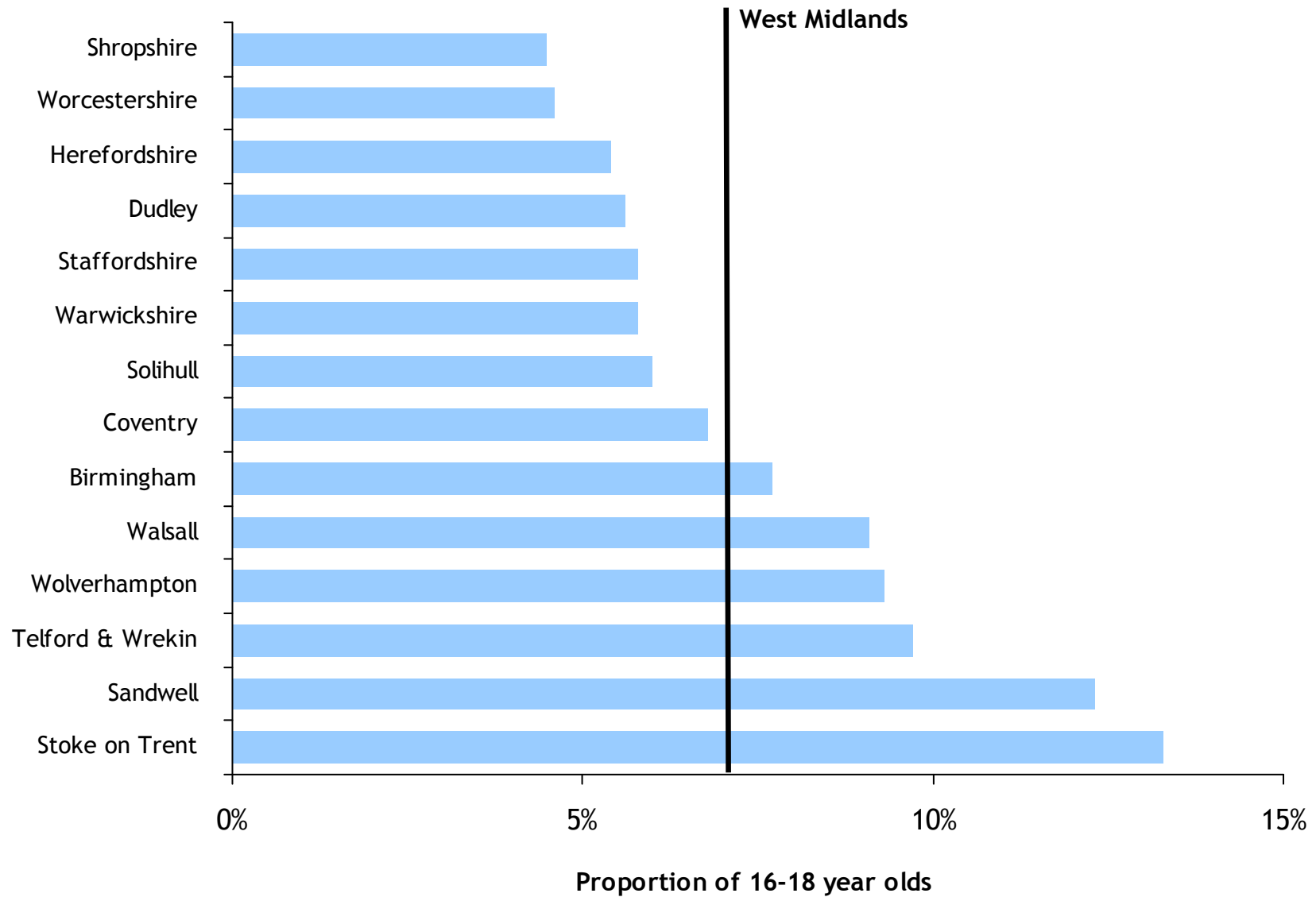
23 Proportion of pupils achieving 5 or more GCSE A*-C grades, incl. Maths and English by LEA, 2006/07



