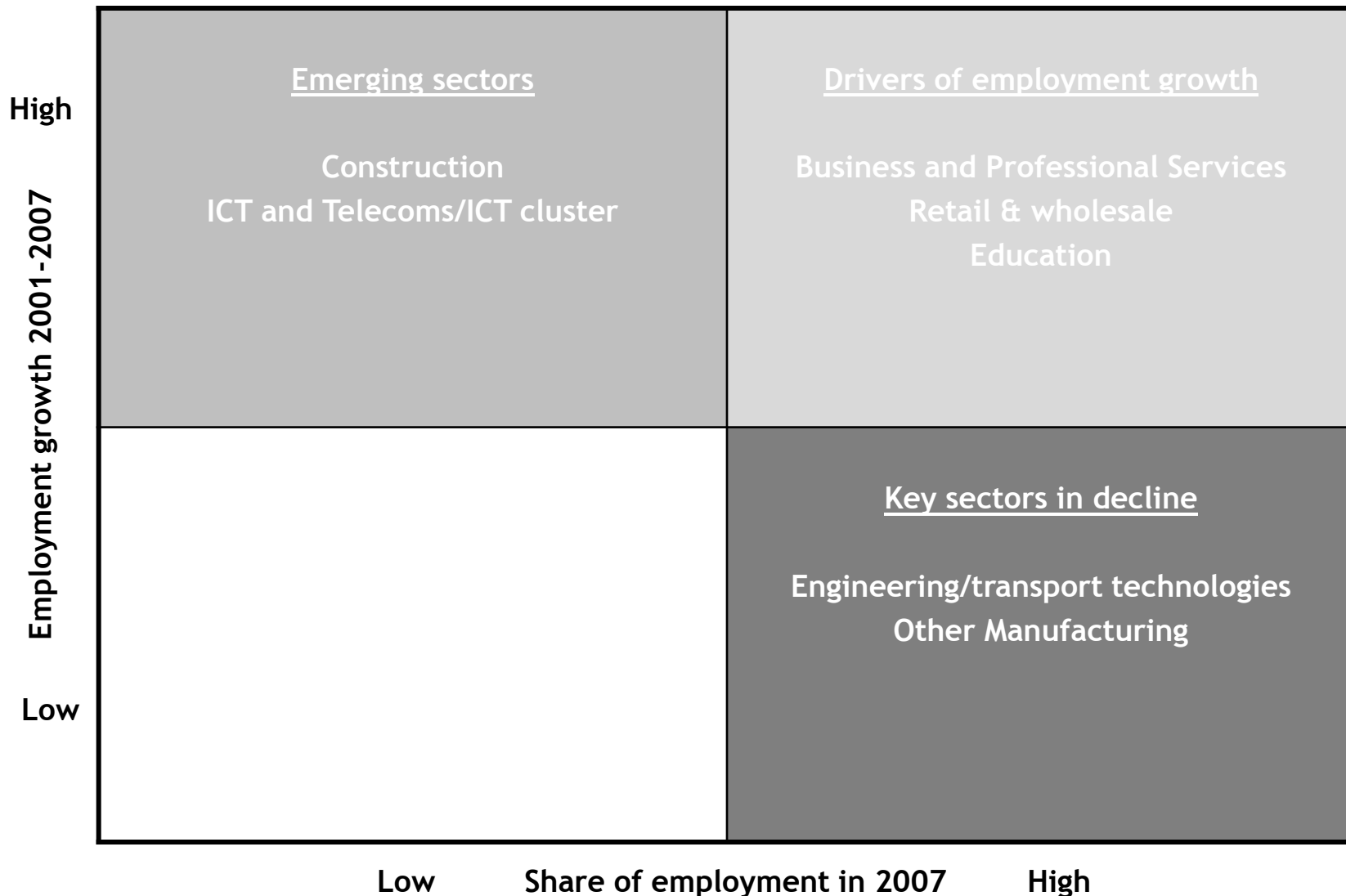

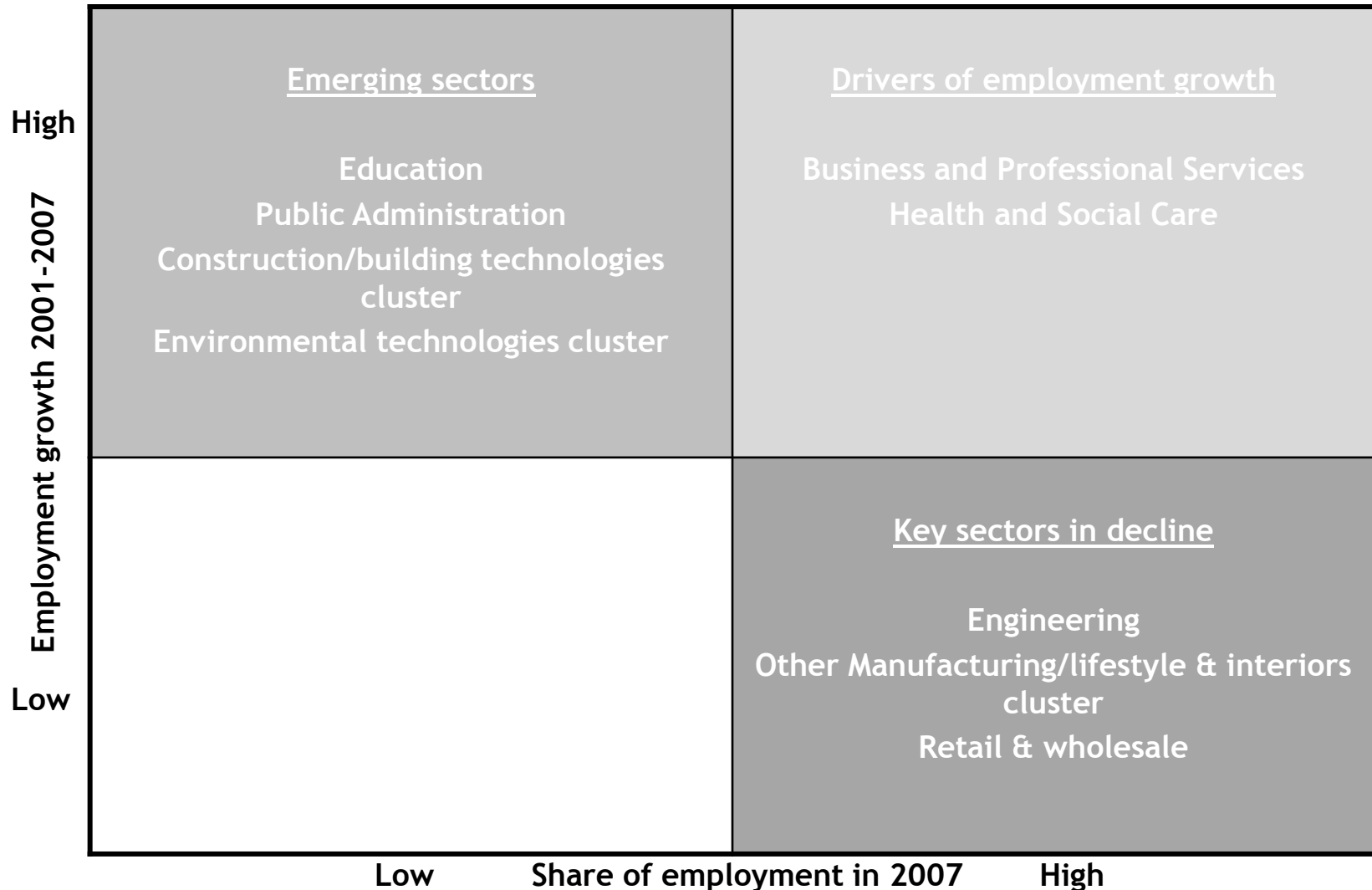

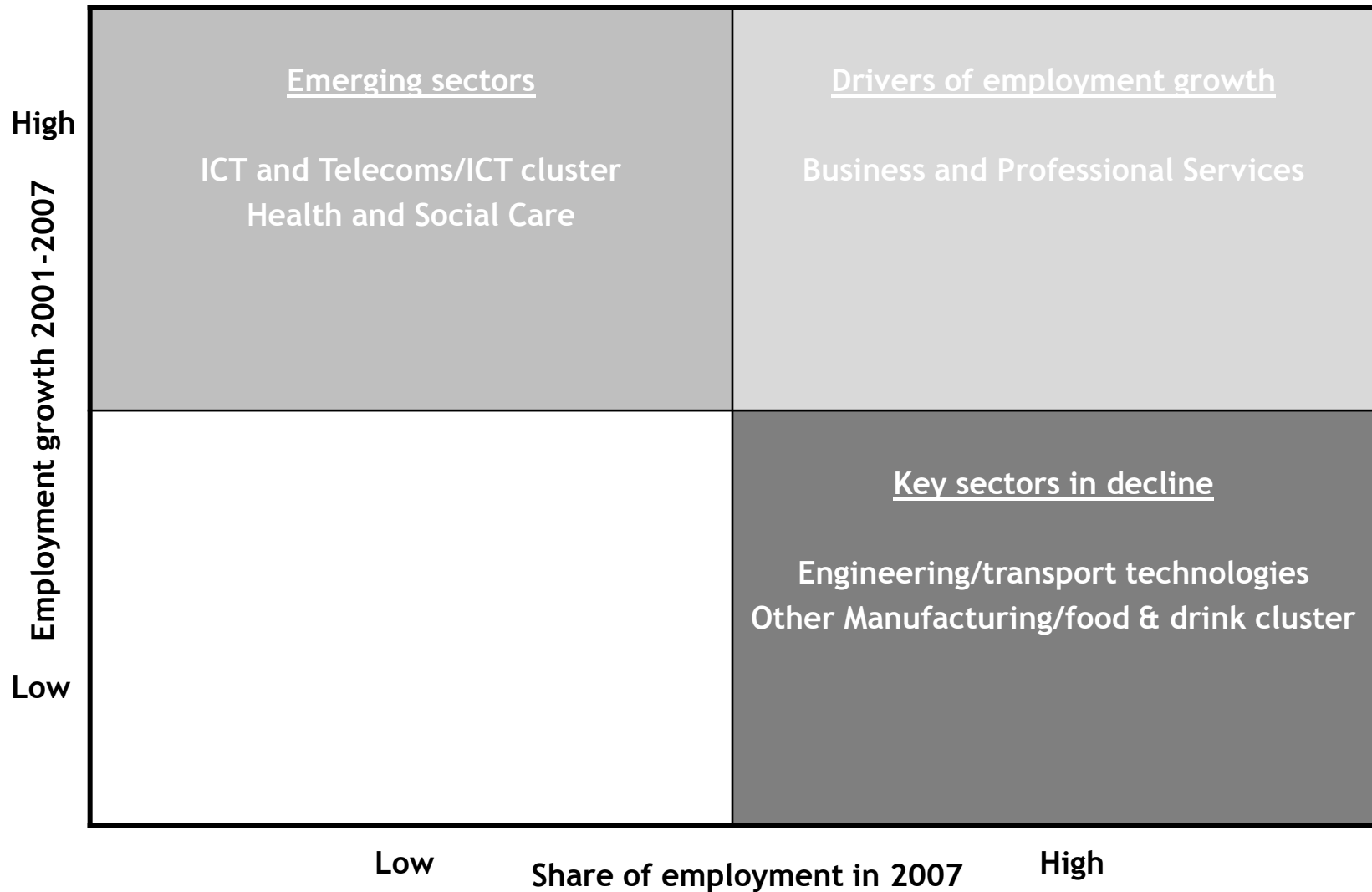

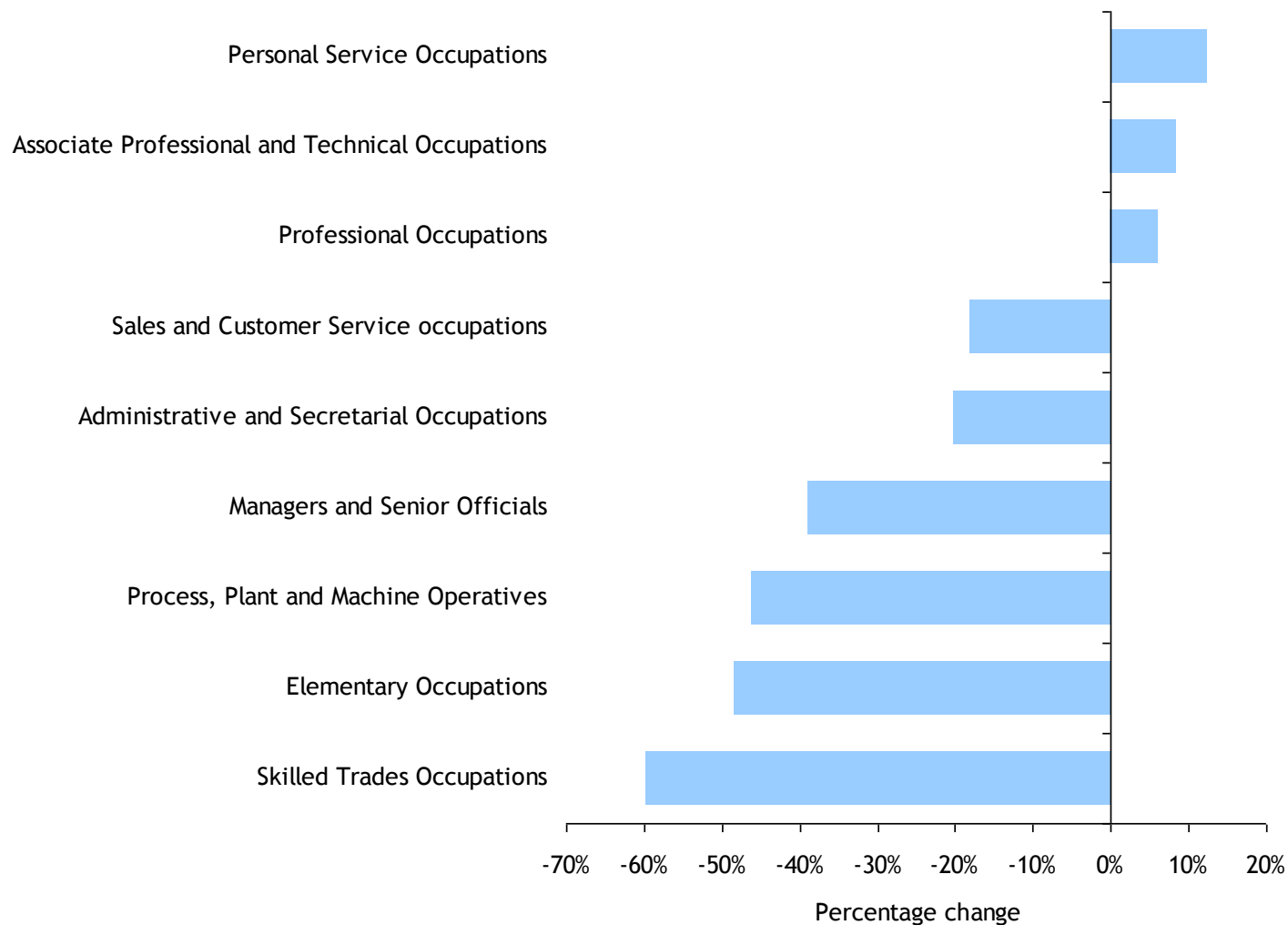

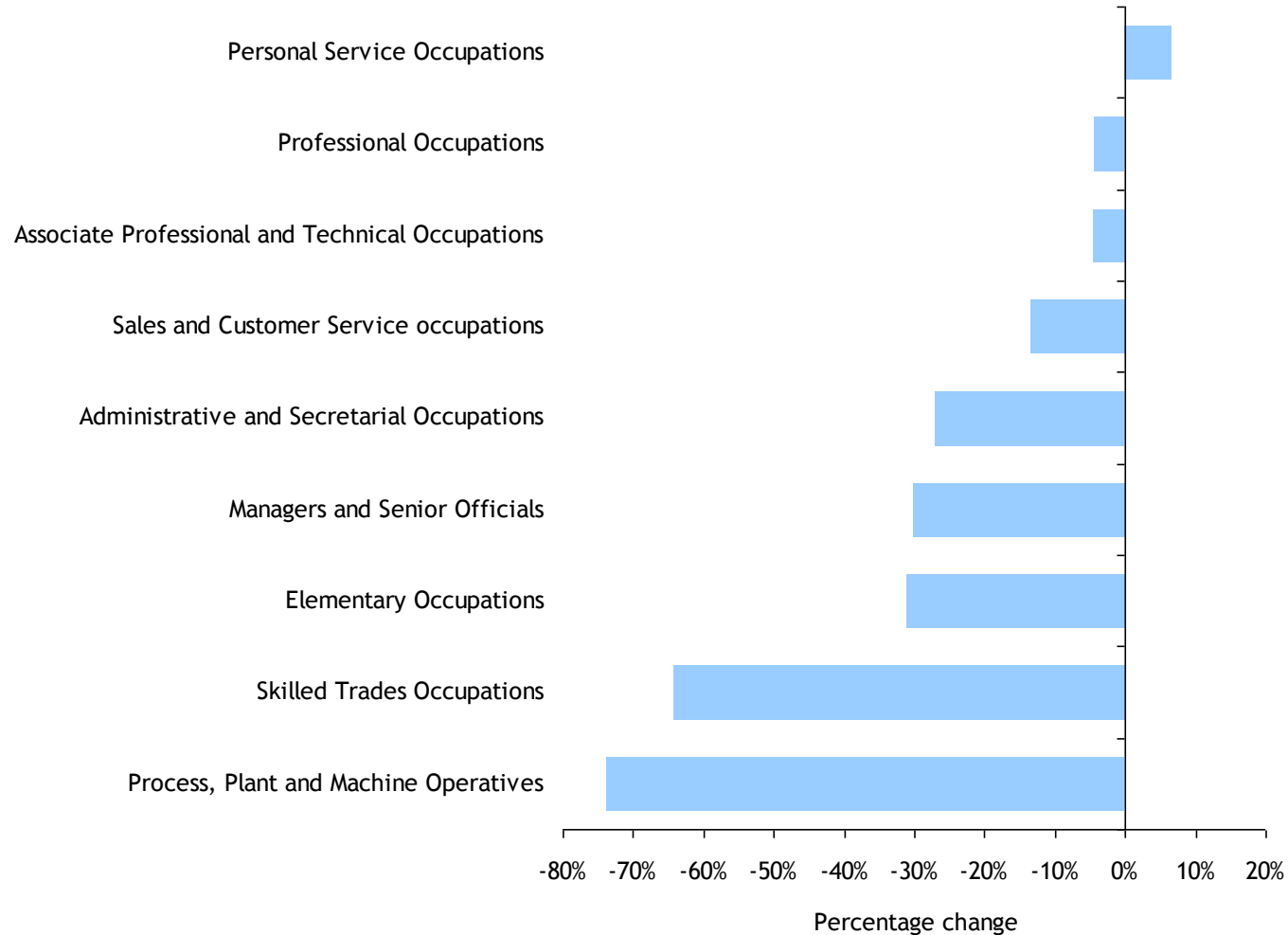

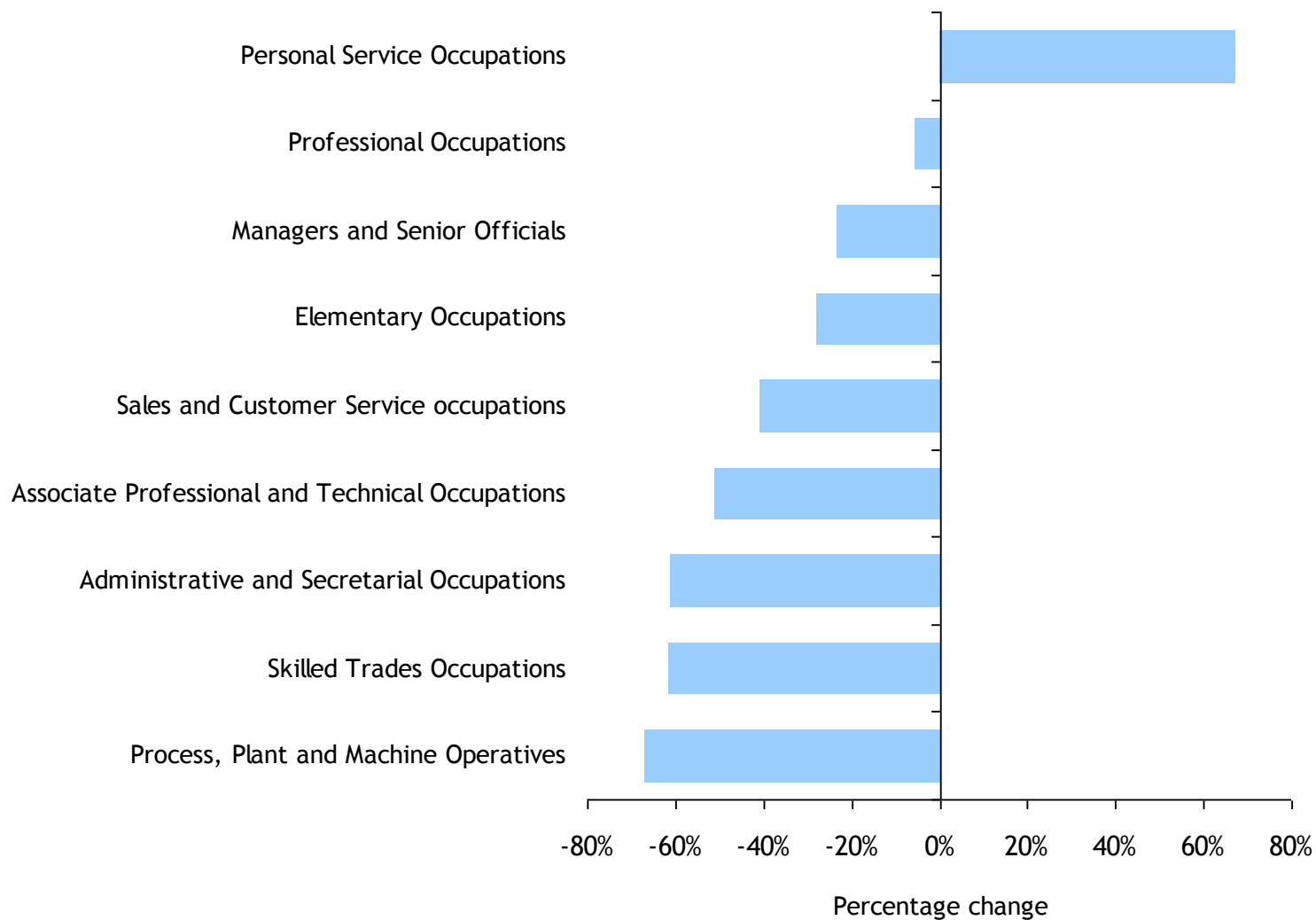
# Percentage change in notified vacancies by occupation June 2008 - June 2009, Birmingham & Solihull



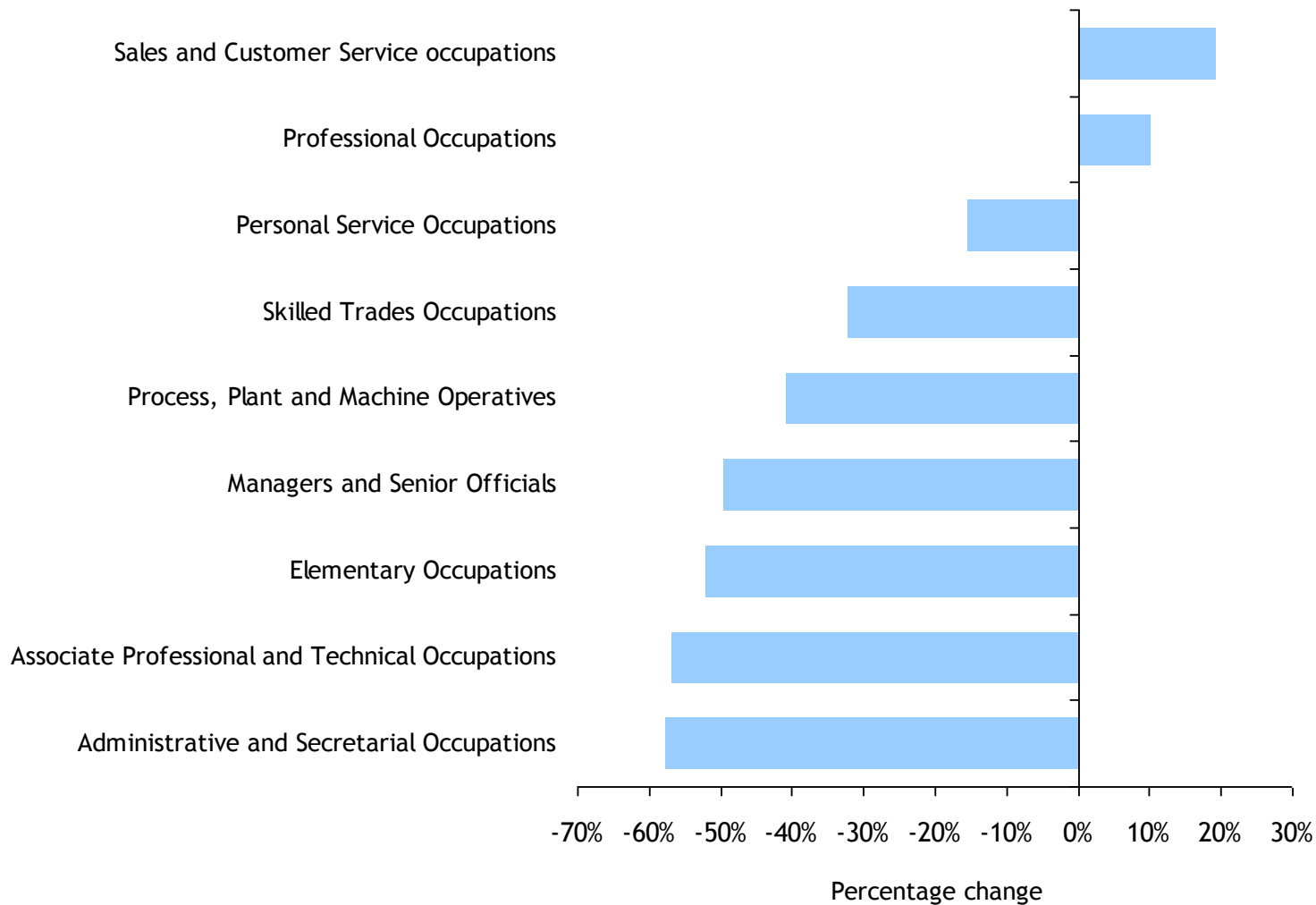
# Percentage change in notified vacancies by occupation June 2008 - June 2009, Coventry & Warwickshire