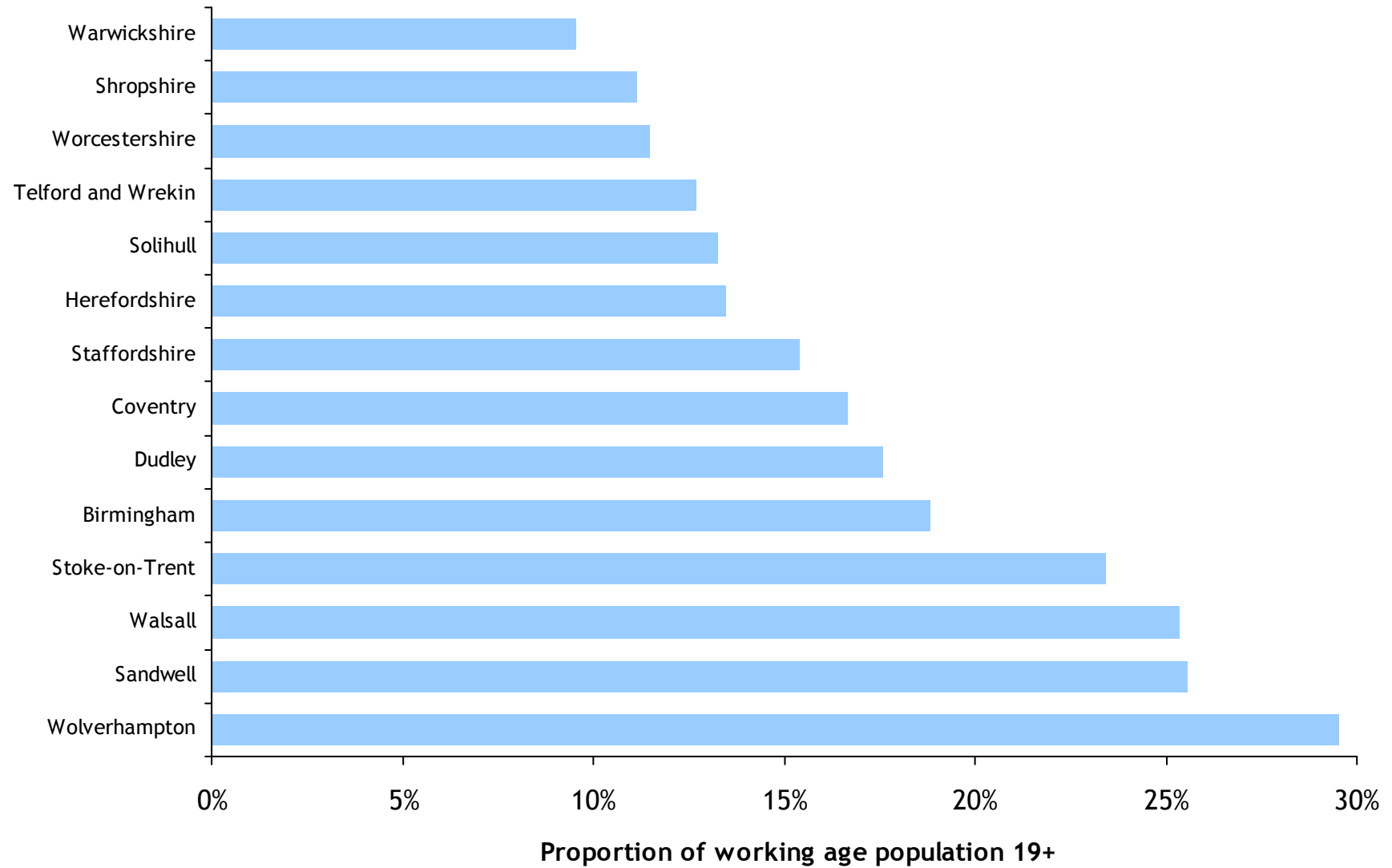
24 Average A-level point score per candidate by LEA, 2006/07



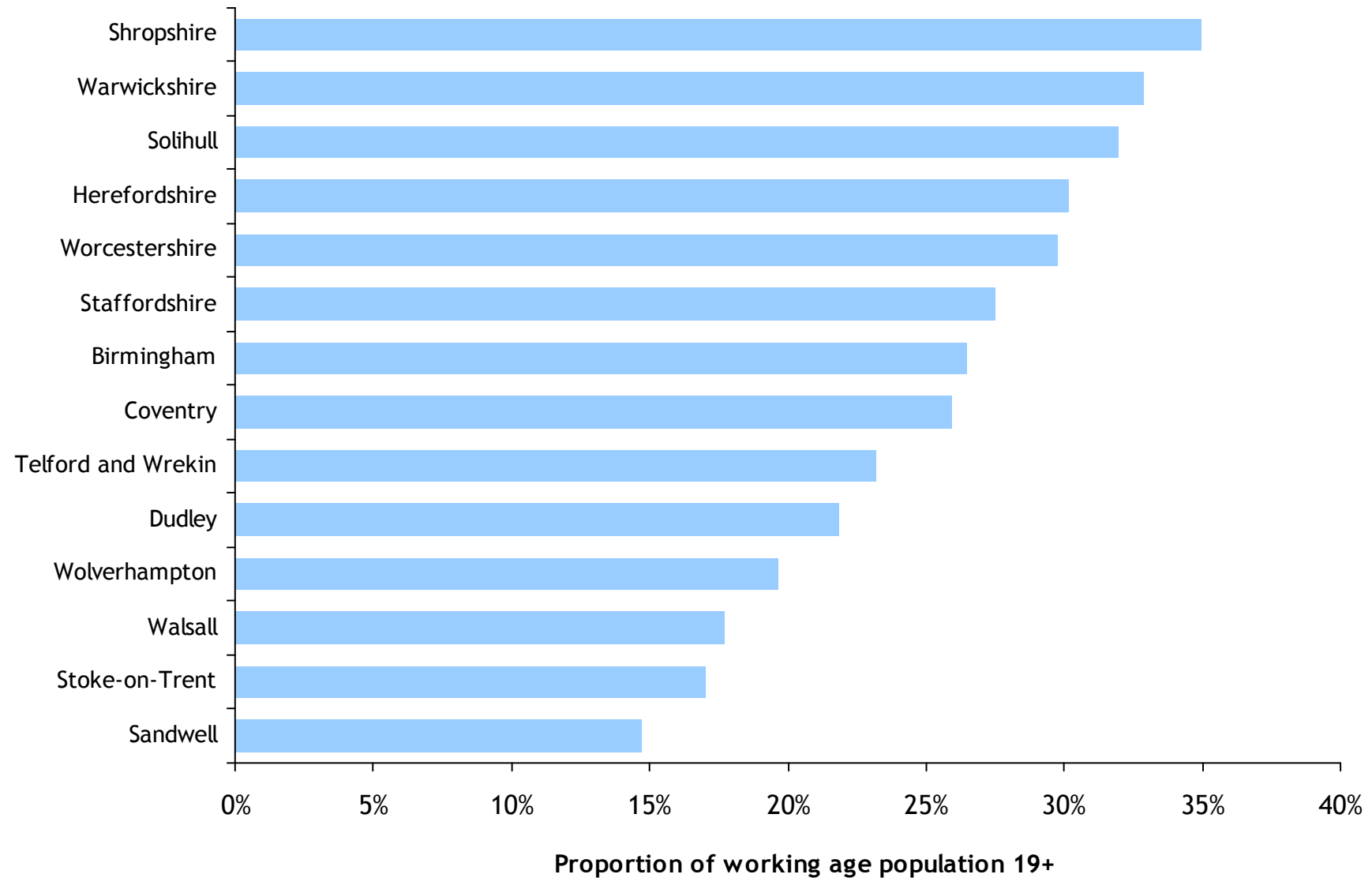
25 Proportion of 16-18 year olds not in