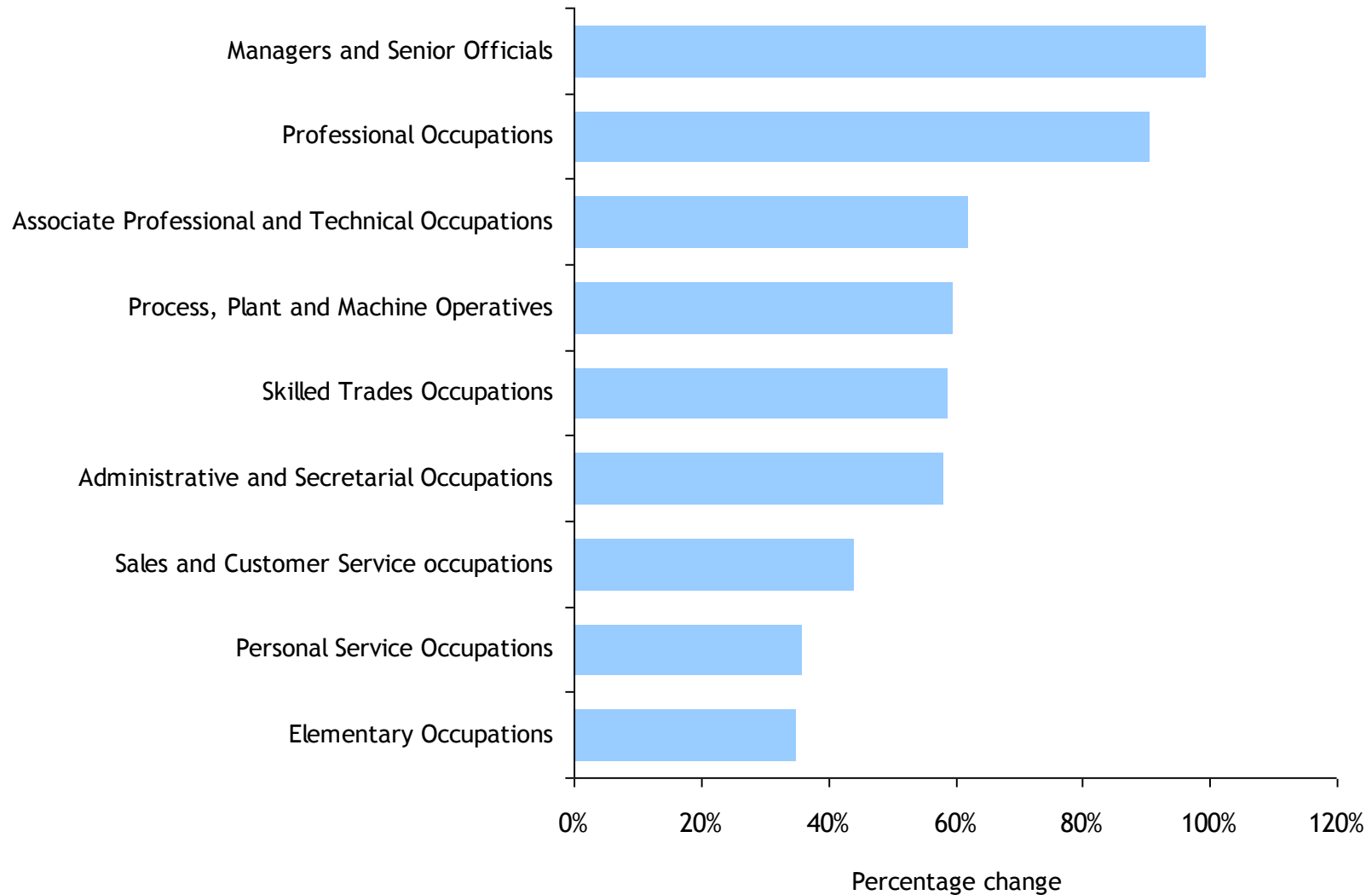
# Percentage change in notified vacancies by occupation June 2008 - June 2009, the Black Country



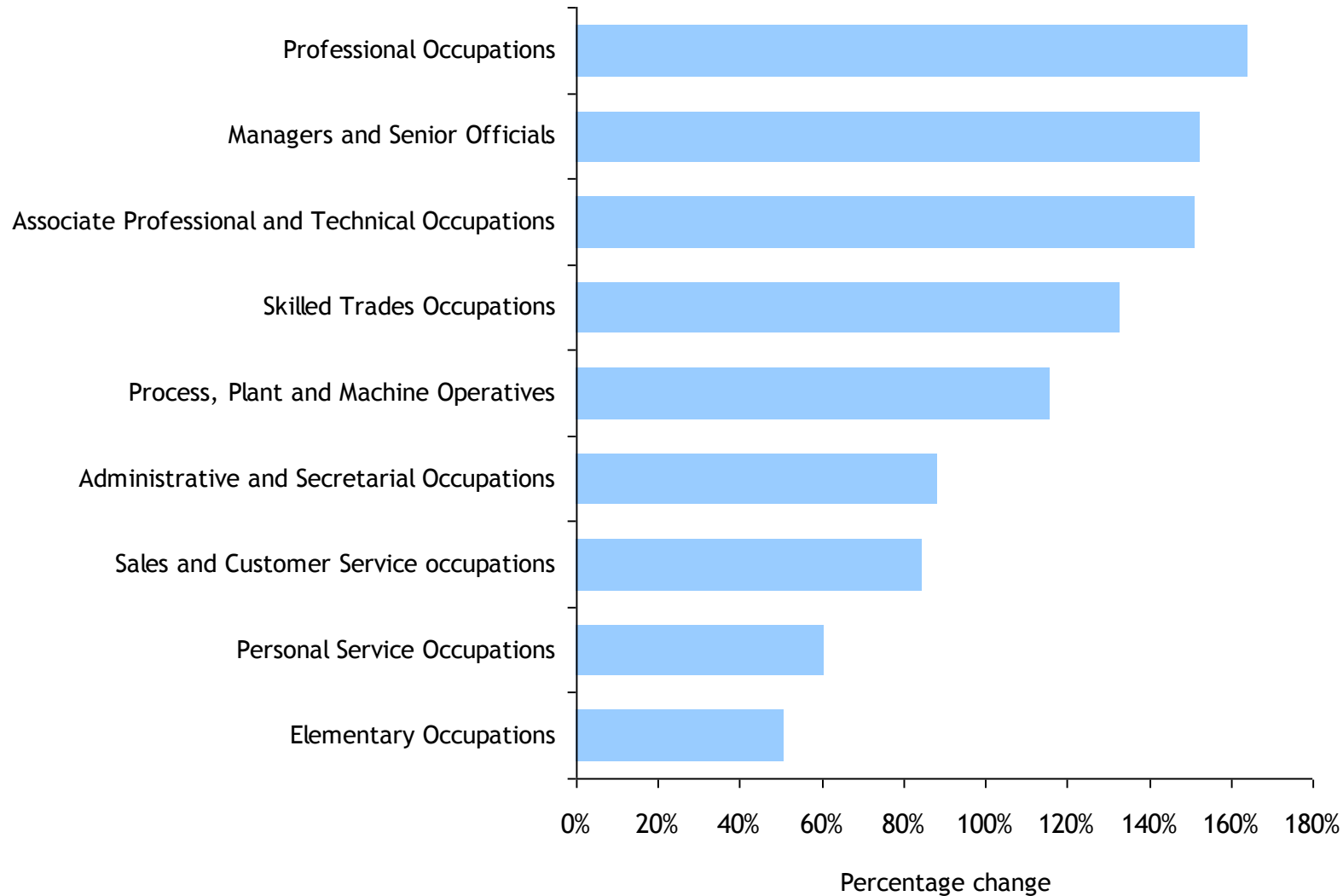

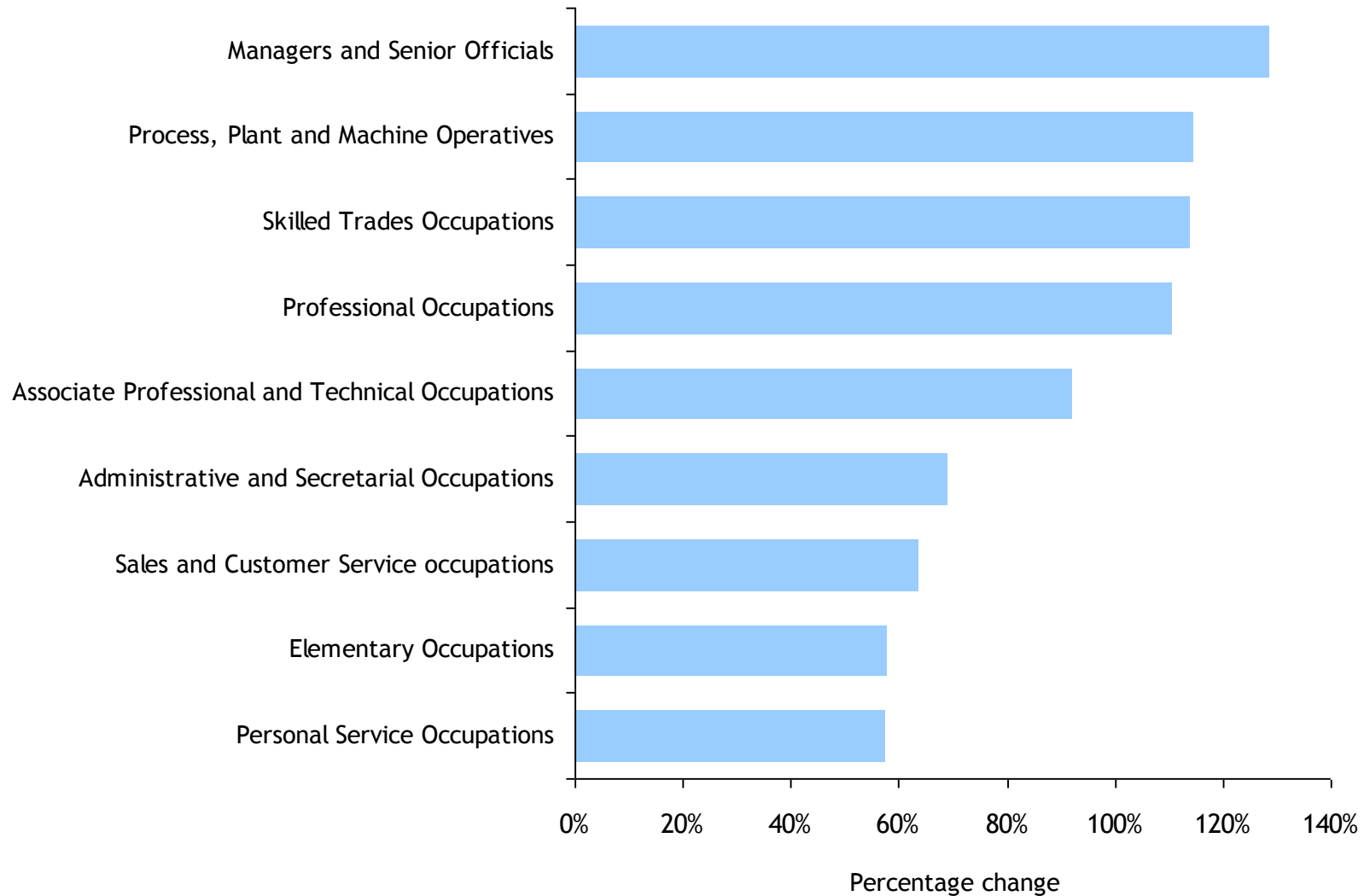
# Percentage change in claimant unemployed by occupation June 2008 - June 2009, Birmingham & Solihull



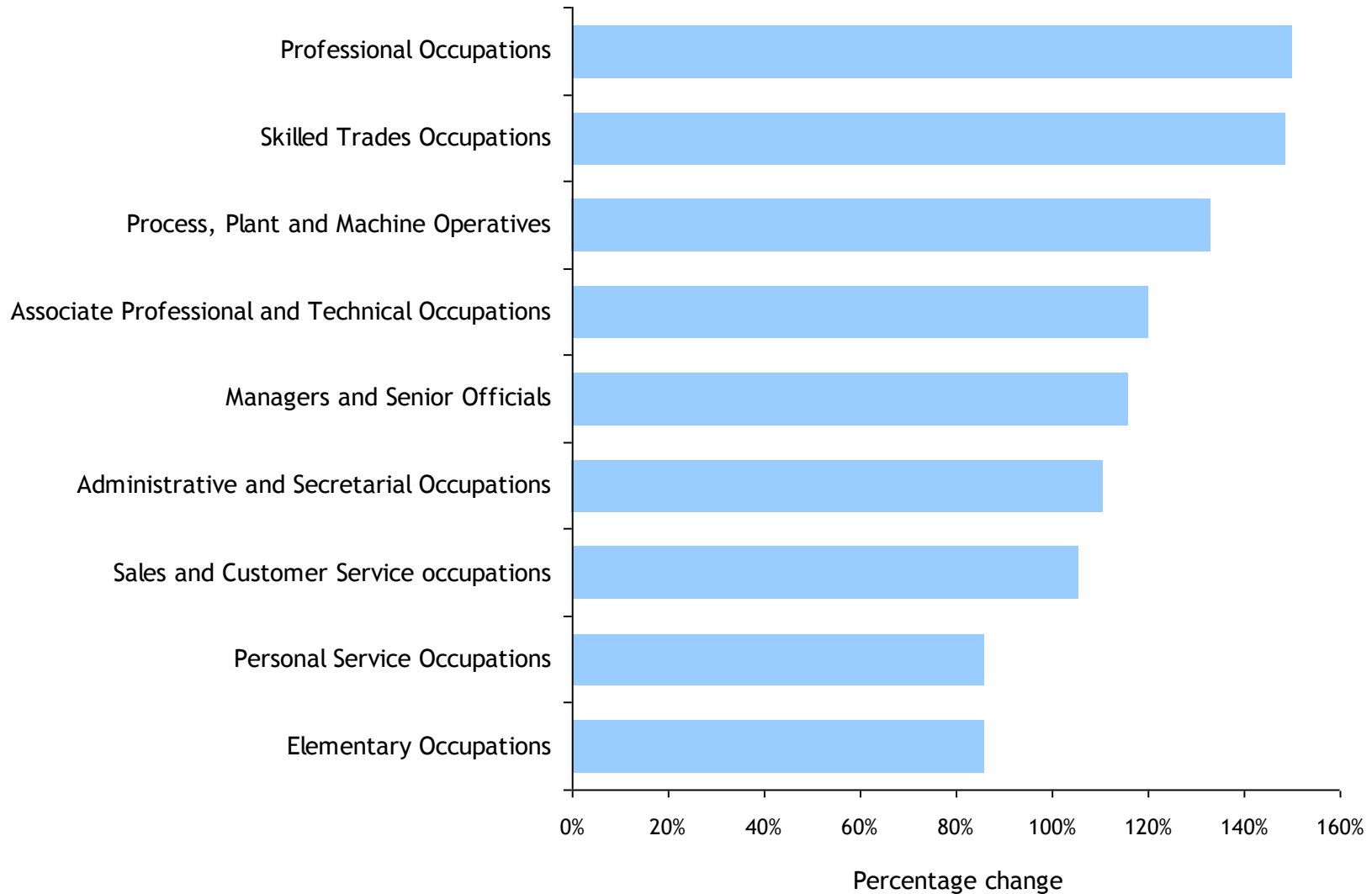
# Percentage change in claimant unemployed by occupation June 2008 - June 2009, Coventry & Warwickshire



# Percentage change in claimant unemployed by occupation June 2008 - June 2009, the Black Country

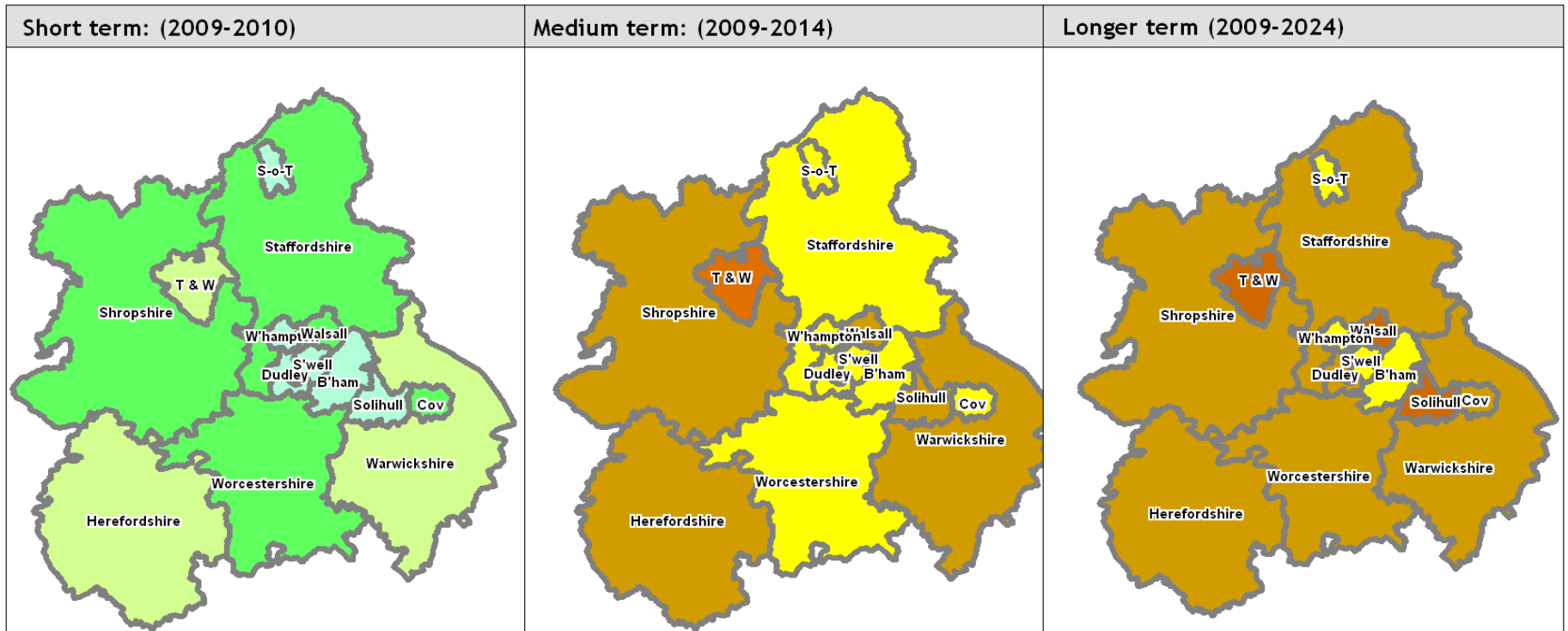

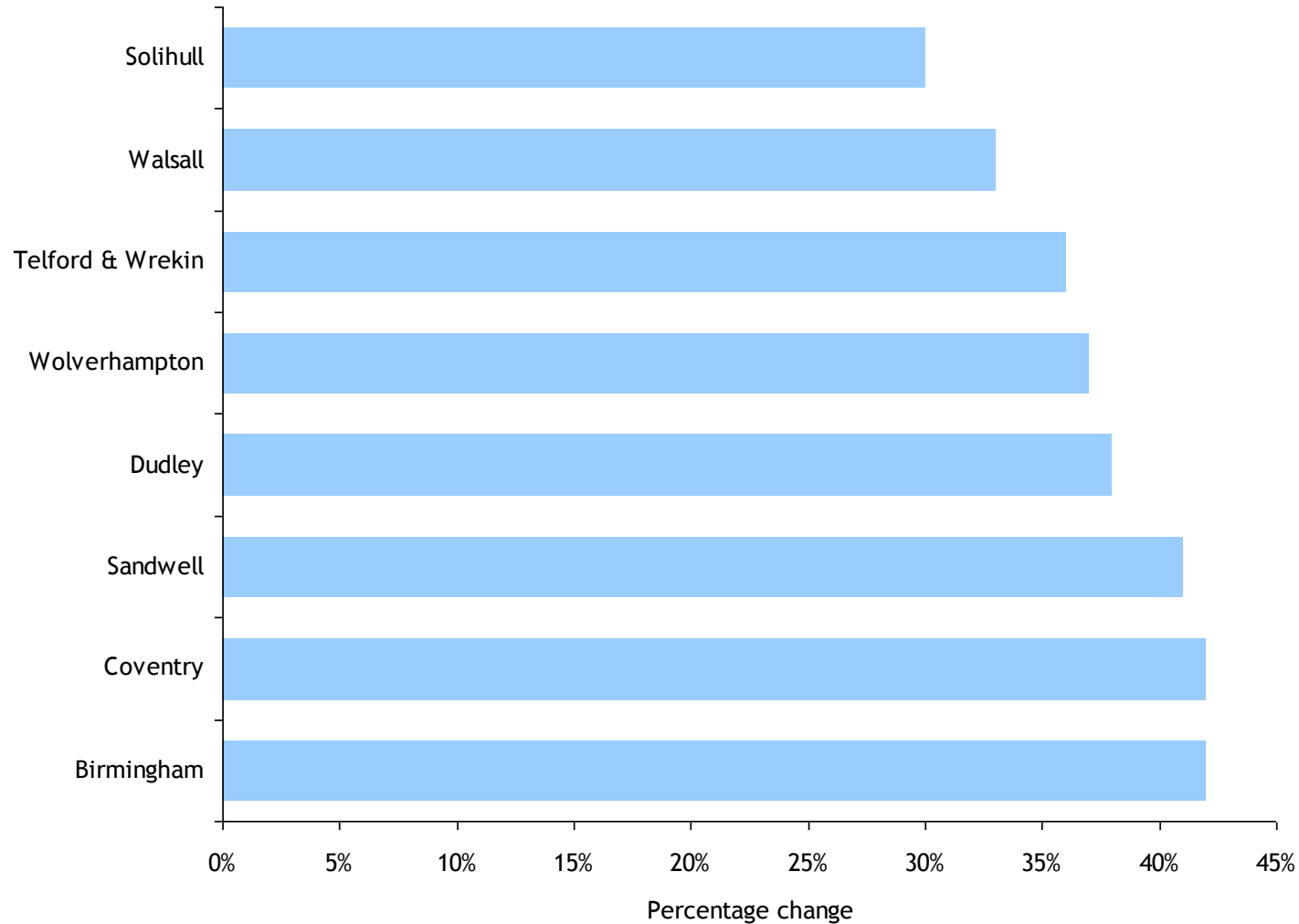
- Dark brown: V significant increase (45+)

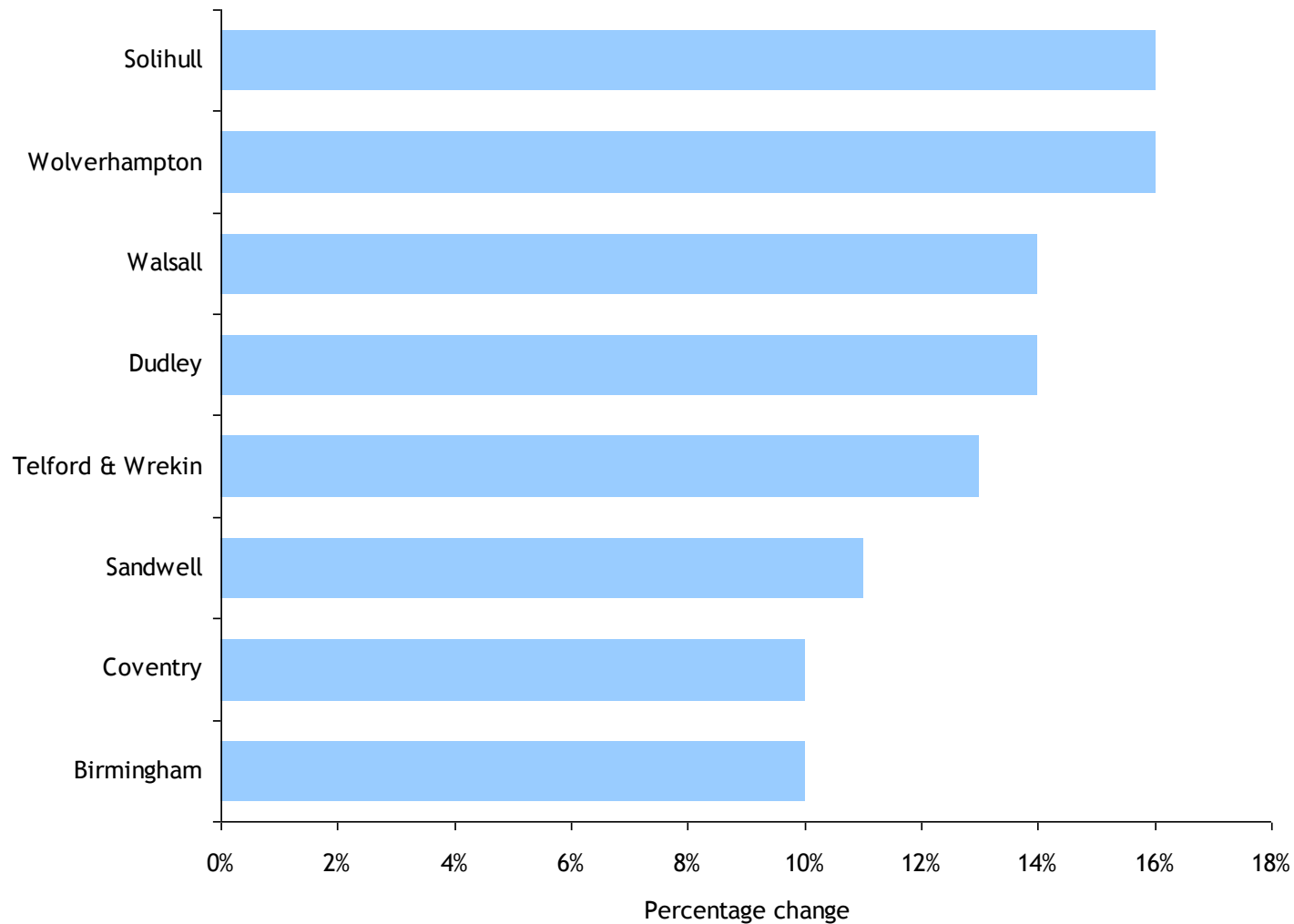
# Proportion of the working age population aged under 35 in 2008 by Local Authority area