employment, education or training, 2007



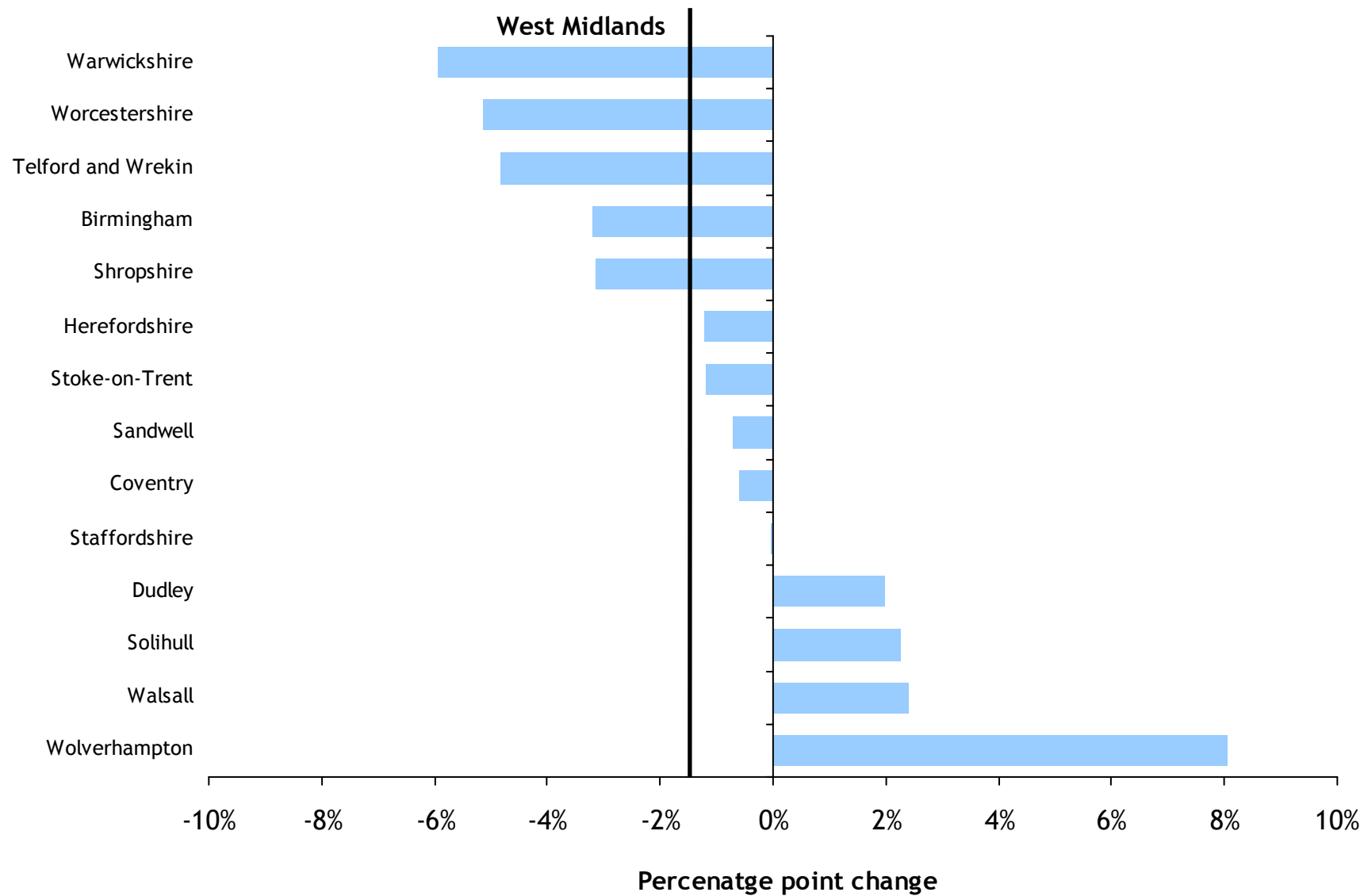
26 Proportion of the working age population 19+ with no qualifications in 2007



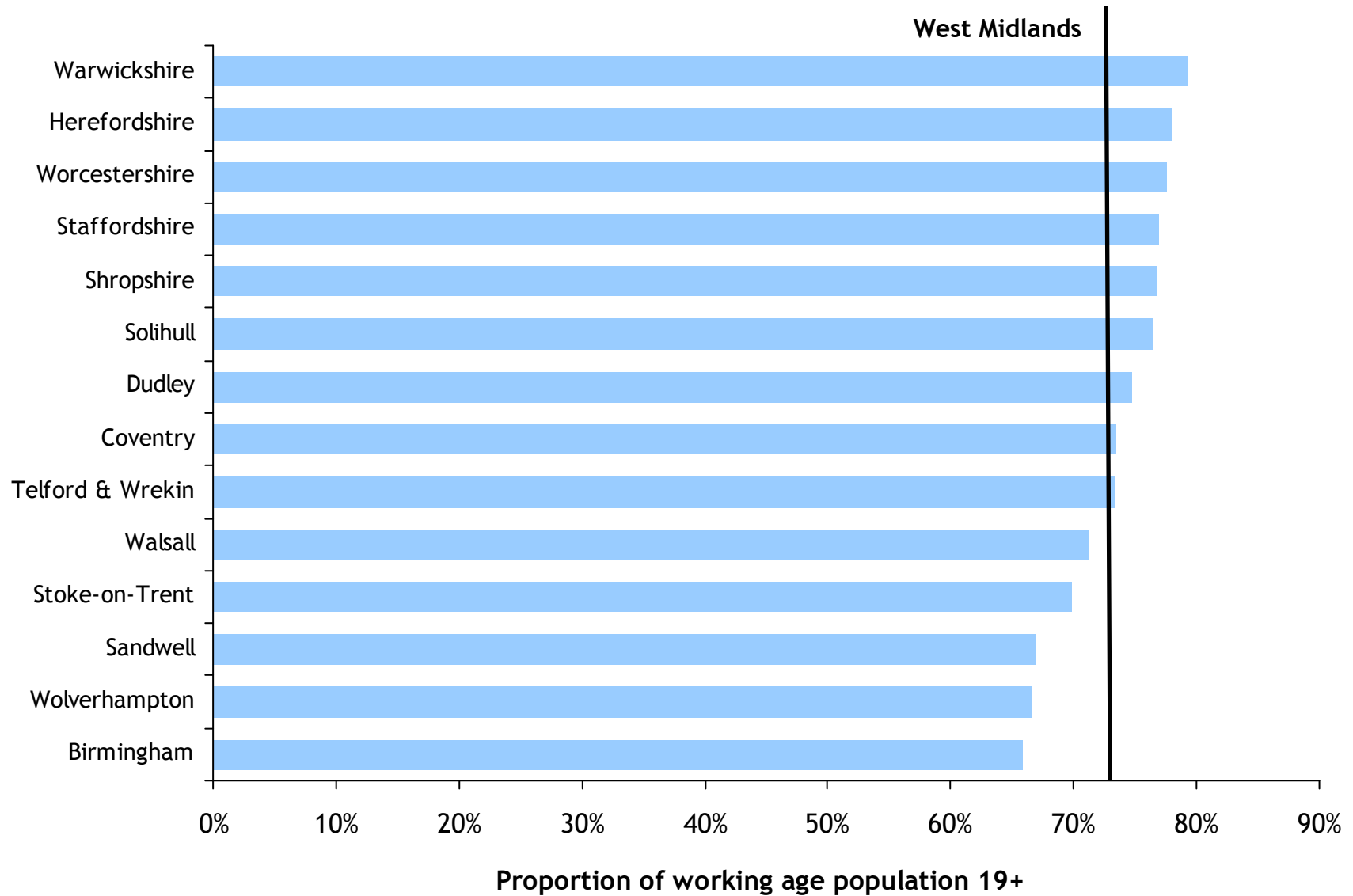
27 Proportion of the working age population 19+ with Level 4+ qualifications in 2007



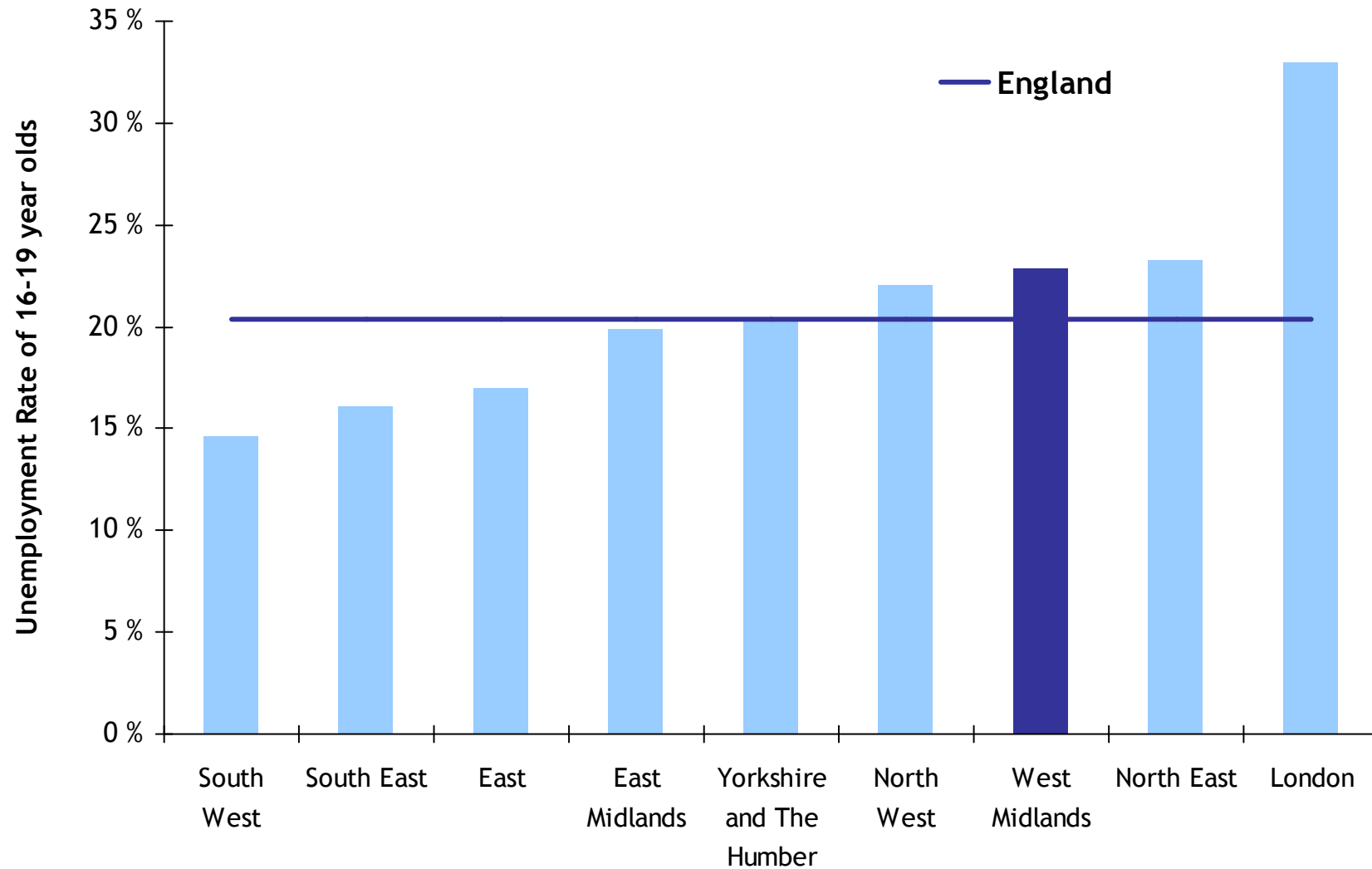