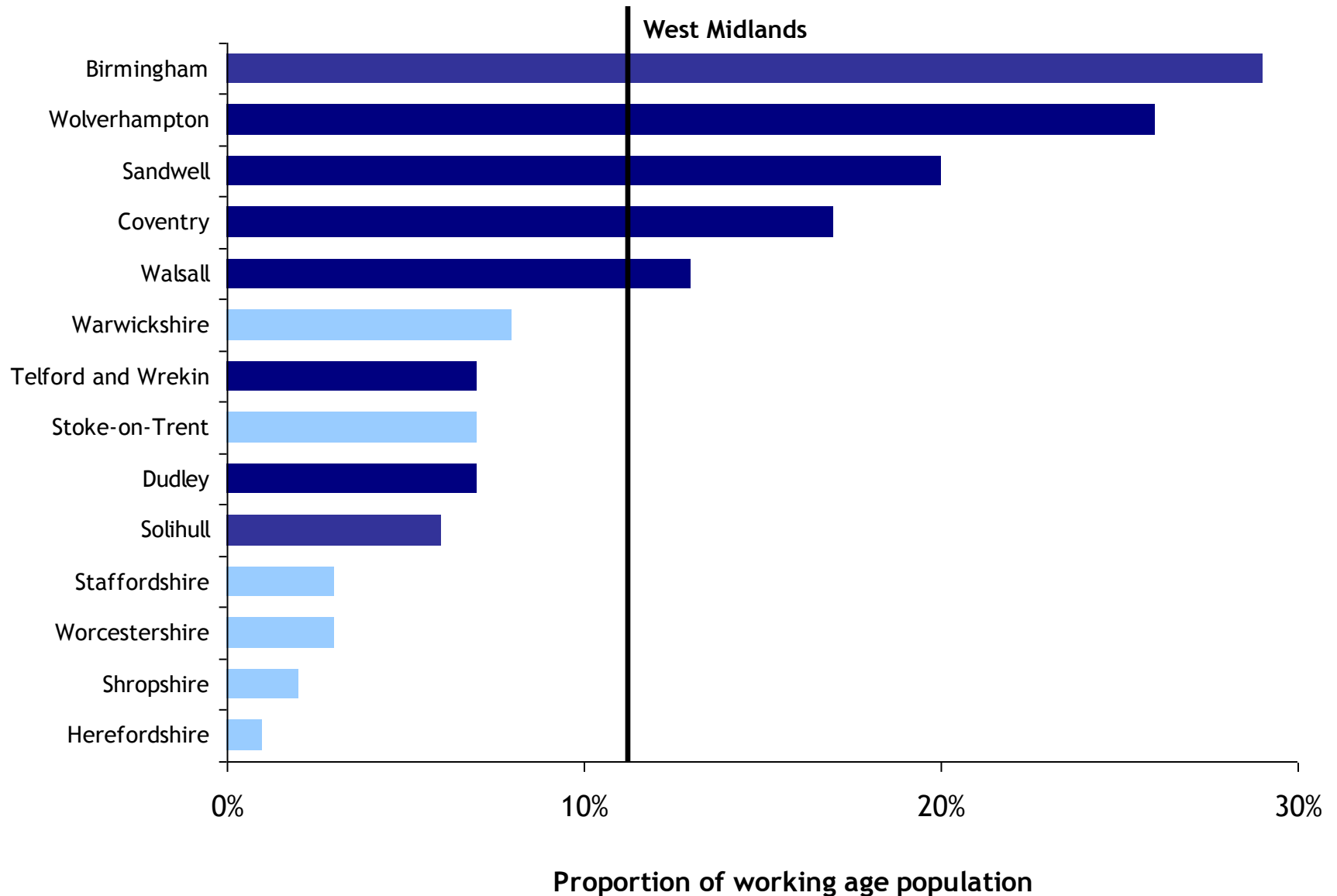


# Proportion of the working age population aged 55 or over in 2008 by Local Authority area

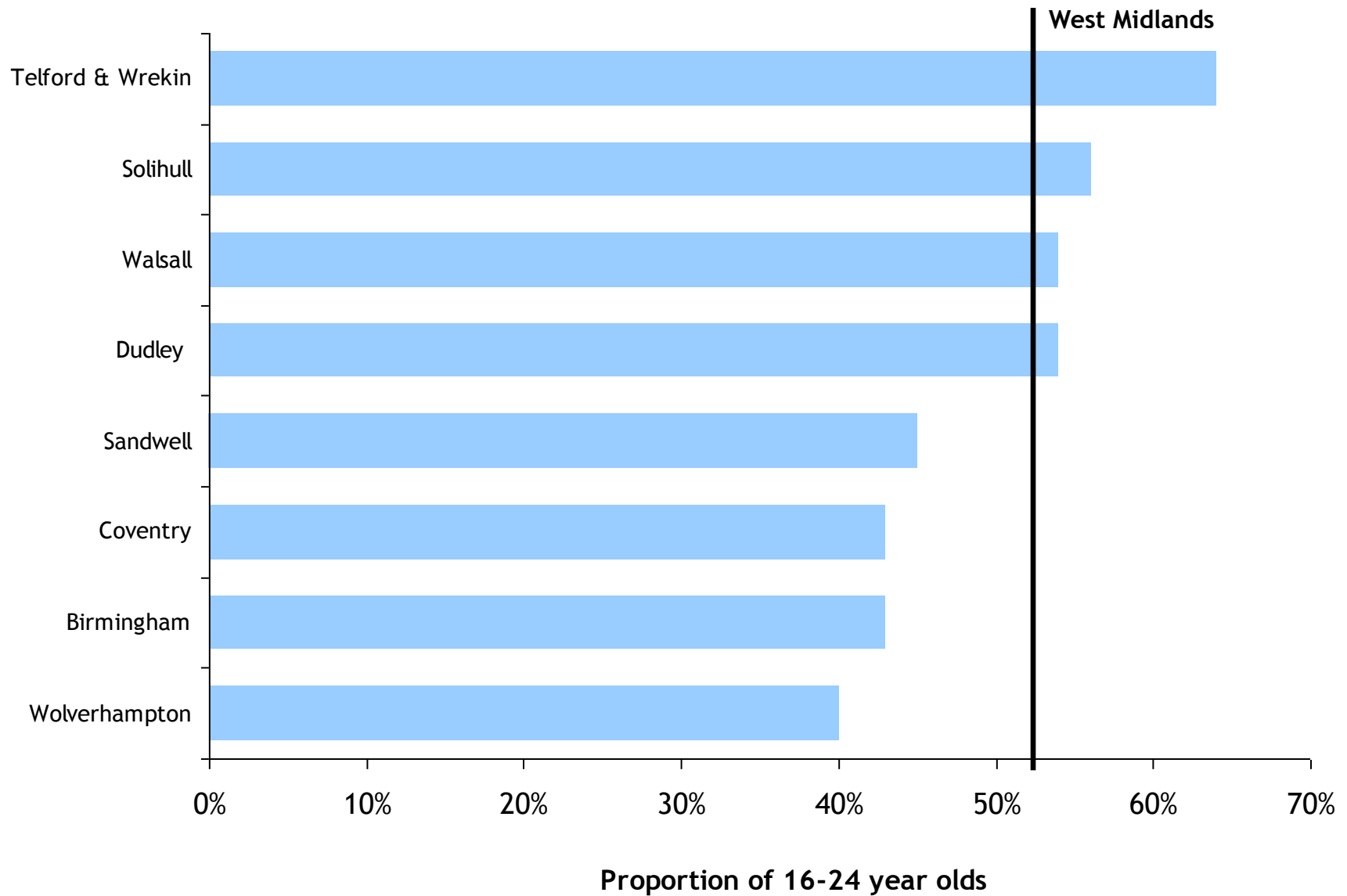

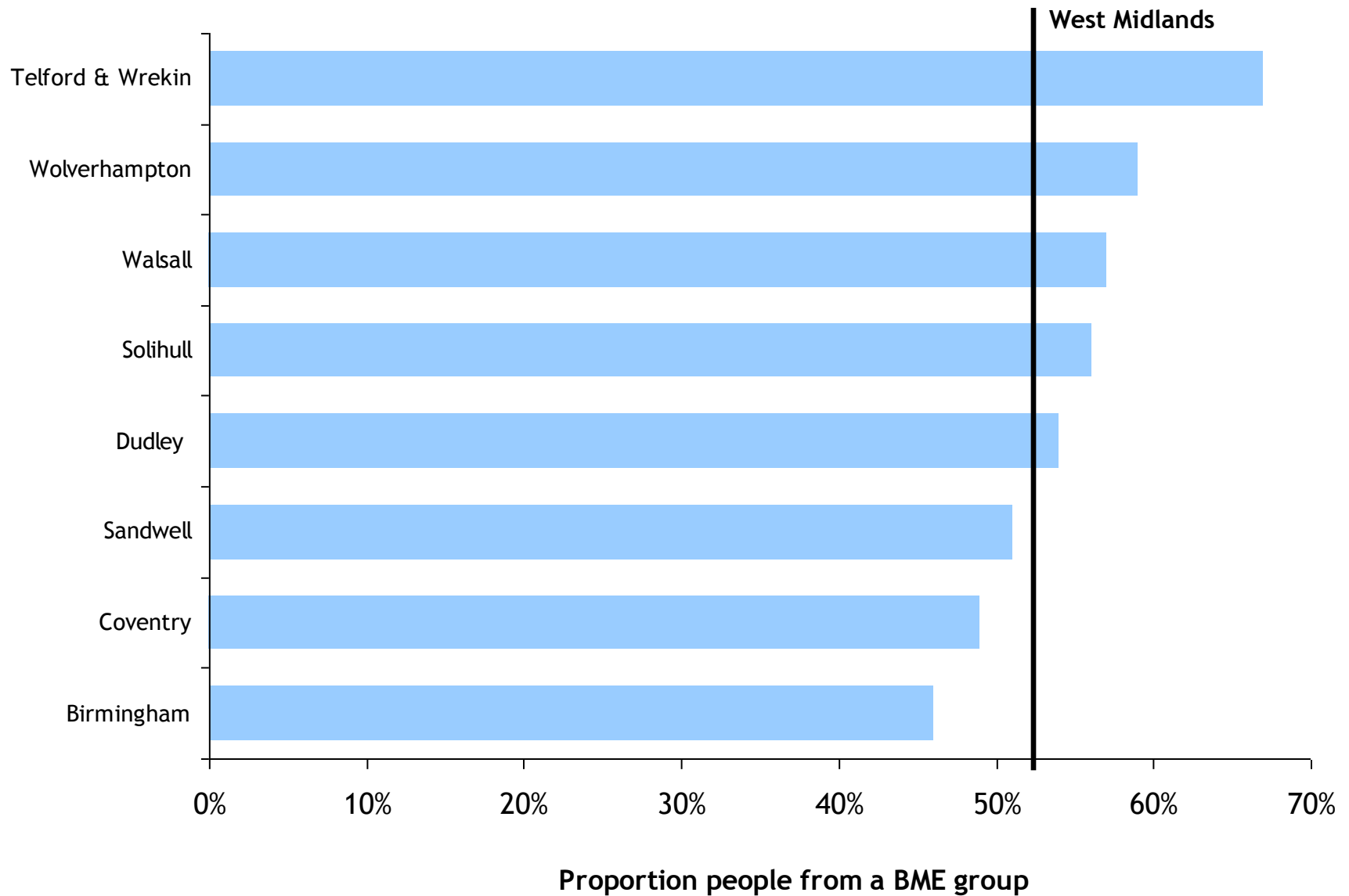
# Proportion of the working age population that is non-white , 2008



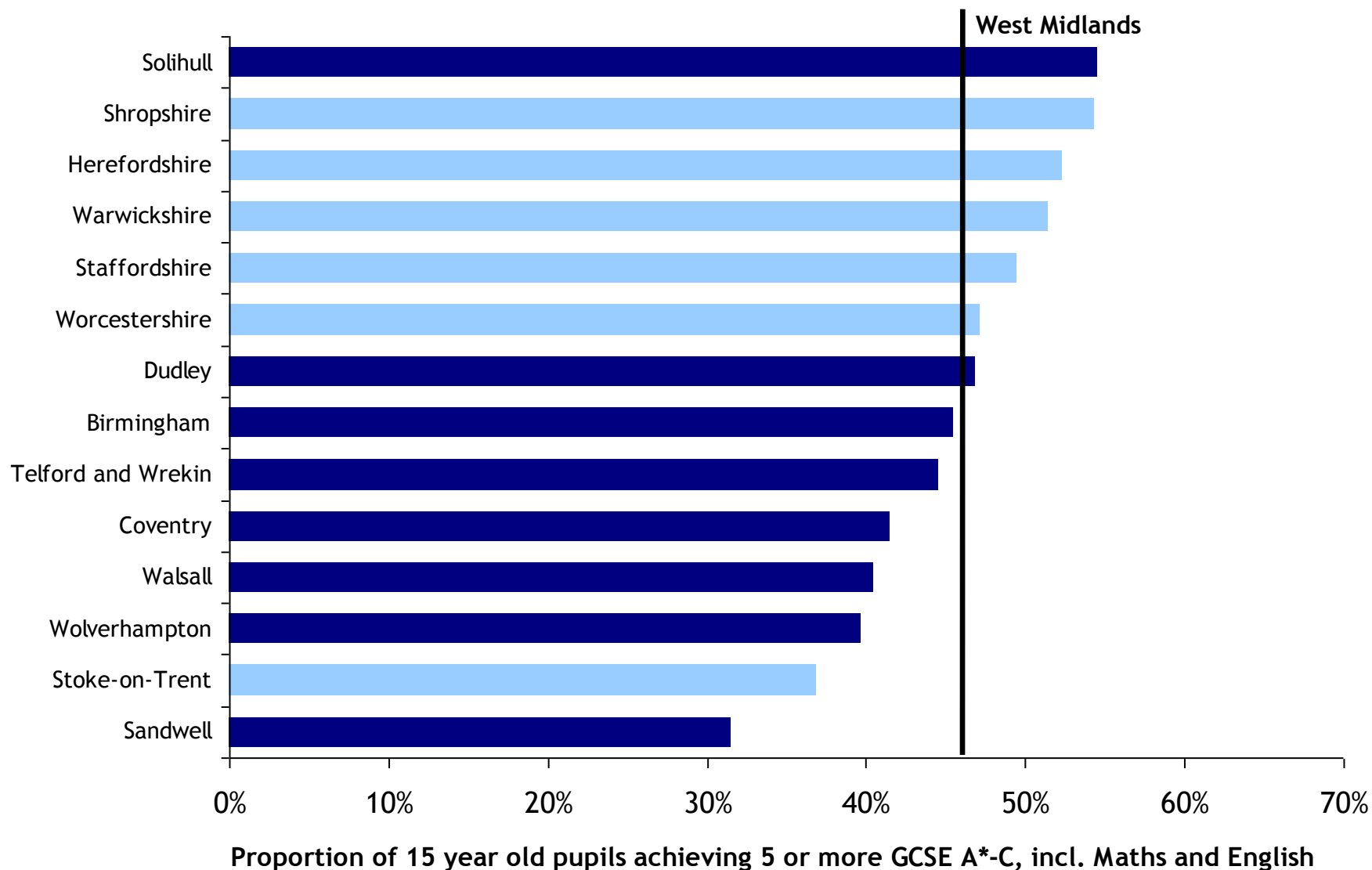
# Proportion of 16-24 year olds in employment, 2008



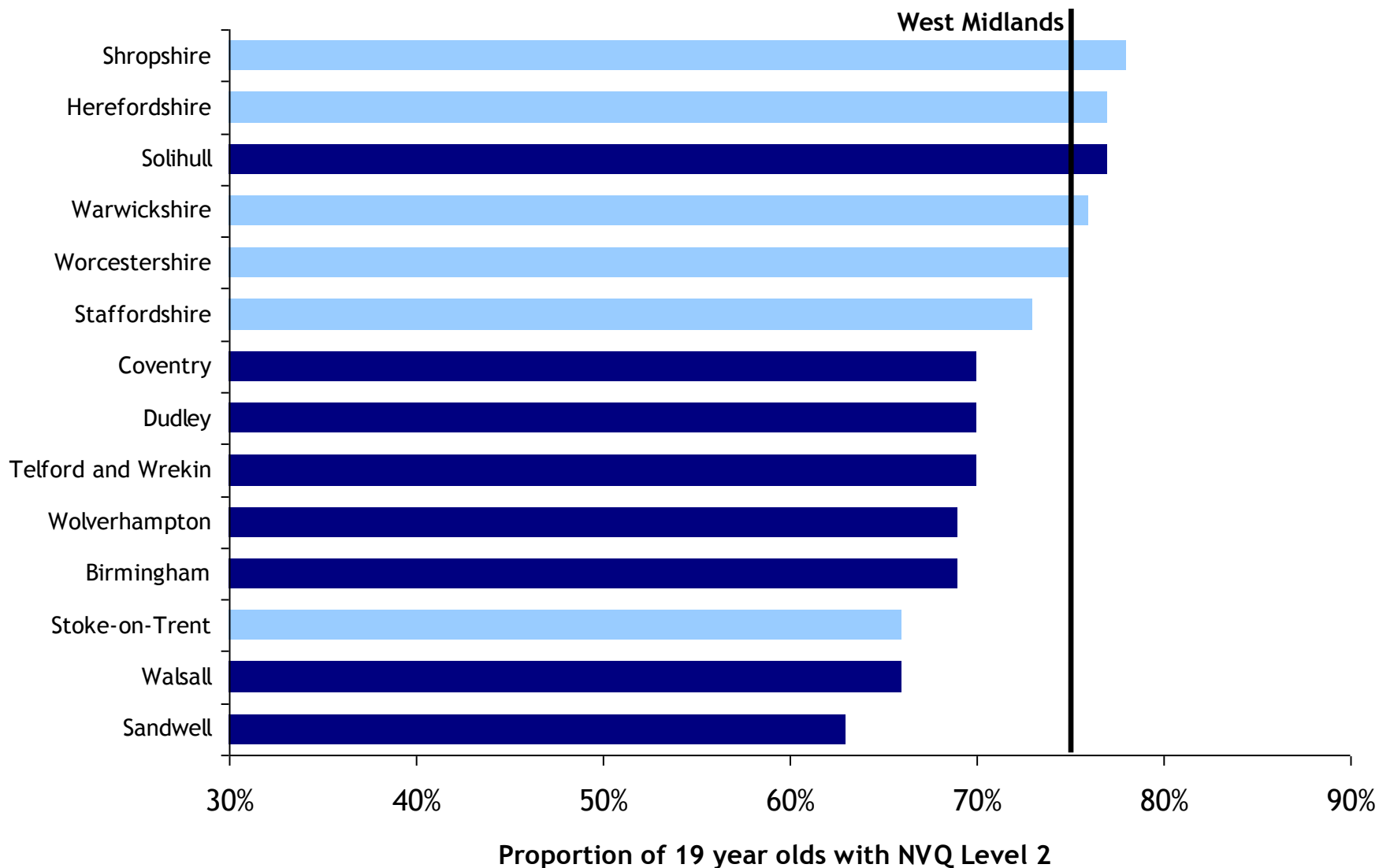
# Proportion of people from a BME group in employment, 2008