28 Proportion of the working age population 19+ with no qualifications 2003-2007



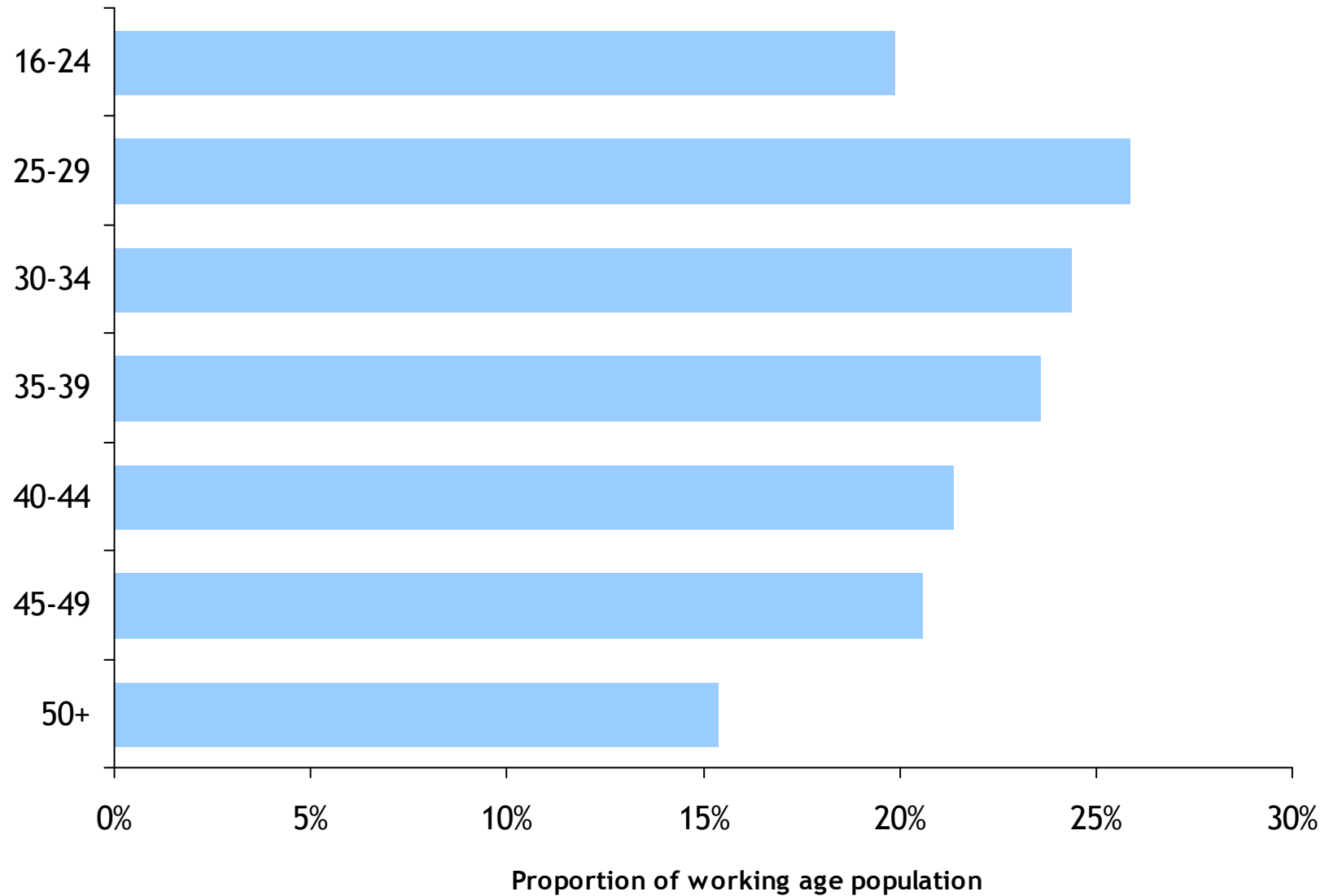
29 Employment rate 19+ in the West