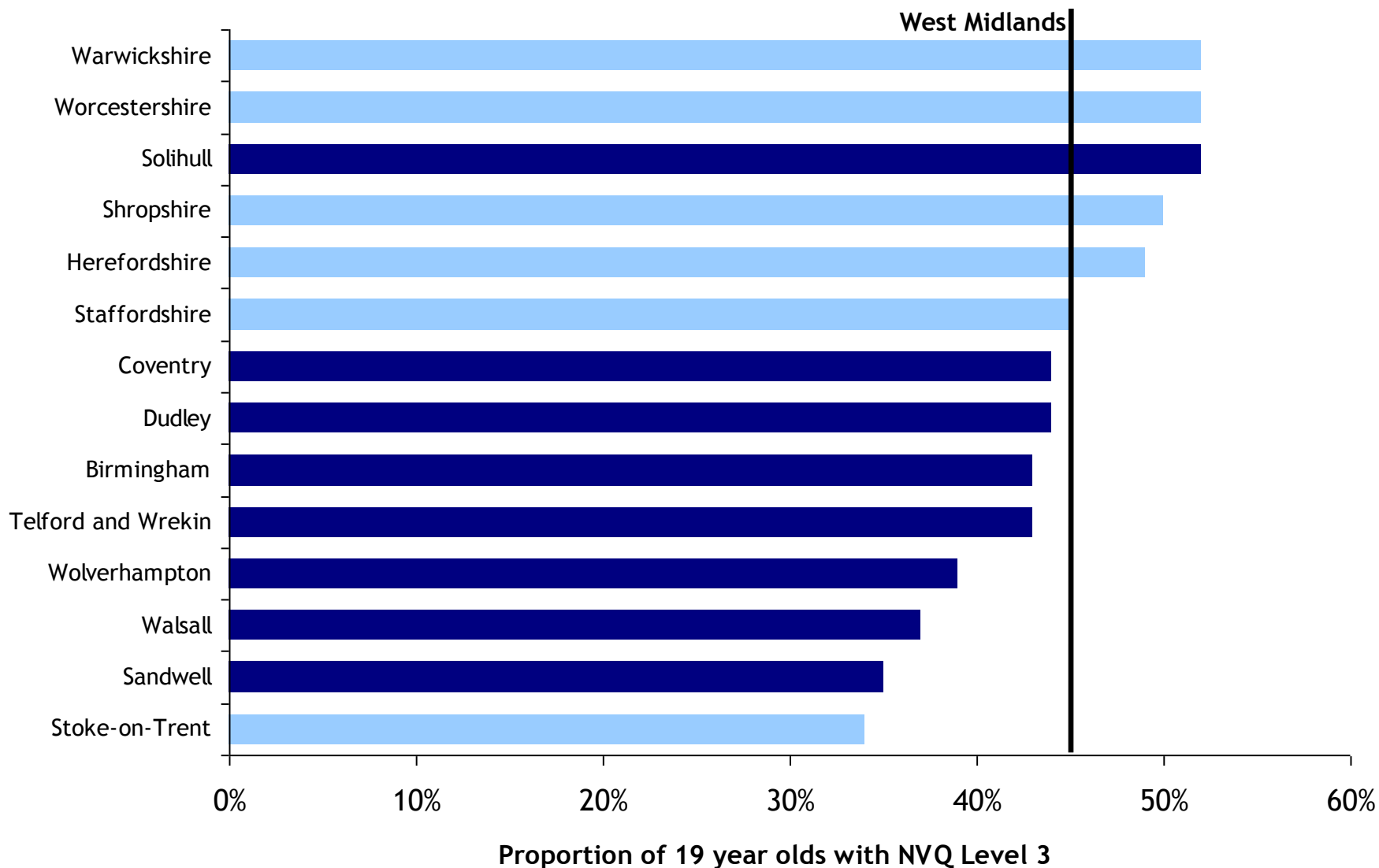
## Proportion of pupils achieving 5 or more GCSE A\*-C grades, incl. Maths and English, 2007/08



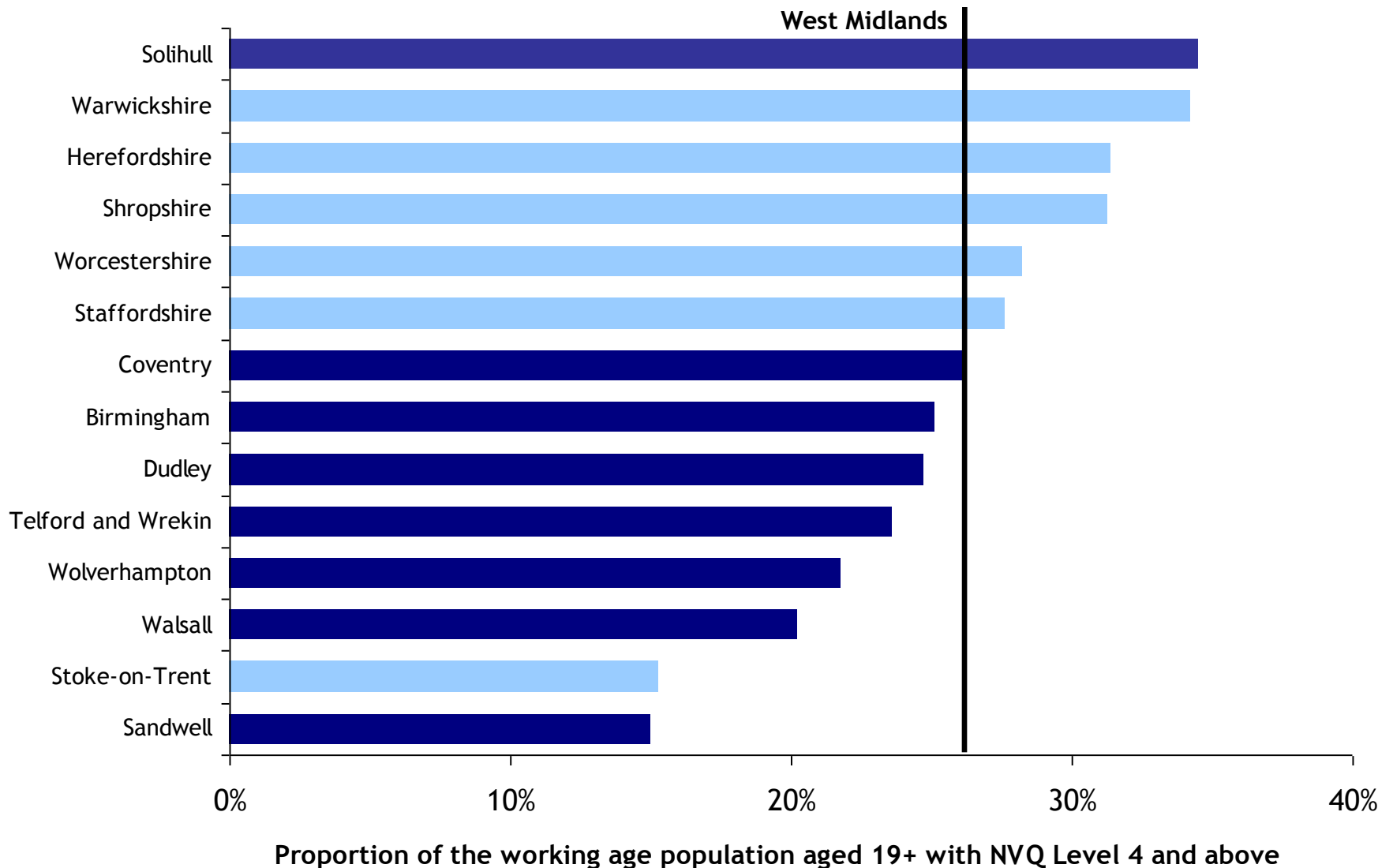
## Proportion of 19 year olds with NVQ Level 2, 2007/08



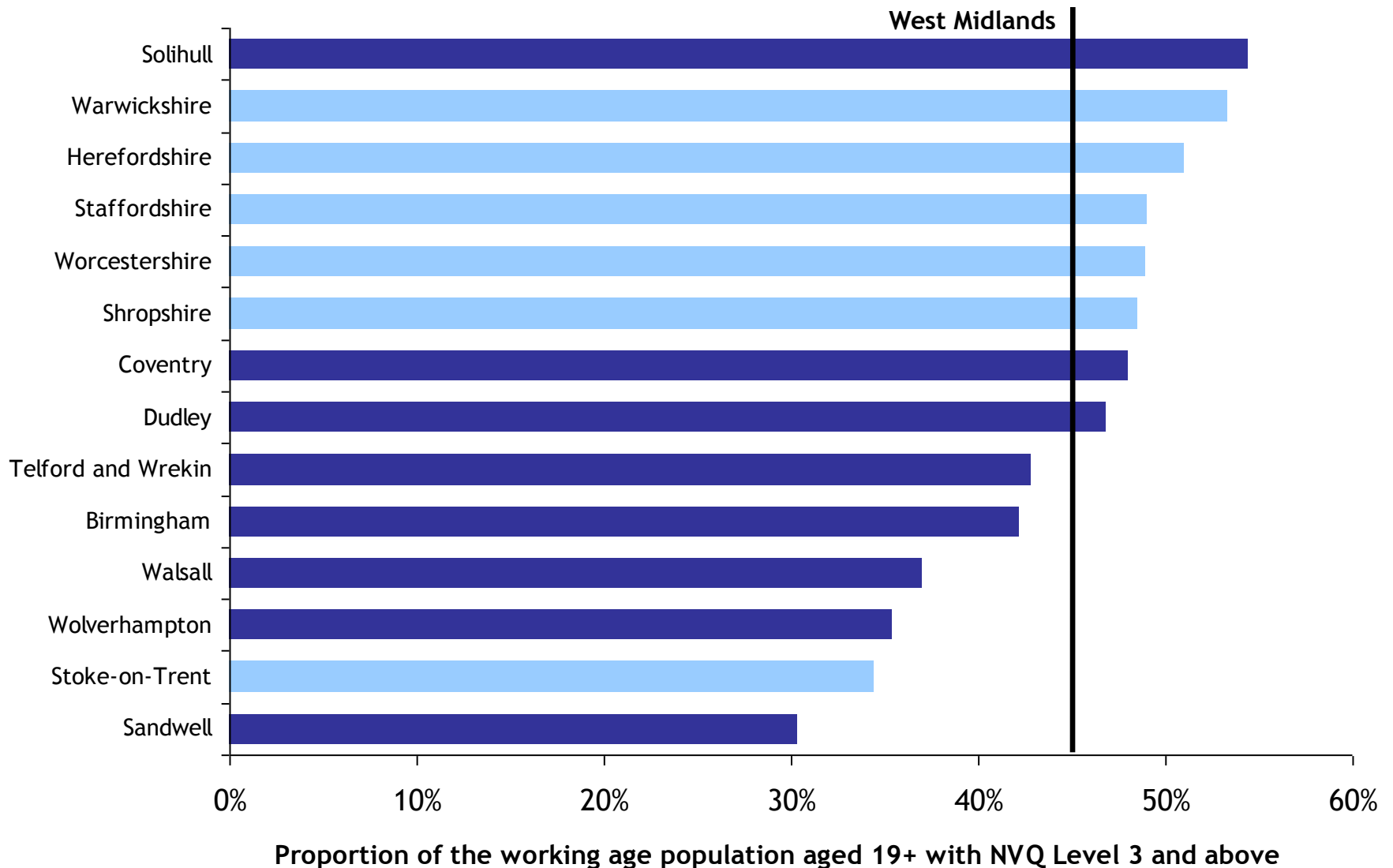
## Proportion of 19 year olds with NVQ Level 3, 2007/08



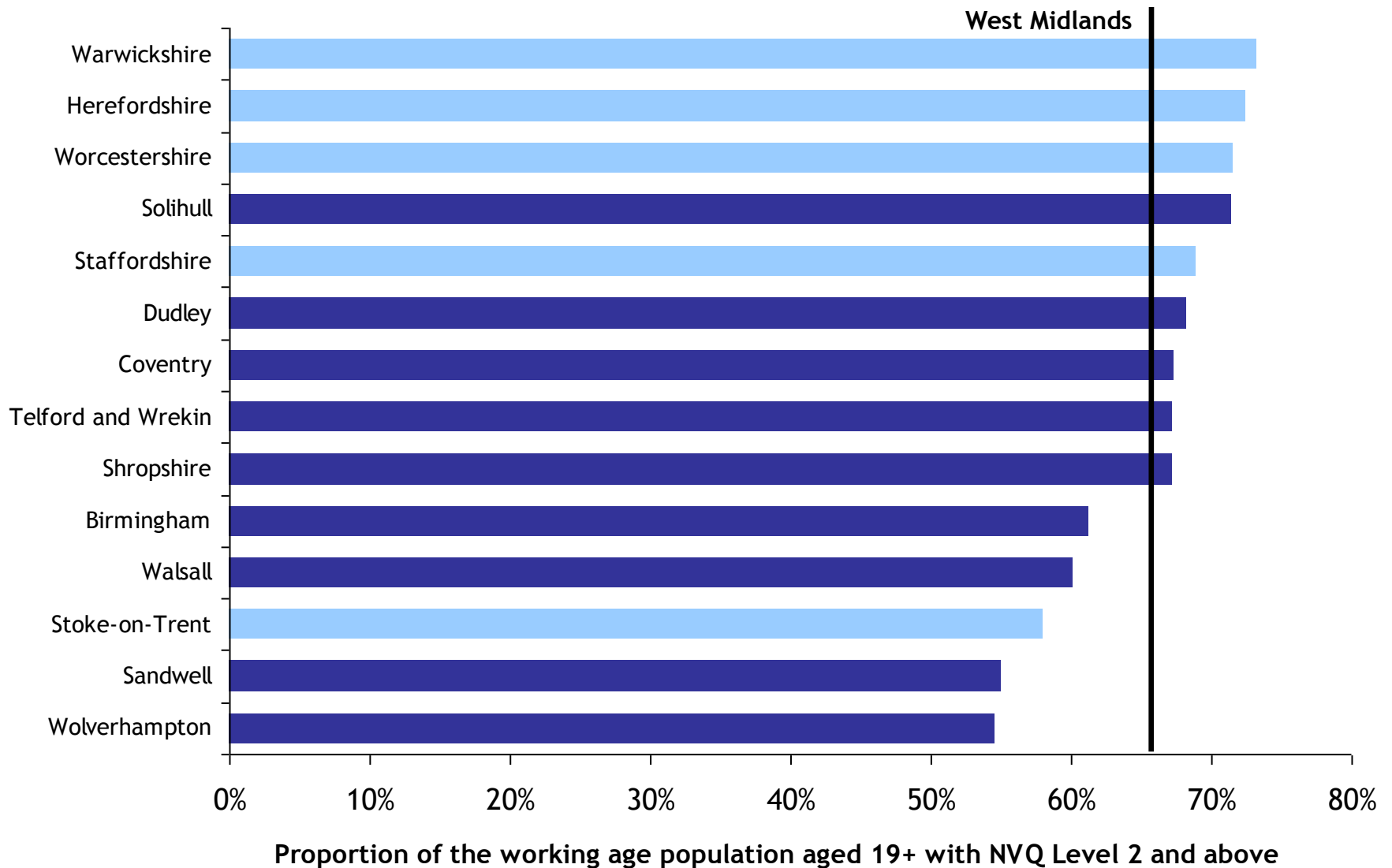
# Proportion of the working age population aged 19+ qualified to NVQ Level 4 and above in 2008