Midlands sub-regions in 2007



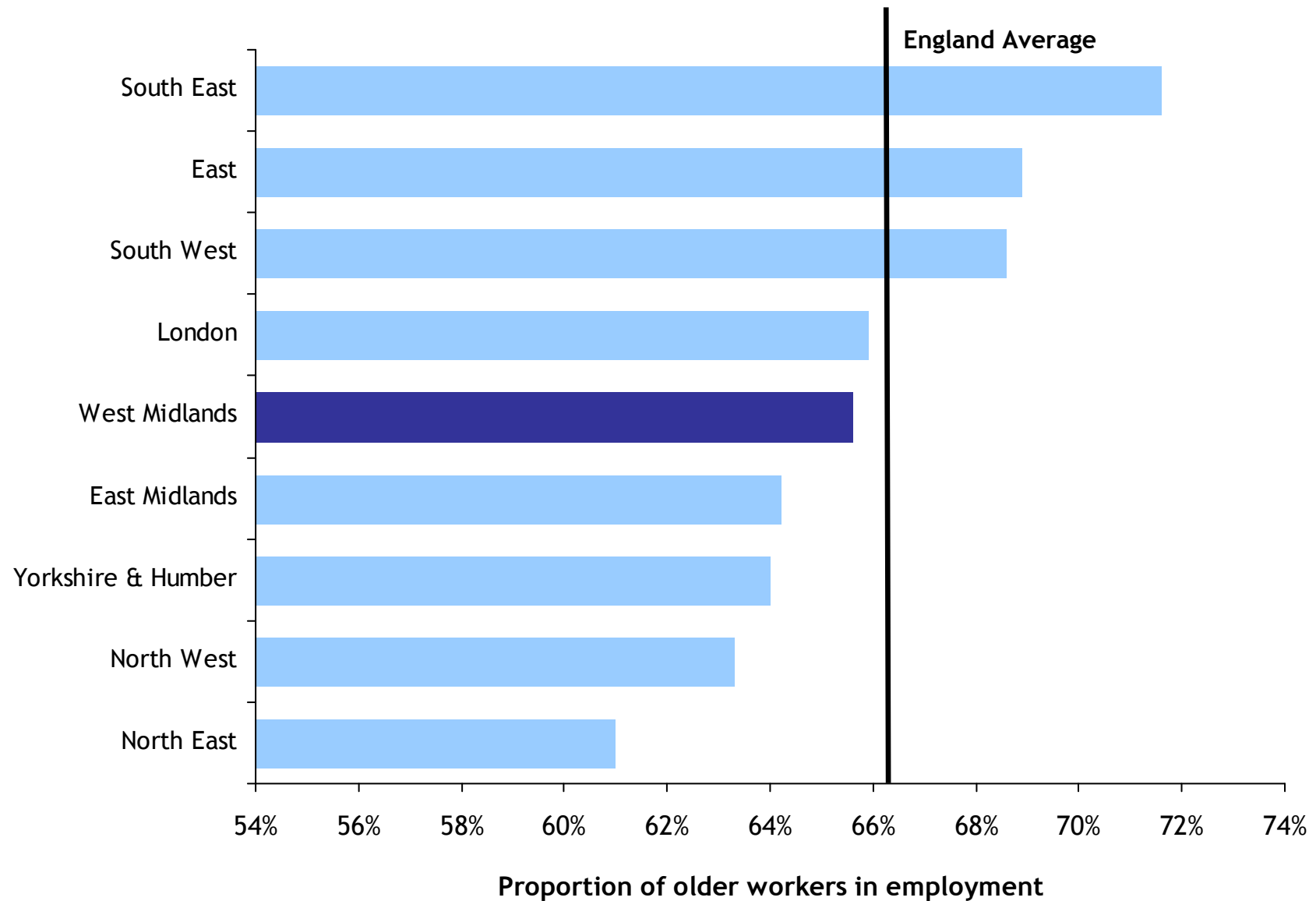
30 Youth unemployment rates by region



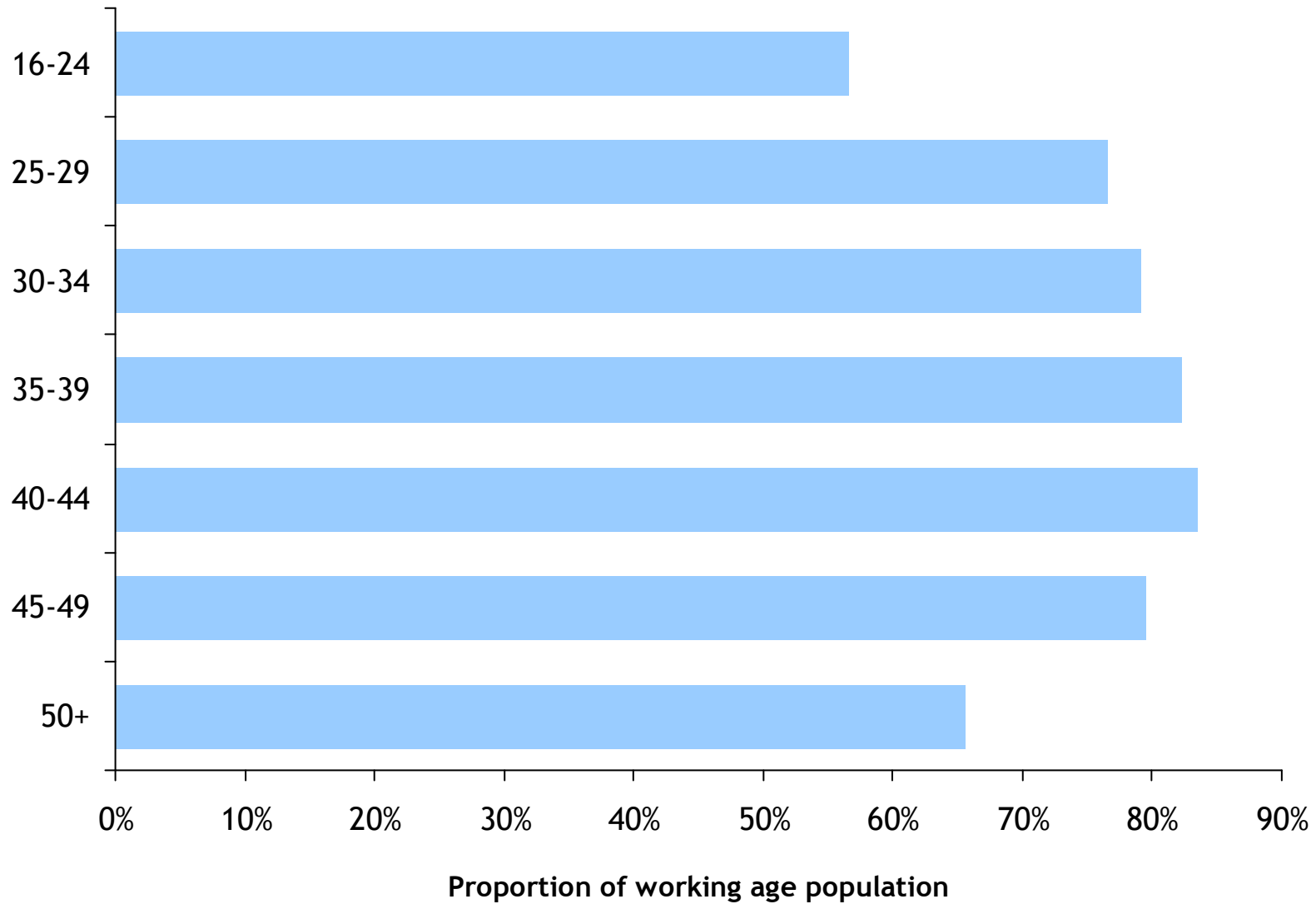