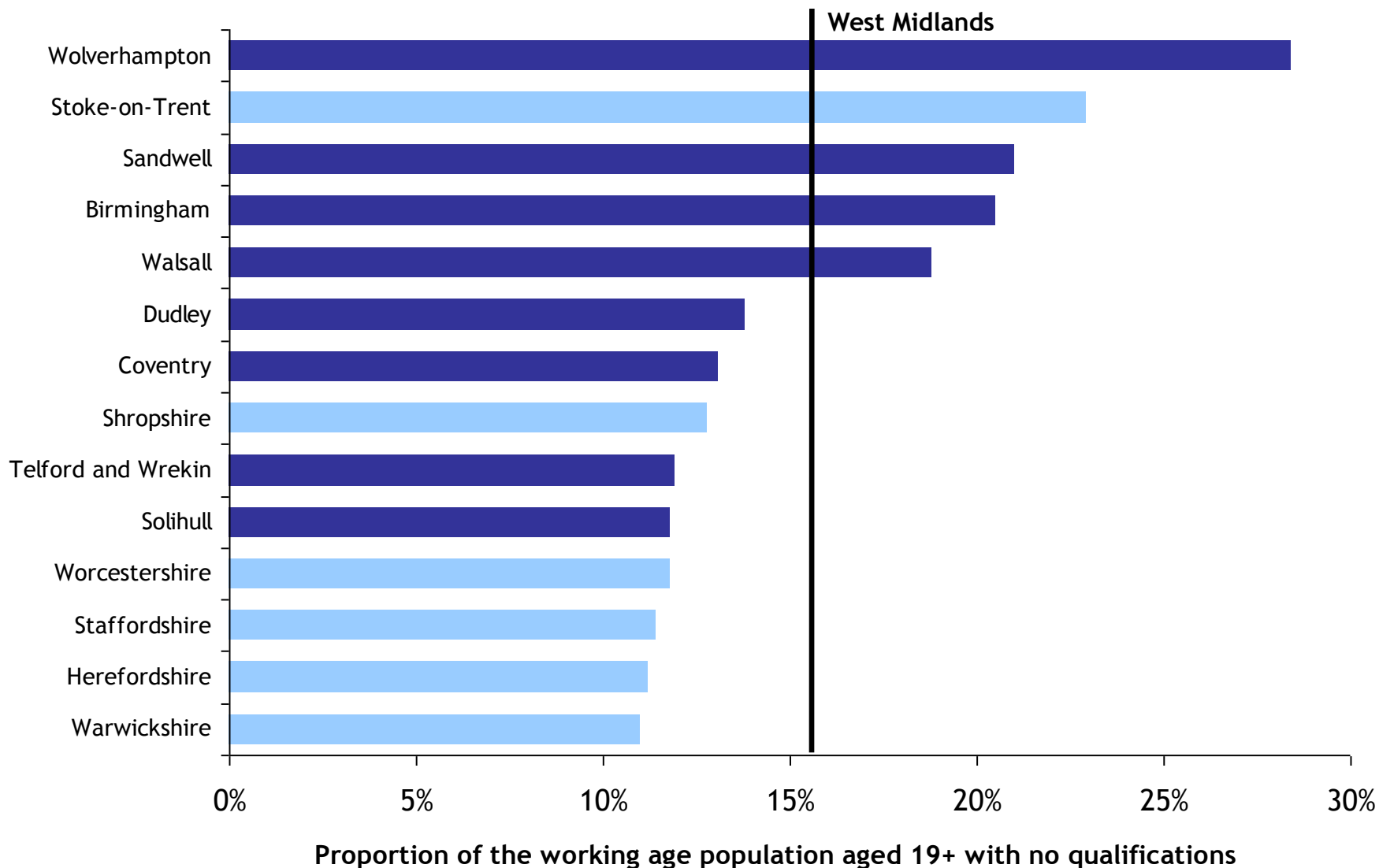
# Proportion of the working age population aged 19+ qualified to NVQ Level 3 and above in 2008



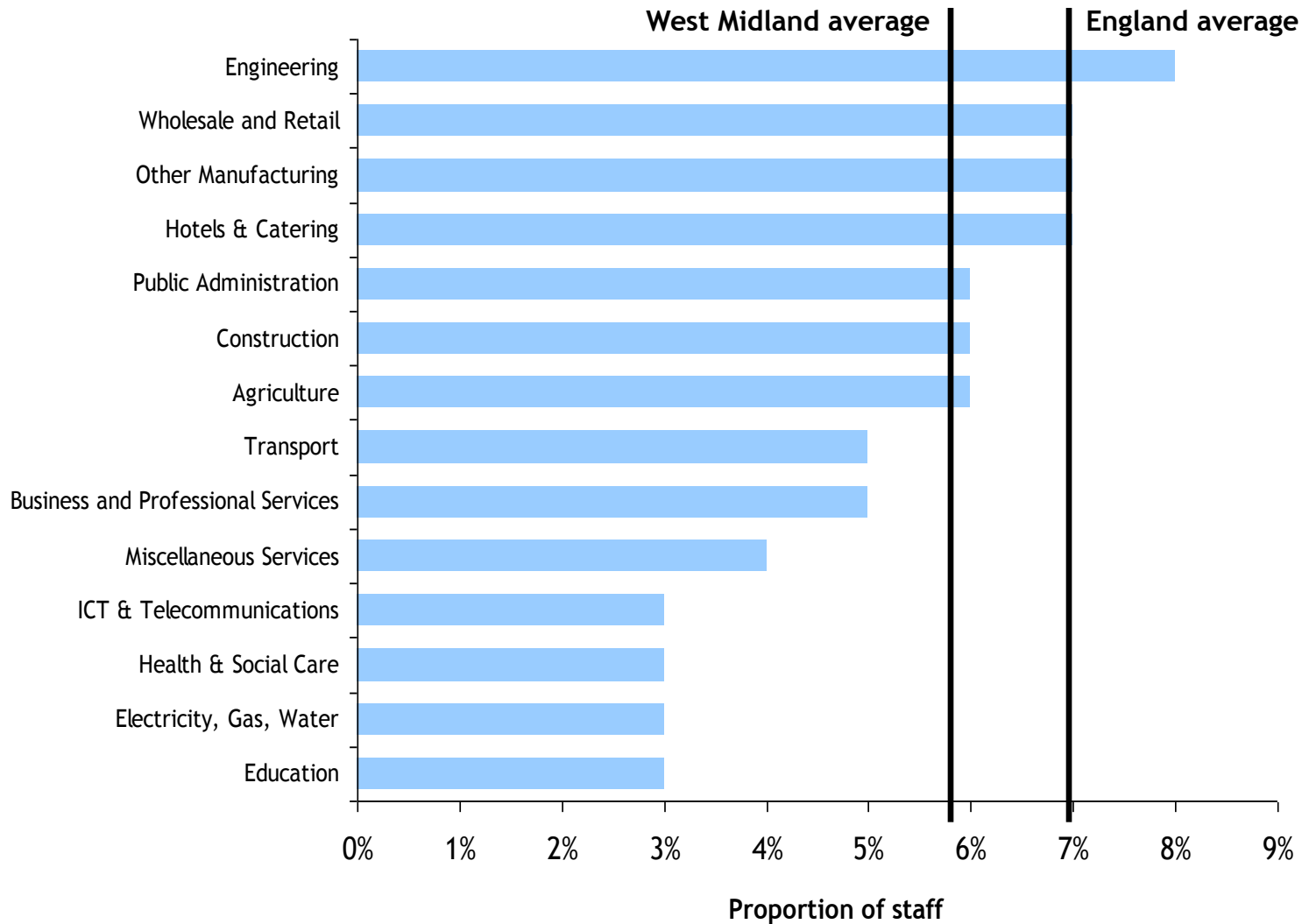
# Proportion of the working age population aged 19+ qualified to NVQ Level 2 and above in 2008



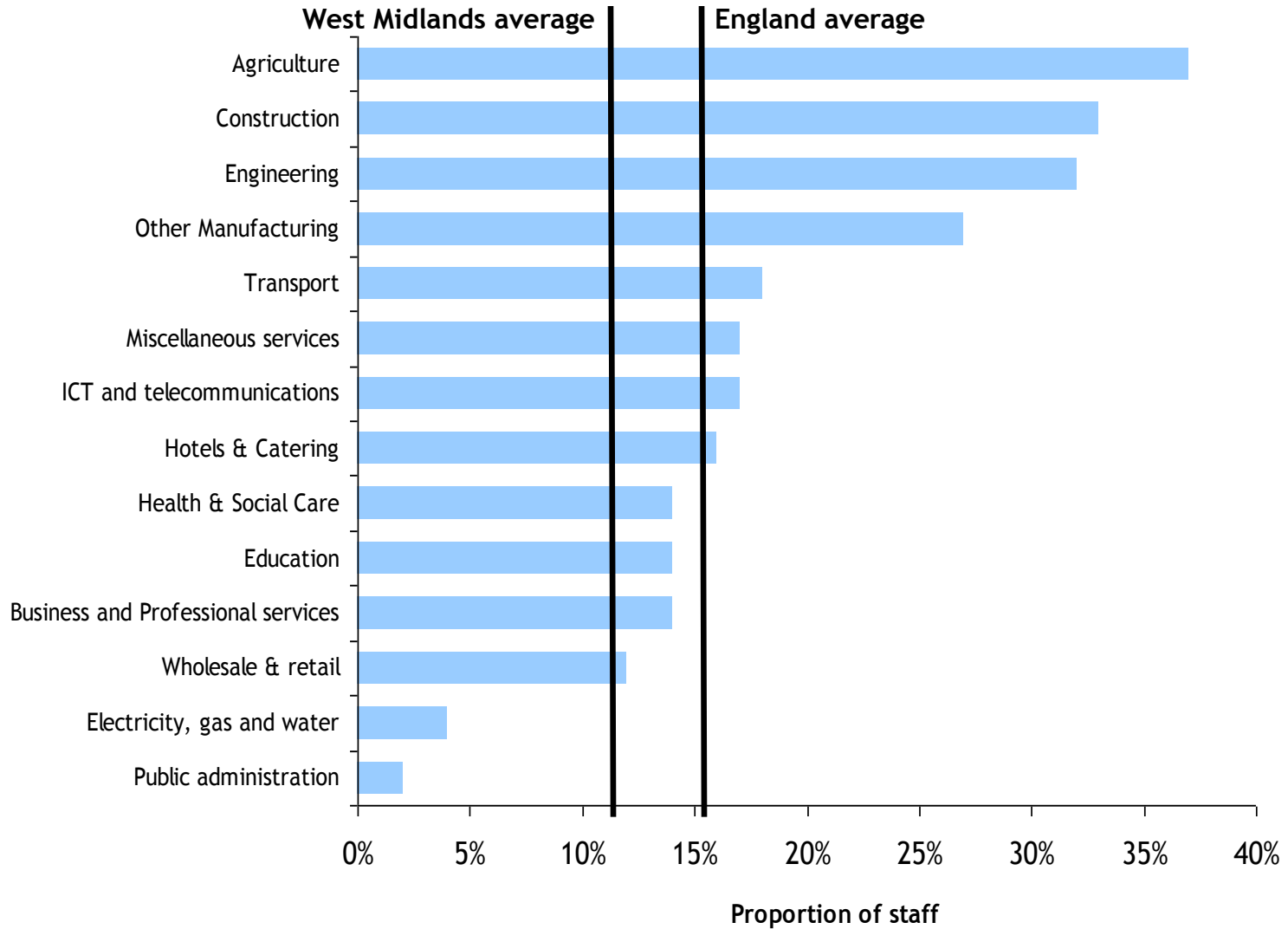
## Proportion of the working age population aged 19+ with no qualifications in 2008