31 Proportion of adults receiving work-related training in last 13 weeks, by age



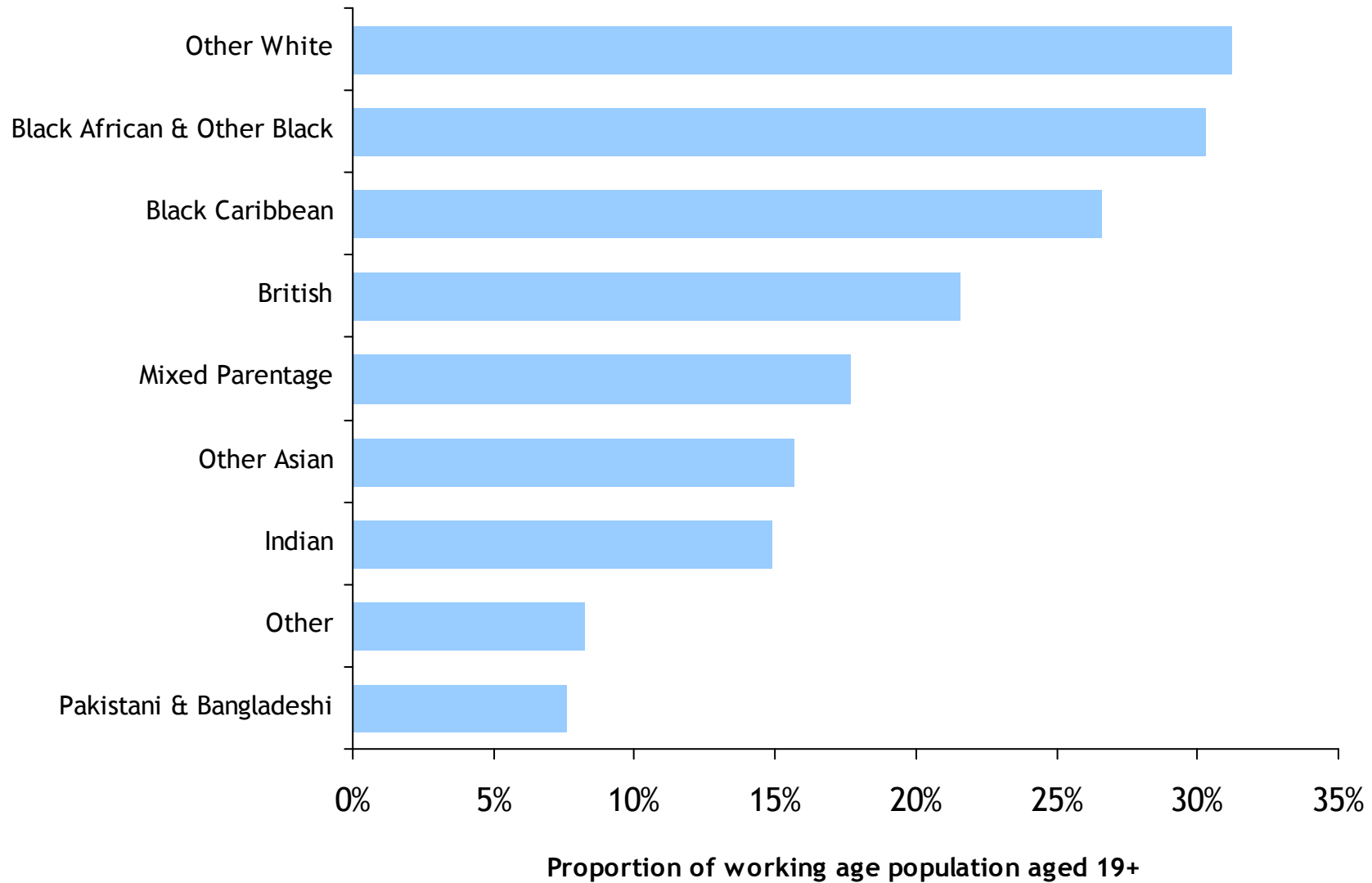
32 Older workers employment rates by Region