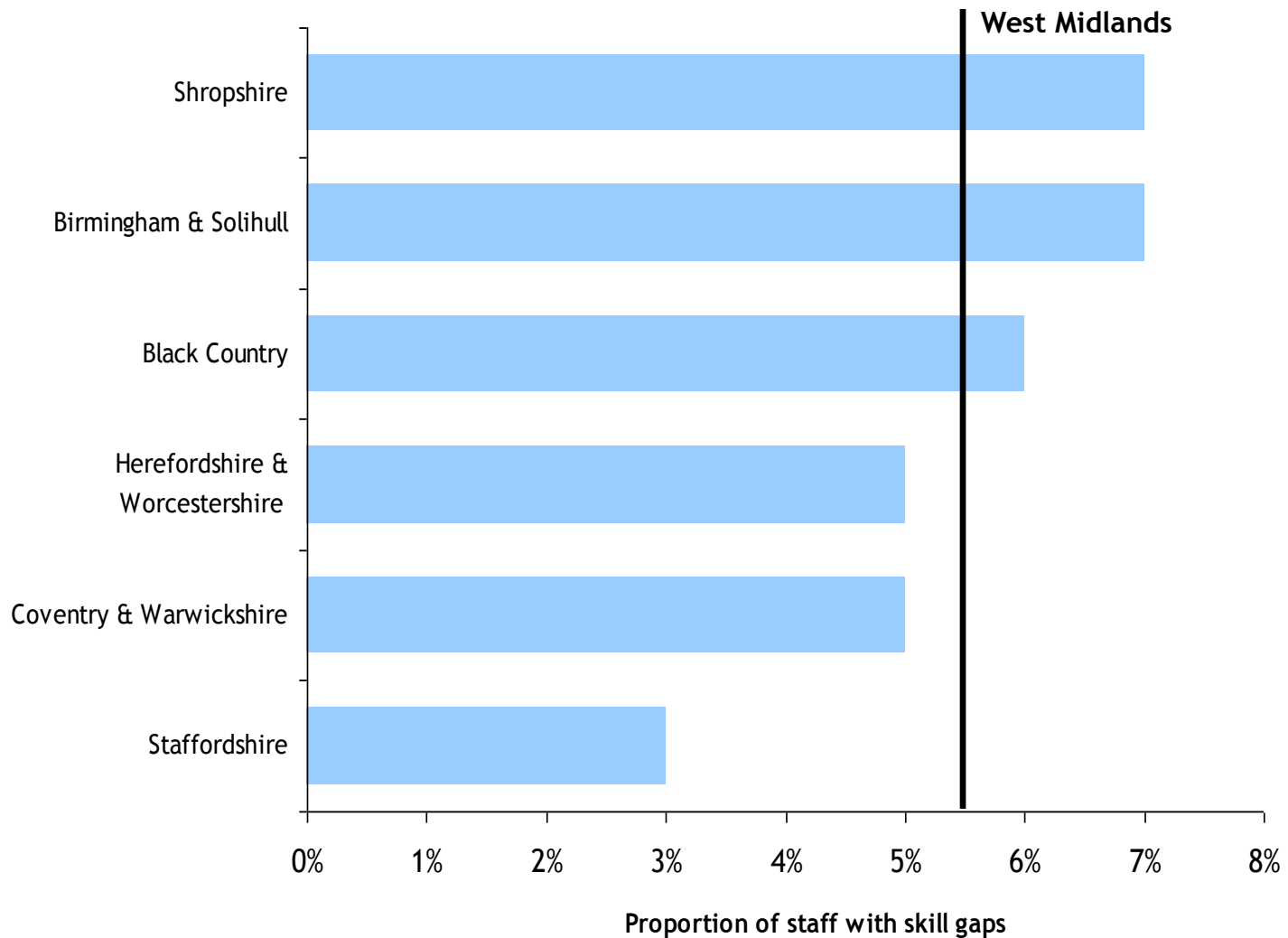
# Proportion of staff with skill gaps & deficiencies by sector



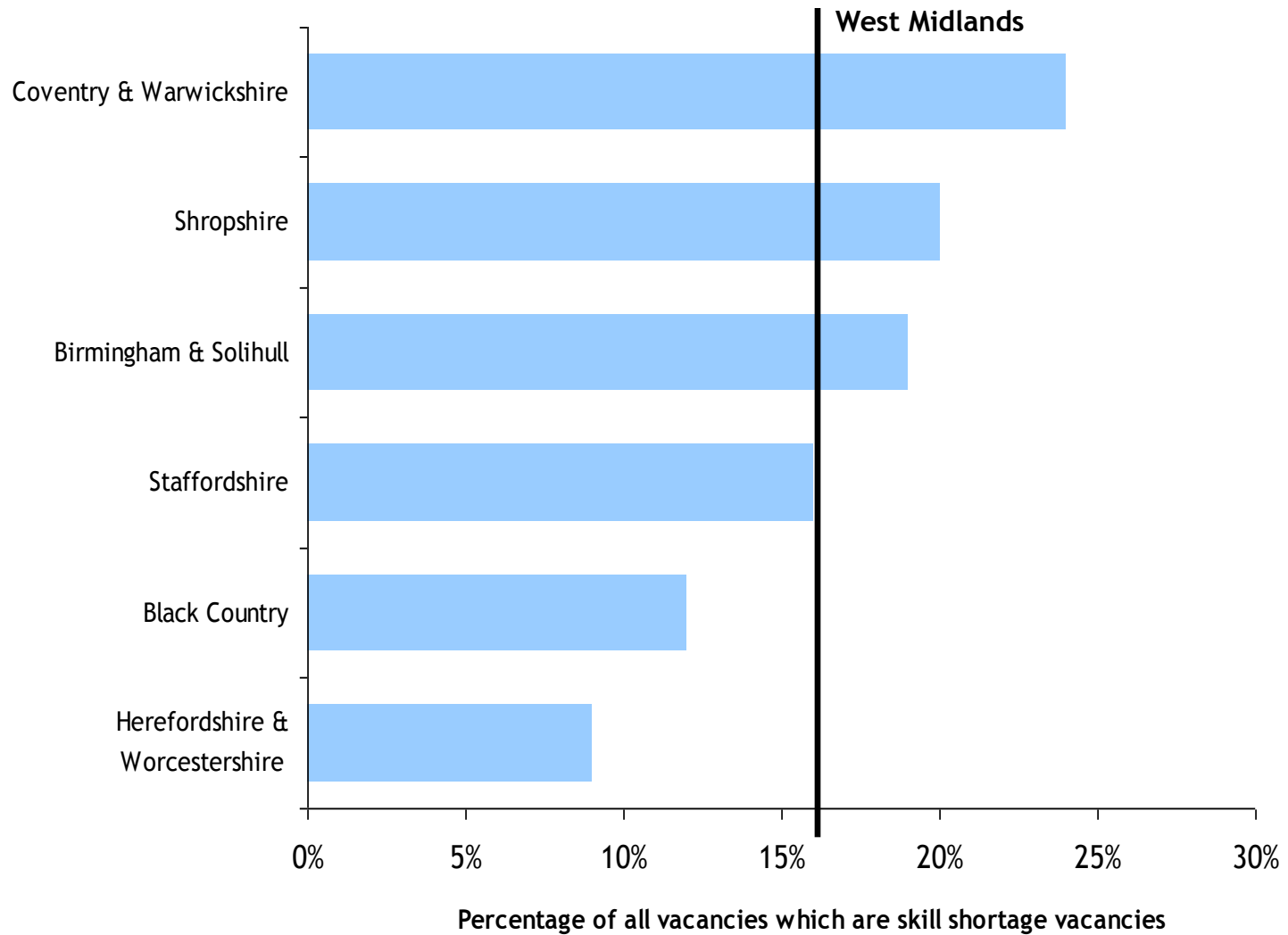
# Proportion of vacancies due to skill shortages by sector



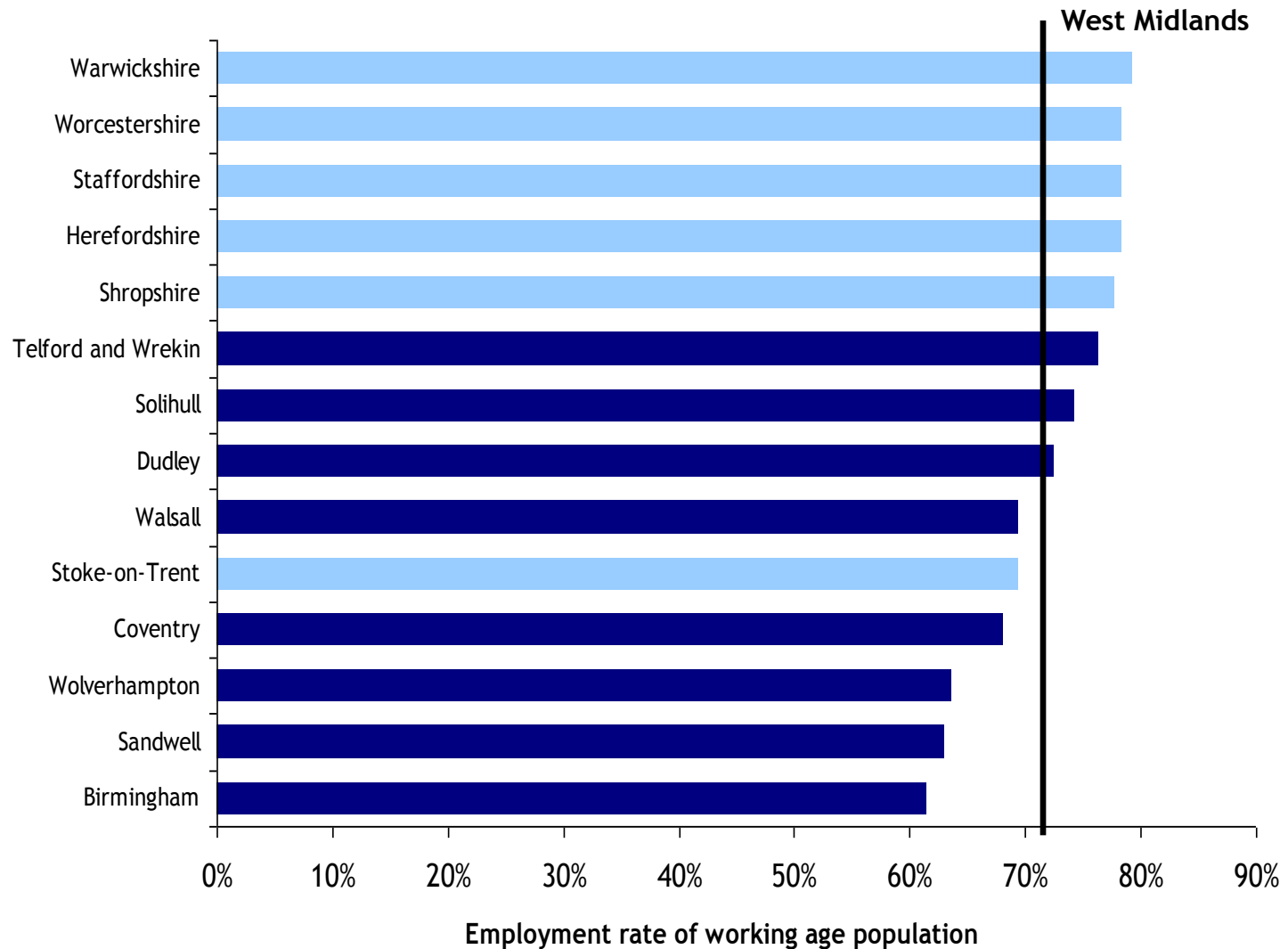
## Proportion of staff with skill gaps and deficiencies by sub-region



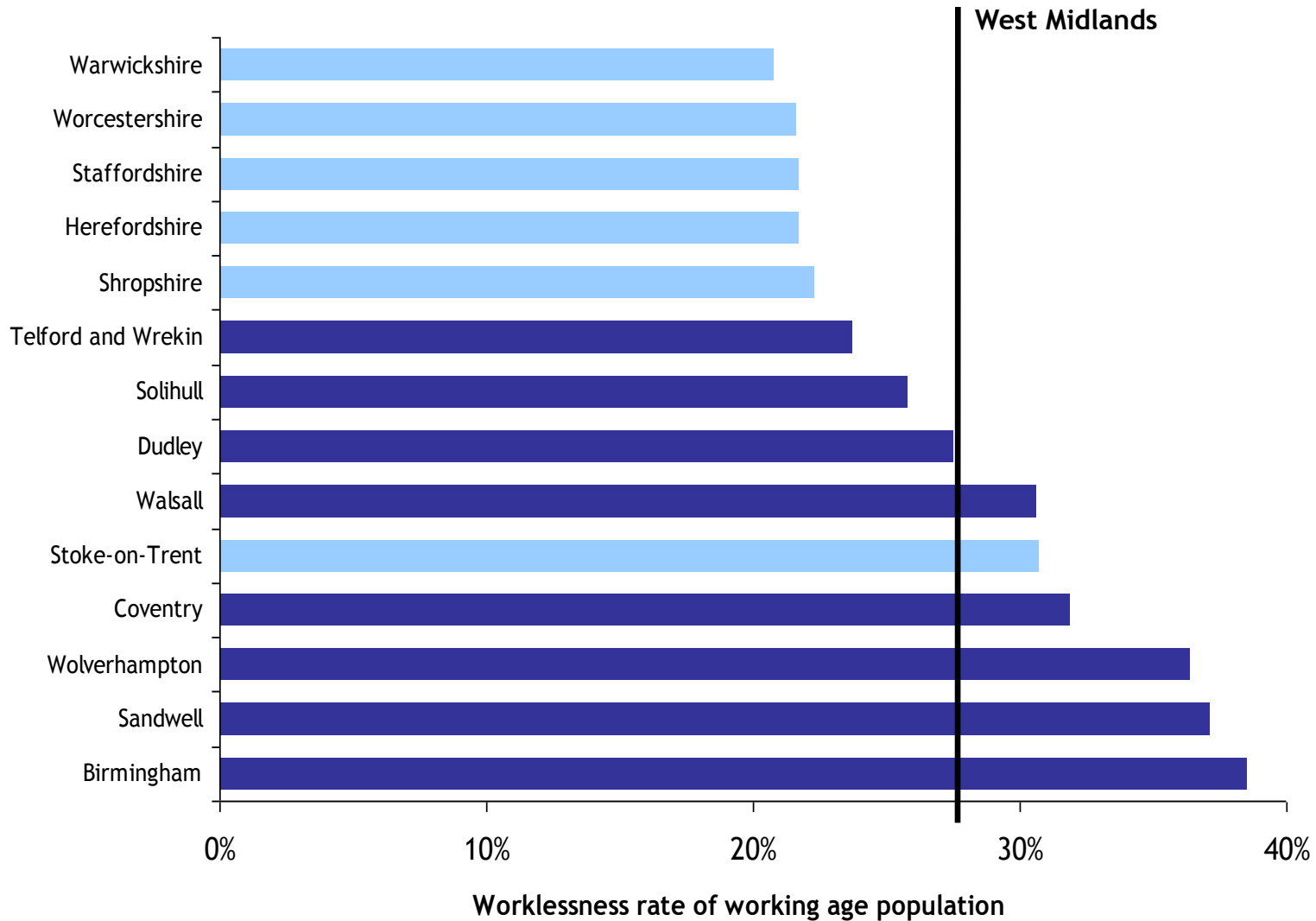
## Proportion of job vacancies due to skill shortages by sub-region