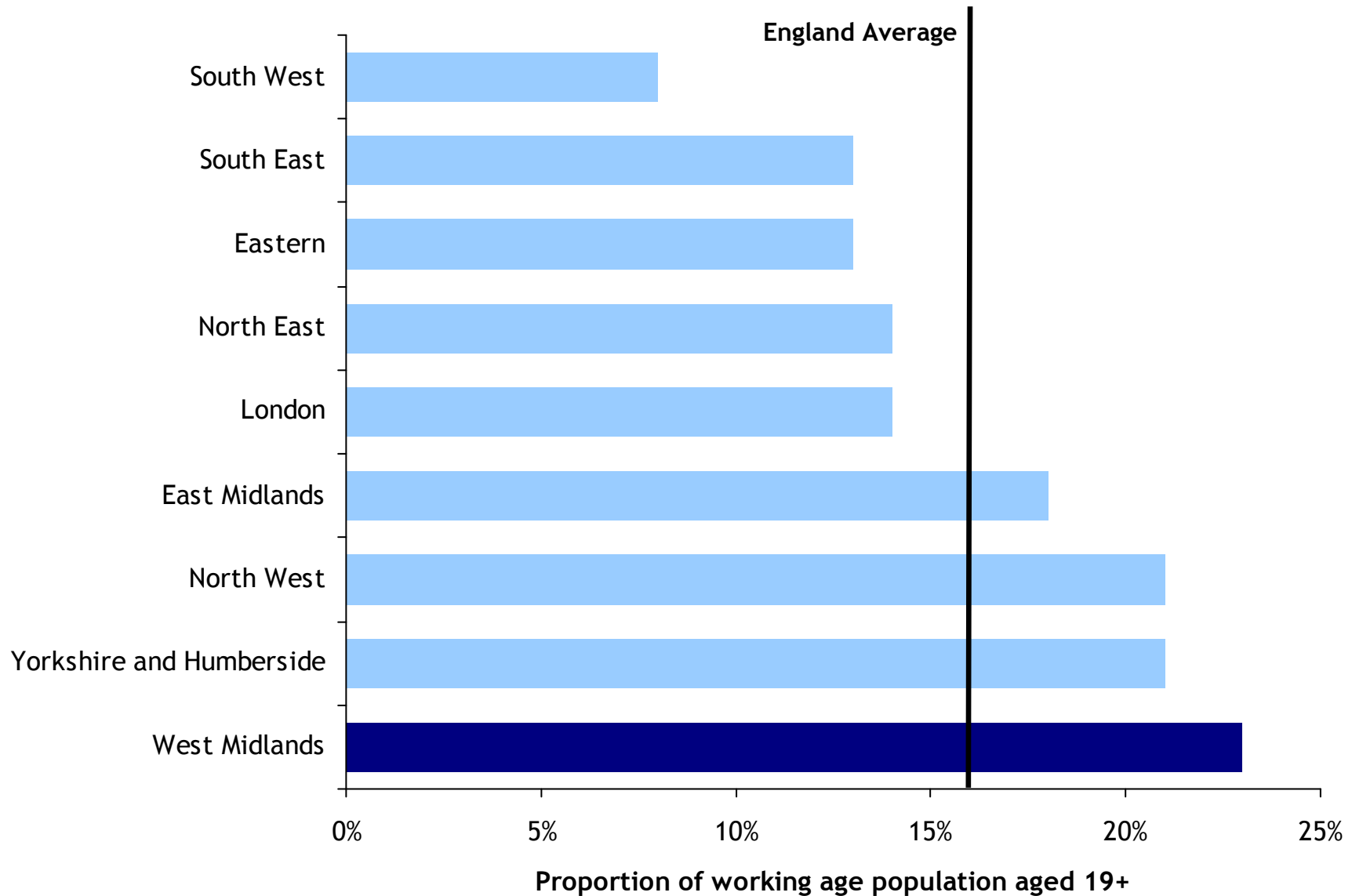

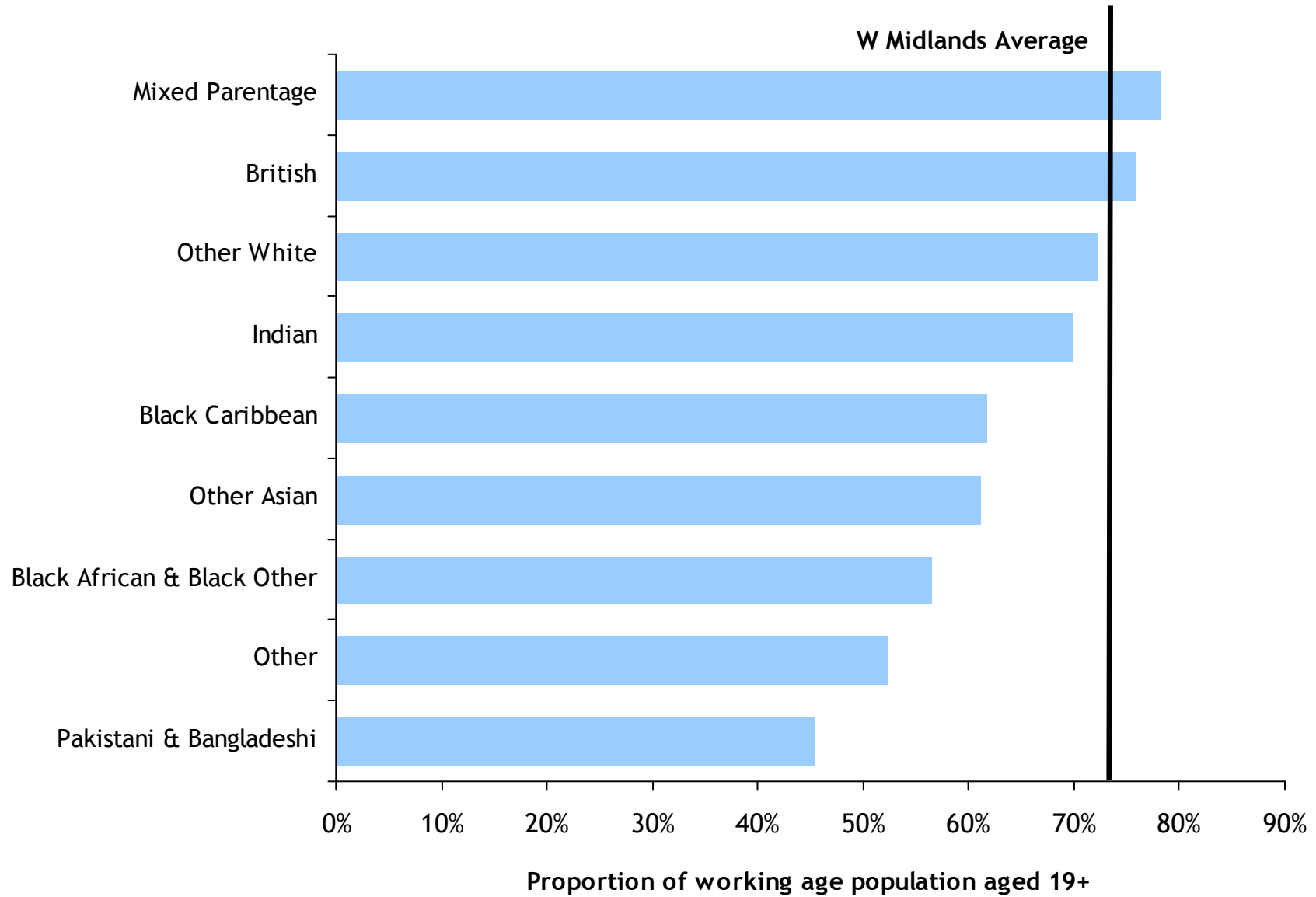
34 Proportion of adults receiving work-related training in last 13 weeks, by ethnic group
